

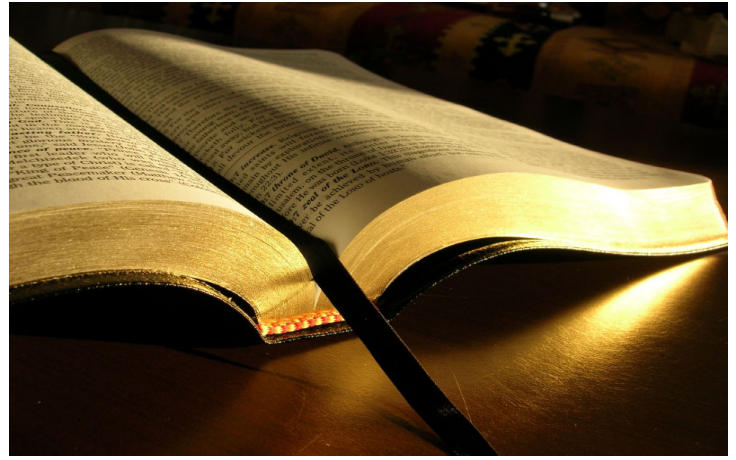

MY DEAR FRIENDS...

This weekend is the Missionary Cooperative Appeal Weekend here in our parish. Every year the Office of Missions and Propagation of the Faith in the Archdiocese invites priests, religious and lay ministers from dioceses and ministries around the world to visit our parishes to share with us their experiences in mission territories of the Church around the world. This weekend we joyfully welcome Father Cassagnol Métellus from Haiti who is coming to share with us the stories of our brothers and sisters in his diocese. These visits serve as a reminder to us that our Church is indeed universal and that we must be conscious of the missionary activities of Christians everywhere especially in the poorest of countries.

In a letter sent to all pastors in March, Archbishop Wenski quoted St. John Paul II in *Ecclesia in America*, "For this service of the poor to be both evangelical and evangelizing, it must faithfully reflect the attitude of Jesus, who came 'to proclaim Good News to the poor' (Lk 4:18). When offered in this spirit, the service of the poor shows forth God's infinite love for all people and becomes an effective way of communicating the hope of salvation which Christ has brought to the world, a hope which glows in a special way when it is shared with those abandoned or rejected by society."

Obviously, the missionary outreach of the Archdiocese goes far beyond the Americas. In the past, I have hosted priests from Father Uko's home country of Nigeria, from the Sudan, and from India as well. All of them have courageous stories of how the Church, despite material struggles, is still heroically proclaiming the Good News sometimes with their very lives at risk.

Because Father Métellus is coming from a poor diocese in Haiti, we want to take up a special collection for his mission work down there. This will take place after Holy Communion at Mass this weekend, and I ask you to please be generous. The Archbishop informed us that last year the

Archdiocese raised \$417,000 to help 30 mission groups around the world. The generosity of the people of God never ceases to amaze me, and I know that our parish's generosity is unmatched.

So I ask you to listen attentively to Father Métellus, and to pray for his ministry and for the good people he serves. We are one Church. In every corner of the world, the gospel is preached and the Divine Sacrifice of the Mass is offered. May we always be aware of the needs of our fellow Catholics who live in poor conditions or live under persecution. And may we always pray for them and for the missionaries who labor to bring the Good News of Jesus Christ to them.

Therefore, on September 9th, 10th, and 11th, we will be celebrating our daily Masses in Comber Hall, the original church, where Mass was celebrated for the first 25 years of our parish. During those days, between Masses, all are invited to pray in our chapel in the parish center where the Blessed Sacrament is always present. I thank you for your cooperation as we seek to maintain our beautiful and historic church.



MIS QUERIDOS AMIGOS...

Este fin de semana es el Fin de Semana de la Apelación Cooperativa Misionera aquí en nuestra parroquia. Cada año, la Oficina de Misiones y Propagación de la Fe en la Arquidiócesis invita a sacerdotes, religiosos y ministros laicos de diócesis y ministerios de todo el mundo a visitar nuestras parroquias para compartir con nosotros sus experiencias en los territorios misioneros de la Iglesia en todo el mundo. Este fin de semana damos la bienvenida al Padre Cassagnol Métellus de Haití, quien viene a compartir con nosotros las historias de nuestros hermanos y hermanas en su diócesis. Estas visitas nos sirven como un recordatorio de que nuestra Iglesia es realmente universal y que debemos ser conscientes de las actividades misioneras de los cristianos en todas partes, especialmente en los países más pobres.

En una carta enviada a todos los párrocos en marzo, el Arzobispo Wenski citó a San Juan Pablo II en Ecclesia in America: "Para que este servicio a los pobres sea evangélico y evangelizador, debe reflejar fielmente la actitud de Jesús, quien vino 'a proclamar Buenas Nuevas a los pobres' (Lc 4:18). Cuando se ofrece con este espíritu, el servicio a los pobres muestra el amor infinito de Dios por todas las personas y se convierte en una forma efectiva de comunicar la esperanza de salvación que Cristo ha traído al mundo, una esperanza que brilla de manera especial cuando se comparte con los abandonados o rechazados por la sociedad".

Obviamente, el alcance misionero de la Arquidiócesis va mucho más allá de las Américas. En el pasado, he recibido sacerdotes del país de origen del padre Uko, Nigeria, del Sudán y también de la India. Todos ellos tienen historias valientes de cómo la Iglesia, a pesar de las luchas materiales, sigue proclamando heroicamente las Buenas Nuevas a veces con sus propias vidas en peligro.

Debido a que el Padre Métellus viene de una diócesis pobre en Haití, queremos hacer una colecta especial para su trabajo misionero allí. Esto tendrá lugar después de la Sagrada Comunión en la Misa

este fin de semana, y les pido que, por favor, sean generosos. El Arzobispo nos informó que el año pasado la Arquidiócesis recaudó \$ 417,000 para ayudar a 30 grupos misioneros en todo el mundo. La generosidad del pueblo de Dios nunca deja de sorprenderme, y sé que la generosidad de nuestra parroquia es inigualable.

Por eso le pido que escuchen atentamente al Padre Métellus y que recen por su ministerio y por las buenas personas a las que sirve. Somos una iglesia. En todos los rincones del mundo, se predica el evangelio y se ofrece el sacrificio divino de la misa. Que siempre estemos conscientes de las necesidades de nuestros compañeros católicos que viven en malas condiciones o viven bajo persecución. Y que siempre oremos por ellos y por los misioneros que trabajan para llevarles las Buenas Nuevas de Jesucristo.

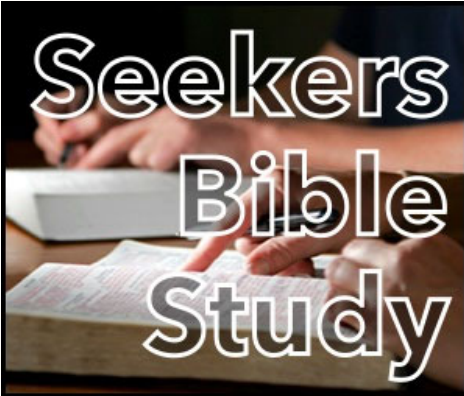
