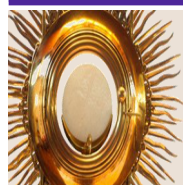

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

The Eucharist. I have said this often: there is nothing that we do in our parish that is more important than the celebration of the Mass. Today, on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, we celebrate Christ's Real Presence at the altar every time we gather to celebrate the Mass. We celebrate that everything we do as a parish, all our ministries and all our charitable endeavors, flow from that altar and return to it. As the Second Vatican Council and the Catechism of the Catholic Church remind us: Everything we do flows from the Eucharist and everything flows back to it. It is indeed the "source and summit of Christian life (CCC 1324)."

As many of you know, we are in the midst of a great National Eucharistic Revival meant to deepen our love for the Eucharist. This past week, our parish spent 40 hours straight adoring the Lord. Not only this past week, but every day, people come to our church or to our Adoration Chapel to kneel before the Eucharistic Lord and delight in his presence. There before Jesus we can place our problems and anxieties at his feet. We can sit in silence and listen to Him speak to us. We can raise our arms in praise and thanksgiving because, even though we sometimes have trouble finding them, He has bestowed countless gifts and blessings upon us. The first being that He has not left us alone. We are not orphans. He continues to be present at every altar and every tabernacle in the world. This should bring us great consolation that no matter how far we may travel this summer, we can always find the Lord when we walk into a Catholic church.

Today is a day for celebration and public profession of our love for the Eucharist, but it should also be a day in which we commit ourselves to learning more about the importance of the Eucharist in our faith. Bishop Robert Barron wrote a magnificent book called "This is My Body: A Call to Eucharistic Revival." It's a short book that we wanted to have in your hands today for Corpus Christi, but the overwhelming demand for the book has delayed its shipping into the summer. That's a good thing because people are clamoring to learn more!

So, we hope to have the books delivered later this summer, and we will distribute them on Catechetical Sunday which falls on Sunday, September 17, which is a most appropriate day, plus we will all be back from summer travels.

Speaking of summer travels, on Thursday I will be departing with a group of 40 pilgrims from our parish to travel to France, where next Sunday we will be celebrating Mass in the Basilica of St. Therese in Lisieux. Please know that we take all of your intentions with us to present before our beloved patroness.

Finally, this is a bittersweet week for us in the parish office. Our long-time office manager and my administrative assistant, Maria Elena Chialastri, is retiring after 30 years of service to our community. She was first hired by Fr. Ken Whitaker and has worked for five different pastors. Beyond assisting the pastors, she had the delicate job of being the first person our brides talked to when they called to schedule a wedding. Always with grace and charity, there was never a schedule snafu, never a complaint, and she made sure the trains ran on time here at Little Flower. She quietly went about her work not expecting praise, but fully knowing that her work, her ministry helped bring people closer to Christ whether it was scheduling a sacrament, scheduling a retreat, or scheduling an appointment so that a parishioner could speak to a priest. Thank you, Mari, for serving your parish which we know you will continue to do well into retirement. Enjoy your grandchildren, enjoy your travels, and on behalf of my four immediate predecessors, thank you for helping us keep our hands firmly on the wheel of this great ship as we lead God's people towards Him. Your parish and your fellow parishioners thank you!

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

La Eucaristía. Lo he dicho a menudo: no hay nada que hagamos en nuestra parroquia que sea más importante que la celebración de la Misa. Hoy, en la solemnidad del Corpus Christi, celebramos la presencia real de Cristo en el altar cada vez que nos reunimos para celebrar la Misa. Celebramos que todo lo que hacemos como parroquia, todos nuestros ministerios y todos nuestros esfuerzos caritativos, fluyen de ese altar y regresan a él. Como nos recuerda el Concilio Vaticano II y el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica: Todo lo que hacemos fluye de la Eucaristía y todo fluye de vuelta a ella. De hecho, es la "fuente y cumbre de la vida cristiana (CIC 1324)".

Como muchos de ustedes saben, estamos en medio de un gran avivamiento eucarístico nacional destinado a profundizar nuestro amor por la Eucaristía. La semana pasada, nuestra parroquia pasó 40 horas seguidas adorando al Señor. No solo la semana pasada, sino todos los días, la gente viene a nuestra iglesia o a nuestra Capilla de Adoración para arrodillarse ante el Señor Eucarístico y deleitarse en su presencia. Allí, ante Jesús, podemos poner nuestros problemas y ansiedades a sus pies. Podemos sentarnos en silencio y escuchar sus palabras. Podemos levantar nuestros brazos en alabanza y acción de gracias porque, aunque a veces tengamos problemas para encontrarlos, Él nos ha otorgado innumerables dones y bendiciones. La primera es que Él no nos ha dejado solos. No somos huérfanos. Él continúa estando presente en cada altar y en cada tabernáculo del mundo. Esto debería traernos un gran consuelo de que no importa cuán lejos podamos viajar este verano, siempre podemos encontrar al Señor cuando entramos en una iglesia católica.

Hoy es un día para la celebración y la profesión pública de nuestro amor por la Eucaristía, pero también debe ser un día en el que nos comprometamos a aprender más sobre la importancia de la Eucaristía en nuestra fe. El obispo Robert Barron escribió un libro magnífico llamado "Este es mi cuerpo: un llamado al avivamiento eucarístico". Es un libro corto que hubiésemos querido tener en sus manos hoy para Corpus Christi, pero la demanda abrumadora del libro

ha retrasado su envío hasta el verano. ¡Eso es algo bueno porque la gente está clamando por aprender más! Por lo tanto, esperamos que los libros se entreguen a finales de este verano, y los distribuiremos el Domingo Catequético que cae el domingo 17 de septiembre, que es el día más apropiado, además de que todos estaremos de regreso de los viajes de verano.

Hablando de viajes de verano, el jueves partiré con un grupo de 40 peregrinos de nuestra parroquia para viajar a Francia, donde el próximo domingo celebraremos la Misa en la Basílica de Santa Teresa en Lisieux. Por favor, sepan que llevamos todas sus intenciones con nosotros para presentarlas ante nuestra amada patrona.

Finalmente, esta es una semana agri dulce para nosotros en la oficina parroquial. Nuestra gerente de oficina desde hace mucho tiempo y mi asistente administrativa, Maria Elena Chialastri, se retira después de 30 años de servicio a nuestra comunidad. Fue contratada por primera vez por el Padre Ken Whitaker y ha trabajado para cinco párrocos diferentes. Más allá de ayudar a los párrocos, ella tenía la delicada tarea de ser la primera persona con la que hablaron nuestras novias cuando llamaban para programar una boda. Siempre con gracia y caridad, nunca hubo un problema de horario, nunca hubo una queja, y ella se aseguró de que los trenes funcionaran a tiempo aquí en Little Flower. Ella silenciosamente se dedicó a su trabajo sin esperar alabanza, sino sabiendo plenamente que su trabajo, su ministerio ayudó a acercar a las personas a Cristo, ya sea programando un sacramento, programando un retiro, o programando una cita para que un feligrés pudiera hablar con un sacerdote. The Caring Place @ The Miami Rescue Mission.

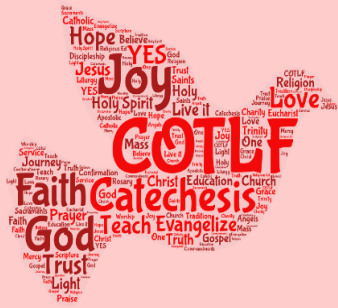



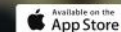
