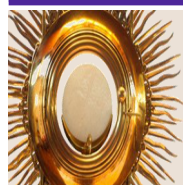

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends:

As we continue this month of November dedicated to prayer for our faithful departed, I offer you this reflection on today's readings given 12 years ago by our dearly departed Pope Benedict XVI. I ask you to pay particular attention to the second reading today:

The Biblical Readings of this Sunday's Liturgy invite us to extend the reflection on eternal life that we began on the occasion of the commemoration of the faithful departed. On this point there is a clear difference between those who believe and those who do not believe or, one might likewise say, between those who hope and those who do not hope.

Indeed St Paul wrote to the Thessalonians: "but we would not have you ignorant, brethren, concerning those who are asleep, that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope" (1 Thess 4:13). Faith in the death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ in this sphere too is a crucial divide. St Paul always reminded the Christians of Ephesus that before accepting the Good News they had been "separated from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world" (Eph 2:12). Indeed the religion of the Greeks, the pagan cults and myths, were unable to shed light on the mystery of death; thus an ancient inscription said: "In nihil ab nihilo quam cito recidimus" which means: "how quickly we fall back from nothing to nothing". If we remove God, we remove Christ and the world falls back into emptiness and darkness. Moreover, this is also confirmed in the expressions of contemporary nihilism that is often unconscious and, unfortunately, infects a great many young people.

Today's Gospel is a famous parable that speaks of ten maidens invited to a wedding feast, a symbol of the Kingdom of Heaven and of eternal life (Mt 25:1-13). It is a happy image with which, however, Jesus teaches a truth that calls us into

question. In fact five of those 10 maidens were admitted to the feast because when the bridegroom arrived they had brought the oil to light their lamps, whereas the other five were left outside because they had been foolish enough not to bring any. What is represented by this "oil", the indispensable prerequisite for being admitted to the nuptial banquet?

St Augustine (cf. Discourses 93, 4), and other ancient authors interpreted it as a symbol of love that one cannot purchase but receives as a gift, preserves within one and uses in works. True wisdom is making the most of mortal life in order to do works of mercy, for after death this will no longer be possible. When we are reawoken for the Last Judgement, it will be made on the basis of the love we have shown in our earthly life (cf. Mt 25:31-46). And this love is a gift of Christ, poured out in us by the Holy Spirit. Those who believe in God-Love bear within them invincible hope, like a lamp to light them on their way through the night beyond death to arrive at the great feast of life.

Let us ask Mary, Sedes Sapientiae, to teach us true wisdom, the wisdom that became flesh in Jesus. He is the Way that leads from this life to God, to the Eternal One. He enabled us to know the Father's face, and thus gave us hope full of love. This is why the Church addresses the Mother of the Lord with these words: "Vita, dulcedo, et spes nostra" [our life, our sweetness and our hope]. Let us learn from her to live and die in the hope that never disappoints.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis queridos amigos,

En este mes de noviembre rezamos particularmente por nuestros fieles difuntos. Les ofrezco esta reflexión de nuestro querido recién fallecido Papa Benedicto XVI que compartió estas palabras sabias sobre las lecturas de hoy hace 12 años. Presten atención a la sabiduría de la segunda lectura particularmente:

Las lecturas bíblicas de la liturgia de este domingo nos invitan a prolongar la reflexión sobre la vida eterna, iniciada con ocasión de la Conmemoración de todos los fieles difuntos. Sobre este punto es neta la diferencia entre quien cree y quien no cree, o — se podría igualmente decir — entre quien espera y quien no espera. San Pablo escribe a los Tesalonicenses: «No queremos que ignoréis la suerte de los difuntos para que no os aflijáis como los que no tienen esperanza» (1 Ts 4, 13). La fe en la muerte y resurrección de Jesucristo marca, también en este campo, un momento decisivo. Asimismo, san Pablo recuerda a los cristianos de Éfeso que, antes de acoger la Buena Nueva, estaban «sin esperanza y sin Dios en el mundo» (Ef 2, 12). De hecho, la religión de los griegos, los cultos y los mitos paganos no podían iluminar el misterio de la muerte, hasta el punto de que una antigua inscripción decía: «In nihil ab nihilo quam cito recidimus», que significa: «¡Qué pronto volvemos a caer de la nada a la nada!». Si quitamos a Dios, si quitamos a Cristo, el mundo vuelve a caer en el vacío y en la oscuridad. Y esto se puede constatar también en las expresiones del nihilismo contemporáneo, un nihilismo a menudo inconsciente que lamentablemente contagia a muchos jóvenes.

