

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

"...the sheep hear his voice, as the shepherd calls his own sheep by name and leads them out." (John 10:3)

When I was a kid, every day after school we would play football in the street in front of my house not too far from our church. Imagine that! We would actually go outside to play instead of numbing our brains to television and video games. We would play from when we arrived from school until sunset or at least until we heard a voice calling us home for dinner. It was the unmistakable voice of our mother who would call us, and yes there were times where we would ignore it so we could get in a couple of more plays, but we would always obey lest we hear the booming voice that would come after hers if we didn't listen: the voice of our father.

We all have been listening to our mother's voice since we were in the womb, and we have a special connection with that voice. It is a voice that soothes, brings comfort, corrects, but that also shows love. It is a voice that Jesus heard too when he was a child as he heard the voice of our Blessed Mother teaching him how to pray and how to recognize the voice of God and to do his will. Mary knew all too well what it meant to do the Father's will, so she taught her Son perfectly how to do the same.

Tomorrow, we begin the Month of Mary who teaches us how to listen to the voice of the Good Shepherd, and today we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday. Jesus tells us in today's gospel that his sheep recognize his voice and follow him. The question for us is: do we really? Do we know what the Shepherd's voice sounds like? And do we follow it? Sometimes that voice calls us to do

some extraordinary tasks; tasks that seem almost impossible. But if God calls us to do something that we deem impossible, isn't he going to make sure that we succeed? What the Archangel Gabriel asked of Mary was impossible, yet he said, "nothing is impossible for God." Perhaps Mary wasn't quite ready to be a mother, but the Lord called, and he made her ready which is why we honor her with a special month because she listened and obeyed. Perhaps we hear the voice of the Good Shepherd calling us into different pastures or calling us to do something that we feel we aren't quite ready to do or capable of doing. If it is indeed God who is calling us, he will make us ready and capable to do whatever it is he is calling us to do. All we have to do is trust in his will for us, for as the psalm says: "he guides me in right paths." And like a mother's voice, his voice will always bring us great comfort and lead us to a place of joy and peace.

This Fourth Sunday of Easter is not only Good Shepherd Sunday, but it is also World Day of Prayer for Vocations. As I mentioned during my Holy Thursday homily, we must rededicate ourselves to prayers for vocations. I invite you to sign up to take the Vocations Chalice home by contacting Father Andrew. And as we begin the month of Mary, let us implore our Blessed Mother to move the hearts of young men and women to follow her Son and dedicate their lives to the work of his Church. We begin these prayers tomorrow night, Monday, May 1st, as we gather for our biannual Outdoor Rosary on the rectory lawn at 7:30pm. I look forward to seeing you there to offer the rosary for vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

"... y el pastor llama a cada oveja por su nombre, y las ovejas reconocen su voz". (Juan 10:3)

Cuando era niño, todos los días después de la escuela jugábamos al fútbol en la calle frente a mi casa, no muy lejos de nuestra iglesia. ¡Imagínense eso! De hecho, salíamos a jugar en lugar de adormecer nuestros cerebros con la televisión y los juegos de video. Jugábamos desde que llegábamos de la escuela hasta el atardecer o al menos hasta que escuchábamos una voz que nos llamaba a casa para cenar. Era la voz inconfundible de nuestra madre quien nos llamaba, y sí, había momentos en los que la ignorábamos para poder hacer un par de jugadas más, pero siempre obedecíamos para no escuchar la voz retumbante que vendría después de la suya si no la escuchábamos: la voz de nuestro padre.

Todos hemos estado escuchando la voz de nuestra madre desde que estábamos en el vientre, y tenemos una conexión especial con esa voz. Es una voz que calma, trae consuelo, corrige, pero que también muestra amor. Es una voz que Jesús escuchó también cuando era un niño cuando escuchó la voz de nuestra Santísima Madre enseñándole cómo orar y cómo reconocer la voz de Dios y hacer su voluntad. María sabía muy bien lo que significaba hacer la voluntad del Padre, así que enseñó perfectamente a su Hijo cómo hacer lo mismo.

Mañana comenzamos el Mes de María quien nos enseña a escuchar la voz del Buen Pastor, y hoy celebramos el Domingo del Buen Pastor. Jesús nos dice en el evangelio de hoy que sus ovejas reconocen su voz y lo siguen. La pregunta para nosotros es: ¿realmente lo hacemos? ¿Sabemos cómo suena la voz del Pastor? ¿Y lo seguimos? A veces esa voz nos llama a hacer algunas tareas extraordinarias; Tareas que parecen

casi imposibles. Pero si Dios nos llama a hacer algo que consideramos imposible, ¿no se asegurará de que tengamos éxito? Lo que el Arcángel Gabriel le pidió a María era imposible, sin embargo, dijo: "nada es imposible para Dios". Tal vez María no estaba lista para ser madre, pero el Señor la llamó, y la preparó, por lo que la honramos con un mes especial porque escuchó y obedeció. Tal vez escuchamos la voz del Buen Pastor llamándonos a diferentes pastos o llamándonos a hacer algo que sentimos que no estamos listos para hacer o que no somos capaces de hacer. Si realmente es Dios quien nos está llamando, nos hará listos y capaces de hacer lo que sea que nos esté llamando a hacer. Todo lo que tenemos que hacer es confiar en su voluntad para nosotros, porque como dice el salmo: "él me guía por caminos rectos". Y como la voz de una madre, su voz siempre nos traerá gran consuelo y nos llevará a un lugar de alegría y paz.

Este cuarto domingo de Pascua no es solo el Domingo del Buen Pastor, sino que también es la Jornada Mundial de Oración por las Vocaciones. Como mencioné durante mi homilía del Jueves Santo, debemos volver a dedicarnos a la oración por las vocaciones. Los invito a inscribirse para llevar el Cáliz de las Vocaciones a su casa comunicándose con el Padre Andrew. Y al comenzar el mes de María, imploremos a nuestra Santísima Madre que mueva los corazones de los hombres y mujeres jóvenes para seguir a su Hijo y dedicar sus vidas a la obra de su Iglesia. Comenzamos estas oraciones mañana por la noche, lunes 1 de mayo, mientras nos reunimos para nuestro Rosario bianual al aire libre en el césped de la rectoría a las 7:30 pm. Espero verlos allí para ofrecer el rosario por las vocaciones al sacerdocio y a la vida religiosa.





YOUTH LECTORS NEEDED FOR SUNDAY 9:00AM MASS


