

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

"In the name of God, I ask: Stop this massacre,"

With those words last Sunday, Pope Francis appealed for an end to the war in Ukraine. That war has been weighing down on us the last few weeks. We have felt sorrow or anger or even helpless as we see a people suffer so much. After reciting the Angelus a week ago, our Holy Father offered these words:

Brothers and sisters, we have just prayed to the Virgin Mary. This weekend, the city that bears her name, Mariupol, has become a city martyred by the time, Caritas Ukraine, with support from CRS, ruinous war that is devastating Ukraine. Faced with the barbarism of the killing of children, and of innocent and defenseless citizens, there are no strategic reasons that hold up: the only thing to be done is to cease the unacceptable armed aggression before the city is reduced to a cemetery. With an aching heart I add my voice to that of the common people, who implore the end of the war. In the name of God, listen to the cry of those who suffer, and put an end to the bombings and the attacks! Let there be real and decisive focus on the negotiations, and let the humanitarian corridors be effective and safe. In the name of God, I ask you: stop this massacre!

(Pope Francis, Angelus, 3/13/22)

We cannot cease to pray for Ukraine. Many of you have probably been asking, "what can we do to help?" As you can imagine, it is very difficult to deliver supplies and aid to a war-torn area, but thankfully Catholic Relief Services and Caritas Ukraine have been on the ground since the invasion started helping the people. As Providence would have it, next week is our annual collection for Catholic Relief Services (CRS). Here is the appeal from their website and a summary of what Caritas is currently doing there:

Your help is needed in Ukraine where there are already more than 2.9 million people in need of assistance! There is great risk of additional suffering both within Ukraine and for those who are fleeing to neighboring countries for safety. CRS and our partners need immediate support to meet both ongoing needs as the situation intensifies. Years of conflict along the eastern border have already displaced 1.3 million people from their homes and claimed 14,000 lives and now 2.3 million people have fled Ukraine. Almost ninety percent of the refugees are women and children. Throughout this has been providing emergency relief and recovery. CRS and Caritas partners on the ground are preparing across Ukraine and in bordering countries, providing safe shelter, hot meals, hygiene supplies, transport to safe areas, counseling support and more. The situation there is rapidly unfolding, and we could not do this work without your help. When you donate, you provide immediate assistance for your Ukrainian sisters and brothers affected by this crisis. Your prayers and support will make so much difference.

Next weekend during the second collection, we will have an opportunity to give to Catholic Relief Services and try and make a difference in the lives <mark>of our suffering brothers and sister i</mark>n Ukraine. If you would like to give directly to this cause today, simply visit www.crs.org and you can give directly to the relief efforts. Catholic Relief Services is one of the charities that I contribute to the most because of the direct help they offer around the world to people suffering from war and natural disasters. Let us continue to pray as a community for an end to the war and to the humanitarian crisis that cries out to God.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

"En el nombre de Dios, pido: Detengan esta masacre"

Con esas palabras el domingo pasado, el Papa Francisco pidió el fin de la guerra en Ucrania. Esa guerra nos ha estado pesando las últimas semanas. Hemos sentido tristeza o ira o incluso impotencia al ver a un pueblo sufrir tanto. Después de recitar el Ángelus hace una semana, nuestro Santo Padre ofreció estas palabras:

Hermanos y hermanas, acabamos de rezarle a la Virgen María. Este fin de semana, la ciudad que lleva su nombre, Mariupol, se ha convertido en una ciudad martirizada por la guerra ruinosa que está devastando Ucrania. Ante la barbarie del asesinato de niños, y de ciudadanos inocentes e indefensos, no hay razones estratégicas que valgan: lo único que hay que hacer es cesar la agresión armada inaceptable antes de que la ciudad quede reducida a un cementerio. Con el corazón adolorido añado mi voz a la del pueblo que implora el fin de la guerra. ¡En el nombre de Dios, escuchen el grito de los que sufren, y pongan fin a los bombardeos y los ataques! Que haya un enfoque real y decisivo en las negociaciones, y que los caminos humanitarios sean efectivos y seguros. En el nombre de Dios, les pido: idetengan esta masacre!

