FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends:

In today's gospel, Jesus tells the disciples, "Call no one on earth your father." He does not mean this literally, for he is simply warning the disciples about the feeling of superiority that the Pharisees had gotten over all the titles they enjoyed being called. For me, the title "father" has never made me feel superior, but rather been a challenge and a reminder of the incredible responsibility that the Good Lord has given to me in calling me to be his priest. It is a challenge to be humble, selfless, and a servant above all else. "The greatest among you must be your servant." Jesus reminded of us this in today's gospel, but as a priest I was reminded of this on my ordination day when I lay prostrate on the cathedral floor. Above all else, I must be your servant.

In the summer of 2010 as I made my first pilgrimage to Rome, I read a great book by the biblical scholar Scott Hahn on the biblical origins of the priesthood titled, "Many Are Called: Rediscovering the Glory of the Priesthood." Dr. Hahn echoes the words of Jesus in today's gospel that we have one Father in heaven, but what this great scholar said next really moved me: "[God the Father's] perfect fatherhood is a spiritual act. Celibate priests are living and life-giving images of God the Father, as they beget new children for the kingdom through baptism (p.129)." This week in his reflection on today's readings, Dr. Hahn would finish that thought by saying: "The fatherhood of...the Church's priests and bishops, is a spiritual paternity given to raise us as God's children. Our fathers give us new life in baptism, and feed us the spiritual milk of the gospel and the Eucharist." Very challenging indeed when I stop to think about my call to mirror the spiritual paternity of God our Father. It is a title that I do not take lightly, and I challenge for all of you not to take lightly either because it reminds my brother priests and I of the humble service that we have been called to and all the spiritual children that have been entrusted to our care.

When I am addressed as "Father," I am reminded that I am a flawed human being who has been called by God to this extraordinary vocation of being a priest. I know I have a lot to go when it comes to being a reflection of our Father in heaven. There are days where priesthood is a joyful struggle as we try to make the Word of God come alive for a people distracted by the world. It is difficult, but there is no greater life, and it is

your prayers that sustain us. We tend to forget that at Mass when the priest says, "This is my body which will be given up for you," he is not simply repeating the words of Christ or dramatically re-enacting them. He is acting in the person of Christ and offering up his own life, as Christ did, for the people he is about to feed. He is offering his own body and blood for the salvation of us all.

All of us are thankful for the priests who have fed us and absolved us through the years. When I was a young priest, I remember getting a note from a parishioner on Friday after a pretty exhausting week when my pastor and the other priests were off on retreat, and I had to basically celebrate the majority of the Masses that week. The note simply said: "Thank you for all the gifts of your priesthood this past week. Because of you, we were able to receive Jesus every day."

We are indeed thankful and are truly blessed that we have an abundance of priests in this parish who feed us at this altar every single day. Yet while so many of you thank us for being priests, it is I who must thank all of you for allowing me to serve you at this altar and beyond as a priest of our Lord Jesus Christ and for serving as your pastor. You remind me every day, even on the difficult ones, of how richly blessed I am and how much I still need to go to be the perfect reflection of Our Father in heaven. That is why on this day, and every day, I ask you: never cease to pray for your priests. And pray for vocations as well because you never know: there may be a young man sitting in our midst that we will one day call "Father."

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis queridos amigos,

En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús les dice a los discípulos: "No llames a nadie en la tierra tu padre". No lo dice literalmente, porque simplemente está advirtiendo a los discípulos sobre el sentimiento de superioridad que los fariseos habían adquirido sobre todos los títulos que les gustaba que se les llamara. Para mí, el título de "padre" nunca me ha hecho sentir superior, sino que ha sido un desafío y un recordatorio de la increíble responsabilidad que el Buen Dios me ha dado al llamarme a ser su sacerdote. Es un desafío ser humilde, desinteresado y un servidor por encima de todo. "El más grande entre nosotros debe ser nuestro siervo". Jesús nos recuerda esto en el evangelio de hoy, pero como sacerdote me lo recordaron el día de mi ordenación cuando me postré en el suelo de la catedral. Por encima de todo, debo ser tu sirviente.

