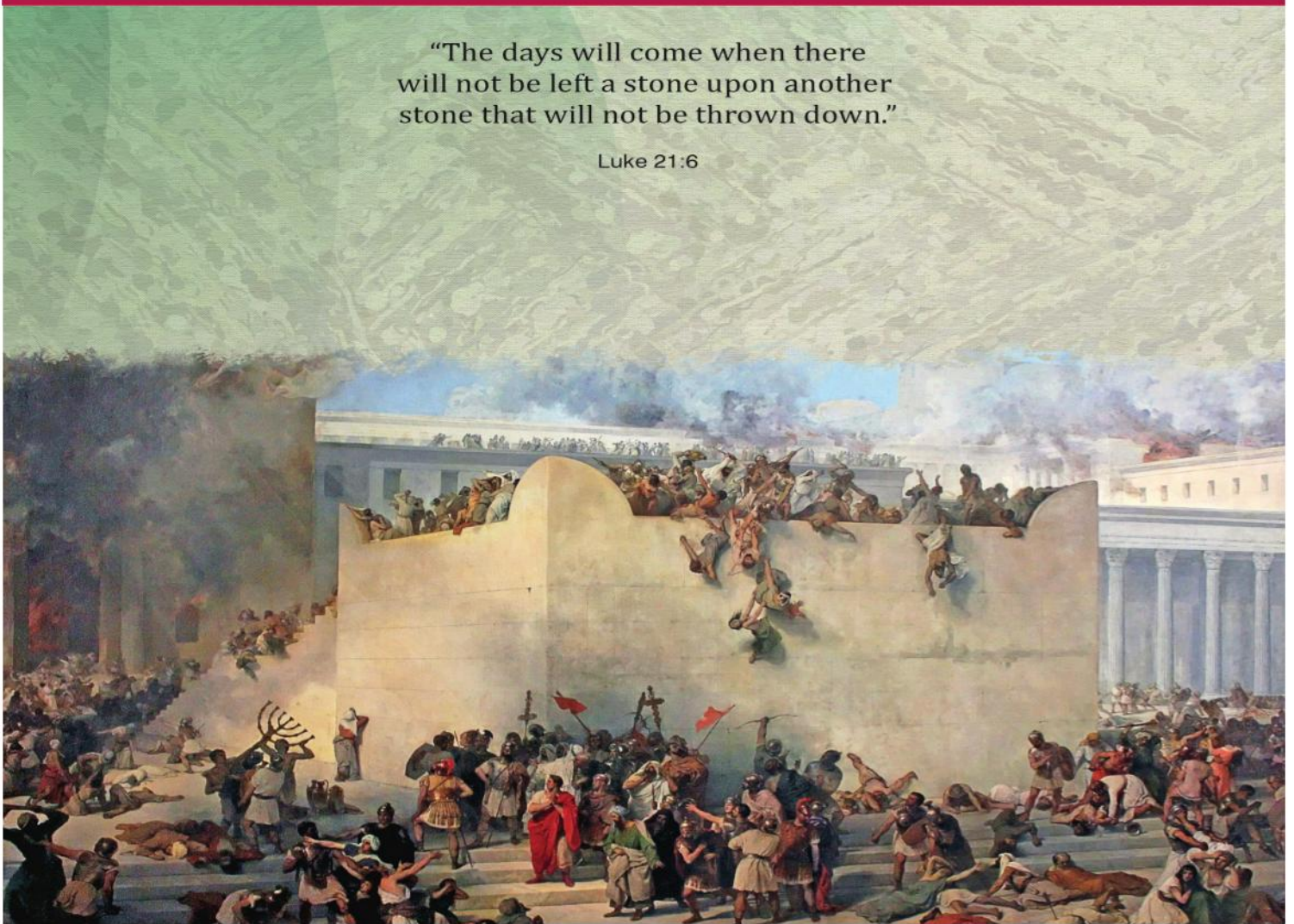

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

*My Dear Friends,*

*Beauty speaks of the Divine.*

Have you ever invited a guest into Little Flower and seen their expression when they behold the majesty of our church for the first time? Last year, there was a young lady who had just arrived from Cuba whom I took into the church to say a prayer of thanksgiving for her safe arrival. Seeing the expression on her face as she took in the wonder of this sacred space, you would think she was walking into St. Peter's Basilica for the first time. It's that this space and its beauty speaks of God, lifts up our souls to God, and helps us concentrate on the Divine Realities happening before us.

