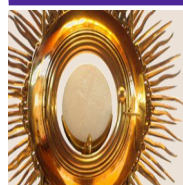

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

*My Dear Friends,*

*Here is a wonderful catechesis on the Holy Trinity from Pope Benedict XVI:*

Today we contemplate the Most Holy Trinity as Jesus introduced us to it. He revealed to us that God is love "not in the oneness of a single Person, but in the Trinity of one substance" (Preface). He is the Creator and merciful Father; he is the Only-Begotten Son, eternal Wisdom incarnate, who died and rose for us; he is the Holy Spirit who moves all things, cosmos and history, toward their final, full recapitulation. Three Persons who are one God because the Father is love, the Son is love, the Spirit is love. God is wholly and only love, the purest, infinite and eternal love. He does not live in splendid solitude but rather is an inexhaustible source of life that is ceaselessly given and communicated.

To a certain extent we can perceive this by observing both the macro-universe: our earth, the planets, the stars, the galaxies; and the micro-universe: cells, atoms, elementary particles. The "name" of the Blessed Trinity is, in a certain sense, imprinted upon all things because all that exists, down to the last particle, is in relation; in this way we catch a glimpse of God as relationship and ultimately, Creator Love. All things derive from love, aspire to love and move impelled by love, though naturally with varying degrees of awareness and freedom.

"O Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!" (Ps 8: 1) the Psalmist exclaims. In speaking of the "name", the Bible refers to God himself, his truest identity. It is an identity that shines upon the whole of Creation, in which all beings for the very fact that they exist and because of the "fabric" of which they are made point to a transcendent Principle, to eternal and infinite Life which is given, in a word, to Love. "In him we live and move and have our being", St Paul said at the Areopagus of Athens (Acts 17: 28). The strongest proof that we are made in the image of the Trinity is this: love alone makes us happy because we live in a relationship, and we live to love and to be loved. Borrowing an analogy from biology, we could say that imprinted upon his "genome", the human being bears a profound mark of the Trinity, of God as Love.

The Virgin Mary, in her docile humility, became the handmaid of divine Love: she accepted the Father's will and conceived the Son by the power of the Holy Spirit. In her the Almighty built a temple worthy of him and made her the model and image of the Church, mystery and house of communion for all human beings. May Mary, mirror of the Blessed Trinity, help us to grow in faith in the Trinitarian mystery.

## DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

*Mis Queridos Amigos,*

*Comparto con ustedes una Bella catequesis sobre La Santísima Trinidad del Papa Benedicto XVI:*

Hoy contemplamos la Santísima Trinidad tal como nos la dio a conocer Jesús. Él nos reveló que Dios es amor "no en la unidad de una sola persona, sino en la trinidad de una sola sustancia" (Prefacio): es Creador y Padre misericordioso; es Hijo unigénito, eterna Sabiduría encarnada, muerto y resucitado por nosotros; y, por último, es Espíritu Santo, que lo mueve todo, el cosmos y la historia, hacia la plena recapitulación final. Tres Personas que son un solo Dios, porque el Padre es amor, el Hijo es amor y el Espíritu es amor. Dios es todo amor y sólo amor, amor purísimo, infinito y eterno. No vive en una espléndida soledad, sino que más bien es fuente inagotable de vida que se entrega y comunica incesantemente.

Lo podemos intuir, en cierto modo, observando tanto el macro-universo — nuestra tierra, los planetas, las estrellas, las galaxias— como el micro-universo — las células, los átomos, las partículas elementales—. En todo lo que existe está grabado, en cierto sentido, el "nombre" de la Santísima Trinidad, porque todo el ser, hasta sus últimas partículas, es ser en relación, y así se trasluce el Dios-relación, se trasluce en última instancia el Amor creador. Todo proviene del amor, tiende al amor y se mueve impulsado por el amor, naturalmente

con grados diversos de conciencia y libertad.

"¡Señor, Dios nuestro, qué admirable es tu nombre en toda la tierra!" (Sal 8, 2), exclama el salmista. Hablando del "nombre", la Biblia indica a Dios mismo, su identidad más verdadera, identidad que resplandece en toda la creación, donde cada ser, por el mismo hecho de existir y por el "tejido" del que está hecho, hace referencia a un Principio trascendente, a la Vida eterna e infinita que se entrega; en una palabra, al Amor. "En él —dijo san Pablo en el Areópago de Atenas— vivimos, nos movemos y existimos" (Hch 17, 28). La prueba más fuerte de que hemos sido creados a imagen de la Trinidad es esta: sólo el amor nos hace felices, porque vivimos en relación, y vivimos para amar y ser amados. Utilizando una analogía sugerida por la biología, diríamos que el ser humano lleva en su "genoma" la huella profunda de la Trinidad, de Dios-Amor.

La Virgen María, con su dócil humildad, se convirtió en esclava del Amor divino: aceptó la voluntad del Padre y concibió al Hijo por obra del Espíritu Santo. En ella el Omnipotente se construyó un templo digno de él, e hizo de ella el modelo y la imagen de la Iglesia, misterio y casa de comunión para todos los hombres. Que María, espejo de la Santísima Trinidad, nos ayude a crecer en la fe en el misterio trinitario.










We pray the "Our Father" as a group during Mass. While we are praying, think of the whole kingdom of God praying with you.