El Evangelio de hoy es una célebre parábola, que habla de diez muchachas invitadas a una fiesta de bodas, símbolo del reino de los cielos, de la vida eterna (cf. Mt 25, 1-13). Es una imagen feliz, con la que sin embargo Jesús enseña una verdad que nos hace reflexionar; de hecho, de aquellas diez muchachas, cinco entran en la fiesta, porque, a la llegada del esposo, tienen aceite para encender

sus lámparas; mientras que las otras cinco se quedan fuera, porque, necias, no han llevado aceite. ¿Qué representa este «aceite», indispensable para ser admitidos al banquete nupcial? San Agustín (cf. Discursos 93, 4) y otros autores antiguos leen en él un símbolo del amor, que no se puede comprar, sino que se recibe como don, se conserva en lo más íntimo y se practica en las obras. Aprovechar la vida mortal para realizar obras de misericordia es verdadera sabiduría, porque, después de la muerte, eso ya no será posible. Cuando nos despierten para el juicio final, este se realizará según el amor practicado en la vida terrena (cf. Mt 25, 31-46). Y este amor es don de Cristo, derramado en nosotros por el Espíritu Santo. Quien cree en Dios-Amor lleva en sí una esperanza invencible, como una lámpara para atravesar la noche más allá de la muerte, y llegar a la gran fiesta de la vida.

A María, Sedes Sapientiae, pidamos que nos enseñe la verdadera sabiduría, la que se hizo carne en Jesús. Él es el camino que conduce de esta vida a Dios, al Eterno. Él nos ha dado a conocer el rostro del Padre, y así nos ha donado una esperanza llena de amor. Por esto, la Iglesia se dirige a la Madre del Señor con estas palabras: «Vita, dulcedo, et spes nostra». Aprendamos de ella a vivir y morir en la esperanza que no defrauda.

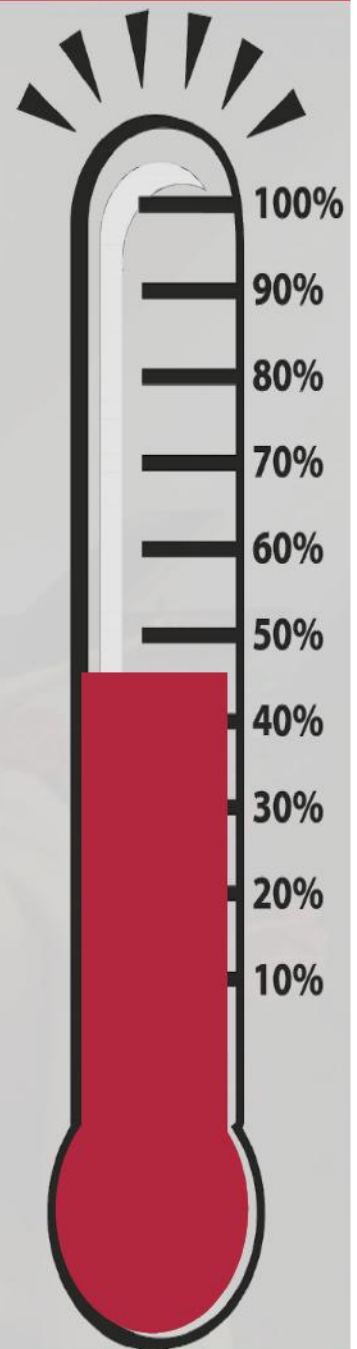

HOMELESS MINISTRY COLLECTION DRIVE

During the month of September we will be collecting the following items that will be delivered directly to the Missionaries of Charity shelter in Miami's inner city:

-Category 1, Food: Canned & Dry Non-Perishable Foods (ideally large canned items from Gordon Food Service that could be used to stock up the Missionaries of Charity's kitchen pantry. They feed hundreds of homeless a day through their kitchen located in the shelter). Desired donations include large cans of tomato sauces, pastas, rice bags, green beans, corn and other canned vegetables. Also they can use iced tea powder, small sugar packets and instant coffee. We will also like to collect sliced bread, peanut butter and jelly for sandwiches as well as cases of bottled water.

-Category 2, Women's Hygiene & Toiletry Items: women's deodorant, soap bars, shampoo, shaving cream, cleansing wipes, disposable razors, body lotions, combs/hair brushes, toothpaste and toothbrushes. (Please make sure they are not travel sized items)

-Category 3, Cleaning Supplies: kitchen dish soap, degreaser, clorox/bleach, disinfectant spray and hand sanitizer.

-Category 4, Clothing: Men's and Women's Underwear (any size)

All items can be dropped off ONLY during the following weekend masses at the Homeless Ministry Collection Area inside the church:

Saturday, November 11, 2023 (Evening Mass) • Sunday, November 12, 2023 (All Sunday Masses)