The same can be said of good music. Have you ever been moved by a musical piece in this church that it moves you to tears? It happened to me (three times!) just last week. That is the beauty of music and of art: it is supposed to be transcendent. Last week, I was moved by a song sung by our Schola at 10:30 a.m. Mass, by 2 little girls singing in unison and perfect harmony at our 9:00 a.m. Mass, and by a group of families who gathered to sing at our 12:30 p.m. Mass. To say nothing of the brilliant work done by our 5:30 p.m. choir week in and week out that causes people to stay in their pews until they are done singing the recessional hymn.

Last weekend was indeed a musical weekend because it started out with the return of the Little Flower Concert Series on Friday night as we hosted the Seraphic Fire Vocal Ensemble. Hearing them sing classical pieces with strings and a harpsichord accompanying the choir reminded me of one of the primary missions of the Church: to communicate the beauty of God. That is done so magnificently through music and art. For this reason, the Church has

always been a patron of the arts. You think of the classical Mass settings composed by the greatest musicians in history, or the works of arts commissioned by popes like the Sistine Chapel in the Vatican. You listen to that music or walk into those sacred spaces, and you are moved into the eternal.

We are indeed proud to bring back the Little Flower Concert Series after the pandemic to be able to host these talented artists singing some of the greatest works ever composed. I want to draw your attention to two particularly significant concerts coming up next month. On December 1, we are going to host the FIU School of Music as they perform Handel's Messiah in our church. If you have never heard Handel's Messiah and its glorious Hallelujah in person, please do yourself, and your soul, a favor and be present when this concert is done. The Hallelujah once caused King George II to rise to his feet when it premiered in London prompting the entire audience to do the same. Why? Because once again, beauty speaks of the Divine.

Seraphic Fire returns for their Christmas concert on Friday, December 16th for a program that you definitely do not want to miss. More information and tickets can be found at [LFconcerts.org](http://LFconcerts.org) on a very nice webpage we designed to highlight our commitment to continue to lift up souls to heaven through music.

## DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

*Mis queridos amigos,*

*La belleza habla de lo Divino.*

¿Alguna vez han invitado a alguien a Santa Teresita y han visto su expresión cuando contempla la majestuosidad de nuestra iglesia por primera vez? El año pasado, había una joven que acababa de llegar de Cuba a quien llevé a la iglesia para ofrecer una oración de acción de gracias por su llegada segura. Al ver la expresión en su rostro mientras contemplaba la maravilla de este espacio sagrado, uno pensaría que estaba entrando en la Basílica de San Pedro por primera vez. Es que este espacio y su belleza hablan de Dios, elevan nuestras almas a Dios y nos ayudan a concentrarnos en las Realidades Divinas que suceden ante nosotros.

Lo mismo puede decirse de la buena música. ¿Alguna vez se ha conmovido con una pieza musical en esta iglesia que los conmueve hasta las lágrimas? Me pasó (¡tres veces!) la semana pasada. Esa es la belleza de la música y del arte: se supone que es trascendente. La semana pasada, me conmovió una canción cantada por nuestra Schola a las 10:30 a.m., por 2 niñas cantando al unísono y en perfecta armonía en nuestra misa de las 9:00 a.m., y por un grupo de familias que se reunieron para cantar en nuestra misa de las 12:30 p.m. Por no hablar del trabajo brillante realizado por nuestro coro de las 5:30 p.m. semana tras semana que hace que las personas permanezcan en sus bancos hasta que terminen de cantar el himno de salida.

El fin de semana pasado fue de hecho un fin de semana musical porque comenzó con el regreso de la Serie de Conciertos de Little Flower el viernes por la noche cuando presentamos el Seraphic Fire Vocal Ensemble. Escucharlos cantar piezas clásicas con cuerdas y un clavicémbalo acompañando al coro me recordó una de las misiones principales de la Iglesia: comunicar la belleza de Dios. Eso se hace tan magníficamente a

través de la música y el arte. Por esta razón, la Iglesia siempre ha sido patrona de las artes. Piensen en las configuraciones clásicas de la Misa compuestas por los mejores músicos de la historia, o en las obras de arte encargadas por papas como la Capilla Sixtina en el Vaticano. Escuchan esa música o entran en esos espacios sagrados, y son conmovidos hacia lo eterno.

Estamos realmente orgullosos de traer de regreso la Serie de Conciertos de Little Flower después de la pandemia para poder acoger a estos artistas talentosos cantando algunas de las mejores obras compuestas alguna vez. Quiero llamar su atención sobre dos conciertos particularmente significativos que se celebrarán el próximo mes. El 1 de diciembre, vamos a ser anfitriones de la Escuela de Música de FIU mientras interpretan el Mesías de Handel en nuestra iglesia. Si nunca han escuchado el Mesías de Handel y su glorioso Aleluya en persona, háganse un favor a ustedes mismos y a su alma y asistan cuando presenten este concierto. El Aleluya una vez hizo que el rey Jorge II se pusiera de pie cuando se estrenó en Londres, lo que provocó que toda la audiencia hiciera lo mismo. ¿Por qué? Porque una vez más, la belleza habla de lo Divino.