En el verano de 2010, mientras hacía mi primera peregrinación a Roma, leí un gran libro del erudito bíblico Scott Hahn sobre los orígenes bíblicos del sacerdocio titulado, "Muchos son llamados: Redescubriendo la gloria del sacerdocio". El Dr. Hahn se hace eco de las palabras de Jesús en el evangelio de hoy de que tenemos un Padre en el cielo, pero lo que este gran erudito dijo a continuación realmente me conmovió: "La paternidad perfecta [de Dios el Padre] es un acto espiritual. Los sacerdotes célibes son imágenes vivas y vivificantes de Dios Padre, ya que engendran nuevos hijos para el reino a través del bautismo (p.129)". Esta semana, en su reflexión sobre las lecturas de hoy, el Dr. Hahn terminaría ese pensamiento diciendo: "La paternidad de... sacerdotes y obispos de la Iglesia, es una paternidad espiritual dada para criarnos como hijos de Dios. Nuestros padres nos dan nueva vida en el bautismo y nos alimentan con la leche espiritual del Evangelio y de la Eucaristía". Es muy desafiante cuando me detengo a pensar en mi llamado a reflejar la paternidad espiritual de Dios nuestro Padre. Es un título que no tomo a la ligera, y desafío a todos ustedes a que tampoco lo tomen a la ligera, porque nos recuerda a mis hermanos sacerdotes y a mí el humilde servicio al que hemos sido llamados y a todos los hijos espirituales que han sido confiados a nuestro cuidado.

Cuando se dirigen a mí como "Padre", se me recuerda que soy un ser humano imperfecto que ha sido llamado por Dios a esta extraordinaria vocación de ser sacerdote. Sé que tengo mucho por hacer cuando se trata de ser un reflejo de nuestro Padre Celestial. Hay días en los que el sacerdocio es una lucha gozosa mientras tratamos de hacer que la Palabra de Dios cobre vida para un pueblo distraído por el mundo. Es difícil, pero no hay vida más

grande, y son sus oraciones las que nos sostienen. Tendemos a olvidar que, en la Misa, cuando el sacerdote dice: "Este es mi cuerpo, que será entregado por vosotros", no está simplemente repitiendo las palabras de Cristo o recreándolas dramáticamente. Está actuando en la persona de Cristo y ofreciendo su propia vida, como lo hizo Cristo, por las personas que está a punto de alimentar. Él está ofreciendo su propio cuerpo y sangre por la salvación de todos nosotros.

Todos estamos agradecidos por los sacerdotes que nos han alimentado y absuelto a lo largo de los años. Cuando era un sacerdote joven, recuerdo haber recibido una nota de un feligrés el viernes después de una semana bastante agotadora en la que mi párroco y los otros sacerdotes estaban de retiro, y básicamente tuve que celebrar la mayoría de las misas esa semana. La nota simplemente decía: "Gracias por todos los dones de su sacerdocio la semana pasada. Gracias a ti, pudimos recibir a Jesús todos los días".

De hecho, estamos agradecidos V verdaderamente bendecidos de tener una gran cantidad de sacerdotes en esta parroquia que nos alimentan en este altar todos los días. Sin embargo, aunque muchos de ustedes nos agradecen por ser sacerdotes, soy yo quien debe agradecerles a todos ustedes por permitirme servirles en este altar y más allá como sacerdote de nuestro Señor Jesucristo y por servir como su pastor. Me recuerdan todos los días, incluso en los difíciles, lo ricamente bendecido que soy y lo mucho que aún necesito ir para ser el reflejo perfecto de Nuestro Padre en el cielo. Por eso, en este día, y todos los días, pidan: no dejéis nunca de rezar por vuestros sacerdotes. Y oren también por las vocaciones, porque nunca se sabe: puede haber un joven sentado en medio de nosotros al que un día llamaremos "Padre".

Centennial Project Updates

A final selection has been made for the solid wood that will be used for the new pews. We hope to have a model pew on display in the vestibule by the end of the year, showing the new pew design at full scale.

Acoustical testing was recently completed inside the church and results of that will give us key insights into the final specifications needed for the new pipe organ to "fill the room" appropriately. Design work continues on both the decorative case work and on the scale model at the CB Fisk workshop.


STS multipurpose center plans continue to work their way through the City of Coral Gables review process. In the meantime, the ADOM Building Department has begun the process for selecting a Project Management firm to oversee construction once those plans are approved and sufficient funds are raised.

Fundraising momentum continues to grow and it's been a GREAT first month since the campaign was announced! Over \$5 Million have already been pledged by less than 10% of our registered church and school families, but gifts and pledges continue to be made daily.