No podemos dejar de rezar por Ucrania. Muchos de ustedes probablemente se han estado preguntando: "¿Qué podemos hacer para ayudar?" Como se pueden imaginar, es muy difícil entregar suministros y ayuda a un área devastada por la guerra, pero afortunadamente Catholic Services y Caritas Ucrania han estado presentes desde que la invasión comenzó para ayudar a la gente. Como por la Providencia, la próxima semana es nuestra colecta anual para Catholic Relief Services (CRS). Aquí está el llamamiento de su sitio web y un resumen de lo que Caritas está haciendo allí actualmente:

¡Su ayuda es necesaria en Ucrania, donde ya hay más de 2.9 millones de personas que necesitan asistencia! Existe un gran riesgo de sufrimiento adicional tanto dentro de Ucrania como para aquellos que huyen a los países vecinos por seguridad. CRS y nuestros socios necesitan apovo inmediato para satisfacer las dos necesidades actuales a medida que la situación se intensifica. Años de conflicto a lo largo de la frontera oriental ya han desplazado a 1.3 millones de personas de sus hogares y se han reclamado 14,000 vidas y ahora 2.3 millones de personas han huido de Ucrania. Casi el noventa por ciento de los refugiados son mujeres y niños. A lo largo de este tiempo, Caritas Ucrania, con el apoyo de CRS, ha estado proporcionando ayuda de emergencia y recuperación. CRS y los socios de Caritas se están preparando localmente a través de toda Ucrania y en los países limítrofes, proporcionando refugio seguro, comidas calientes, suministros de higiene, transporte a áreas seguras, apoyo de asesoramiento y más. La situación allí se está desarrollando rápidamente, y no podríamos hacer este trabajo sin su ayuda. Cuando donan, proporcionan asistencia inmediata a sus hermanas y hermanos ucranianos afectados por esta crisis. Sus oraciones y apoyo harán mucha diferencia.

El próximo fin de semana durante la segunda colecta, tendremos la oportunidad de donar a Catholic Relief Services y tratar de hacer una <mark>diferencia en las vidas de nu</mark>estros hermanos y hermanas que sufren en Ucrania. Examination of Conscience

Confession can seem intimidating for a lot of people, but with some simple preparation, it can be a healing encounter with Christ that fills us with peace. Pray that God will give you peace and help you make a good confession.

Reflect on ways you have harmed your relationship with God, yourself & others using the question below.

- ♣ Do I pray to God every day? Have I thanked God for His gifts to me?
- Did I put my faith in danger through readings contrary to Catholic teachings or involvement in non-Catholic sects? Did I engage in superstitious practices: palm-reading or fortune-telling?
- Did I take the name of God in vain? Did I curse or take a false oath?
- Did I miss Mass on Sundays or holy days of obligation through my own fault? Am I attentive at Mass? Did I keep fast and abstinence on the prescribed days?
- Did I disobey my parents and lawful superiors in important matters?
- Did I hate or quarrel with anyone, or desire revenge? Did I refuse to forgive? Was I disrespectful?
- Did I get drunk? Did I take illicit drugs?
- ᆉ Did I consent to, recommend, advise or actively take part in an abortion?
- Tid I willfully look at pornography, entertain impure thoughts or engage in impure conversations or actions? Did I use artificial means to prevent conception?
- Was I unfaithful to my spouse? Did I engage in sexual activity outside of marriage?
- Did I steal or damage another's property? Have I been honest and just in my business relations?
- Have I been responsive to the needs of the poor and respected the dignity of others?
- Did I tell lies? Did I sin by calumny, or detraction, of others? Did I judge others rashly in serious matters?
- + Have I envied other people?



How do I go to Confession?

Confess your sins aloud to the priest, who listens lovingly on behalf of Christ and the Church.

Receive Penance, the prayers or good deeds the priest gives you to begin healing the relationships hurt by your sins.

Pray an Act of Contrition, a simple expression to God that you are sorry for your sins and that you resolve to leave sin behind and live in the light!

Receive Absolution, the words the priest speaks which reconcile you to God and the Church.

An Act of Contrition

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy.




Saint Perpetua and Saint Felicity