Seraphic Fire regresa para su concierto de Navidad el viernes 16 de diciembre para un programa que definitivamente no querrán perderse. 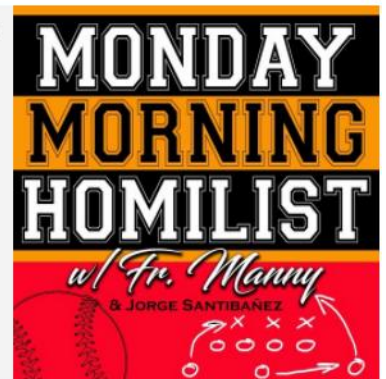

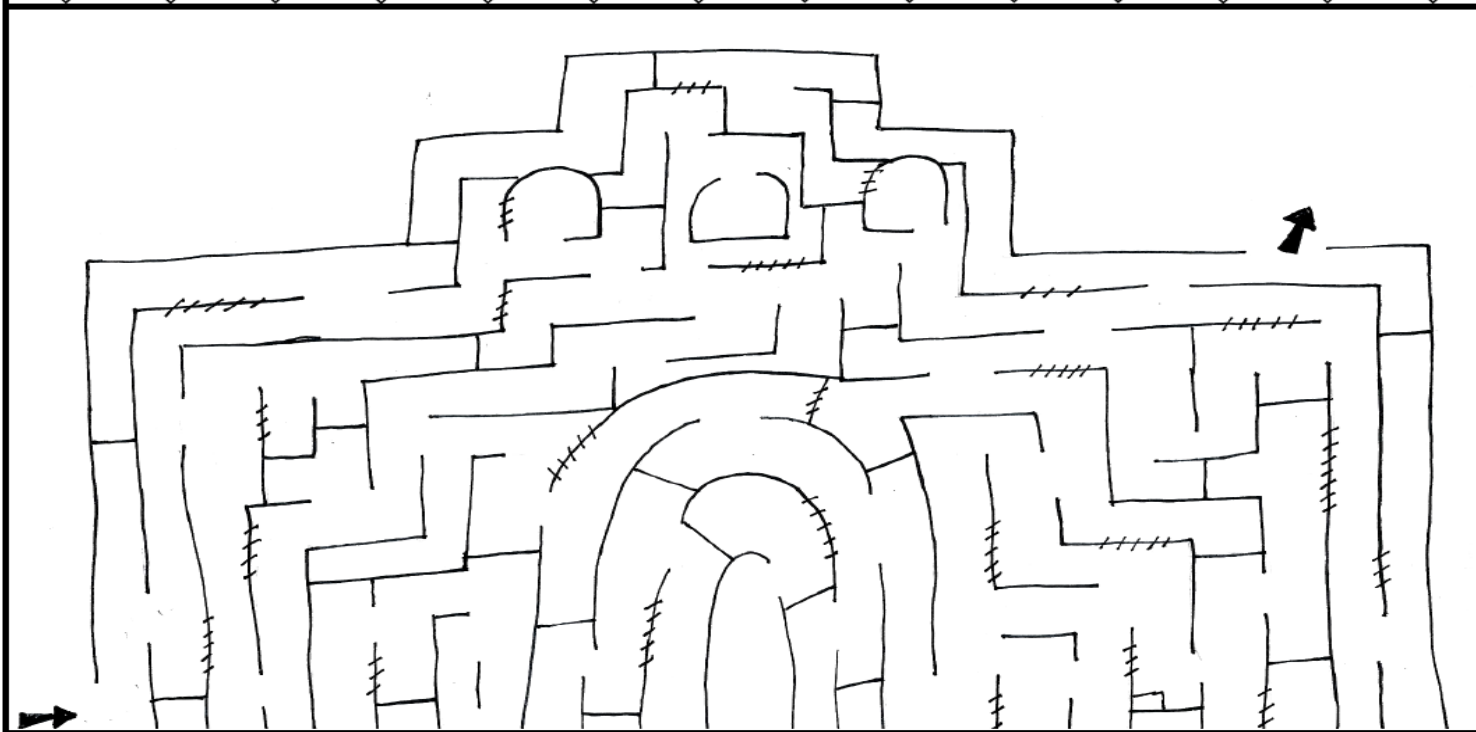
