FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

"The loveliest masterpiece of the heart of God is the heart of a mother." -- St. Thérèse of Lisieux

The quote above attributed to our patroness is so fitting when I think about the gift of our mothers. St. Thérèse lost her mother when she was only 4 years old, yet found spiritual motherhood in her older sisters and still had the grace to conceive this magnificent quote. There is nothing like the heart of a mother. We look to the Immaculate Heart of our Blessed Mother and find an ocean of love. Those same loving waters flow through the hearts of our mothers who bore us in their wombs. Words do no justice when trying to describe the love a mother has for her child.

St. Thérèse's mother, St. Zélie Martin, once said of motherhood: "Above all, during the months immediately preceding the birth of her child, the mother should keep close to God, of whom the infant she bears within her is the image, the handiwork, the gift, and the child. She should be for her offspring, as it were, a temple, a sanctuary, an altar, a tabernacle. In short, her life should be, so to speak, the life of a living sacrament, a sacrament in act, burying herself in the bosom of that God who has so truly instituted it and hallowed it, so that there she may draw that energy, that enlightening, that natural and supernatural beauty which He wills, and wills precisely by her means, to impart to the child she bears and to be born of her."

I am always left in awe when I behold mothers. They sacrifice so much for their children. Sometimes sacrificing even their own lives so that their child may live. Just look at the example of St. Gianna Molla, an Italian pediatrician, who in 1962, gave her life so that the child in her womb may live. While she was pregnant, doctors discovered a tumor in her uterus near her baby. Gianna opted to only remove the tumor which would put her life in peril but save her child's life. One week after her baby was born, despite the best efforts of her doctors, St. Gianna entered eternal life. Her husband and her

children were present when she was canonized by St. John Paul II in 2004. When speaking about the sacrifice she was making, St. Gianna said, "Look at the mothers who truly love their children: how many sacrifices they make for them. They are ready for everything, even to give their own blood so that their babies grow up good, healthy, and strong."

On this day, my heart also turns to mothers who have lost children: be it during pregnancy, infancy, or even as adults. No mother should have to bury their child. Yet, we accompany so many mothers who have had to go through the sorrows that our Blessed Mother did when she witnessed her son die. Mary's heart was filled with the hope of the resurrection. Mother's Day can be a difficult day for mothers who have lost children. Remember them in your prayers this day.

We also remember our mothers who have been called to the house of the Father. We ask that our Provident and Loving God reward our mothers in heaven for their sacrifices here on earth.

How beautiful is the heart of the mother! On this day, and every day, we thank God for this masterpiece born from his own heart. I look around our church every Sunday and see so many mothers holding their babies, see strollers filling up our side aisles, and hear the cries of their babies and I cannot help but thank God for those little lives that makes our church come alive during Mass. All because of the gift of our mothers who brought these little ones, these precious gifts, these tiny members of the Body of Christ, into our world. Thank you, moms! Enjoy your day, and may Mother Mary guide you and intercede for you as you embrace this heroic vocation.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

"La obra maestra más hermosa del corazón de Dios es el corazón de una madre." --Santa Teresa de Lisieux

La cita anterior atribuida a nuestra patrona es muy apropiada cuando pienso en el don de nuestras madres. Santa Teresa perdió a su madre cuando tenía solo 4 años, pero encontró la maternidad espiritual en sus hermanas mayores y todavía tuvo la gracia de concebir esta magnífica cita. No hay nada como el corazón de una madre. Miramos al Inmaculado Corazón de nuestra Santísima Madre y encontramos un océano de amor. Esas mismas aguas amorosas fluyen a través de los corazones de nuestras madres que nos dieron a luz en sus vientres. Las palabras no hacen justicia cuando se trata de describir el amor que una madre tiene por su hijo.

La madre de Santa Teresa, Santa Celia Martin, dijo una vez de la maternidad: "Sobre todo, durante los meses inmediatamente anteriores al nacimiento de su hijo, la madre debe mantenerse cerca de Dios, de quien el niño que lleva dentro es la imagen, la obra, el don y el niño. Ella debería ser para su descendencia, por así decirlo, un templo, un santuario, un altar, un tabernáculo. En resumen, su vida debe ser, por así decirlo, la vida de un sacramento vivo, un sacramento en acto, enterrándose en el seno de ese Dios que tan verdaderamente lo instituyó y lo santificó, para que allí pueda atraer esa energía, esa iluminación, esa belleza natural y sobrenatural que Él quiere, y quiere precisamente por sus medios, para impartir al hijo que tiene y nacer de ella".

Siempre me quedo asombrada cuando contemplo a las madres. Sacrifican mucho por sus hijos. A veces sacrificando incluso sus propias vidas para que su hijo pueda vivir. Basta con mirar el ejemplo de Santa Gianna Molla, una pediatra italiana, que en 1962, dio su vida para que el niño en su vientre pueda vivir. Mientras estaba embarazada, los médicos descubrieron un tumor en su útero cerca de su bebé. Gianna optó por extirpar solo el tumor, lo que pondría su vida en peligro pero salvaría la vida de su hijo. Una semana después de que naciera su bebé, a pesar de los mejores esfuerzos de sus médicos, Santa Gianna entró en la

vida eterna. Su esposo y sus hijos estuvieron presentes cuando fue canonizada por San Juan Pablo II en 2004. Al hablar sobre el sacrificio que estaba haciendo, Santa Gianna dijo: "Miren a las madres que realmente aman a sus hijos: cuántos sacrificios hacen por ellos. Están listos para todo, incluso para dar su propia sangre para que sus bebés crezcan bien, sanos y fuertes".

En este día, mi corazón también se gira hacia las madres que han perdido hijos: ya sea durante el embarazo, la infancia o incluso como adultos. Ninguna madre debería tener que enterrar a su hijo. Sin embargo, acompañamos a tantas madres que han tenido que pasar por los dolores que nuestra Santísima Madre hizo cuando vio morir a su hijo. El corazón de María estaba lleno de la esperanza de la resurrección. El Día de la Madre puede ser un día difícil para las madres que han perdido hijos. Recuérdalos en sus oraciones este día.

También recordamos a nuestras madres que han sido llamadas a la casa del Padre. Pedimos que nuestro Dios Providente y Amoroso recompense a nuestras madres en el cielo por sus sacrificios aquí en la tierra.

¡Qué hermoso es el corazón de la madre! En este día, y todos los días, damos gracias a Dios por esta obra maestra nacida de su propio corazón. Miro alrededor de nuestra iglesia todos los domingos y veo a tantas madres sosteniendo a sus bebés, veo cochecitos llenando nuestros pasillos laterales y escucho los gritos de sus bebés y no puedo evitar agradecer a Dios por esas pequeñas vidas que hacen que nuestra iglesia cobre vida durante la misa. Todo por el regalo de nuestras madres que trajeron a estos pequeños, estos preciosos regalos, estos pequeños miembros del Cuerpo de Cristo, a nuestro mundo. ¡Gracias, mamás! Disfruta de tu día, y que la Madre María te guíe e interceda por ti mientras abrazas esta vocación heroica.

- Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to the Church, to God, to Christ and to one another. Let them know that they are always at home in this house of worship.

2023-2024 classes will be held on Wednesdays only, from September 13th, 2023 through May 10th, 2024.



All those in need of special healing graces are invited to attend and participate. Several priests will be available at the conclusion of the Mass to impart the Anointing of the Sick.






ADUIT SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION - OCIA/RCIA

- † Unbaptized adults who wish to become Catholics.
- † Those baptized in another Christian Church who are seeking full communion with the Roman Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.
- † Catholic adults who were baptized Roman Catholic as infants and need to complete their Sacraments of Eucharist and/or Confirmation.






