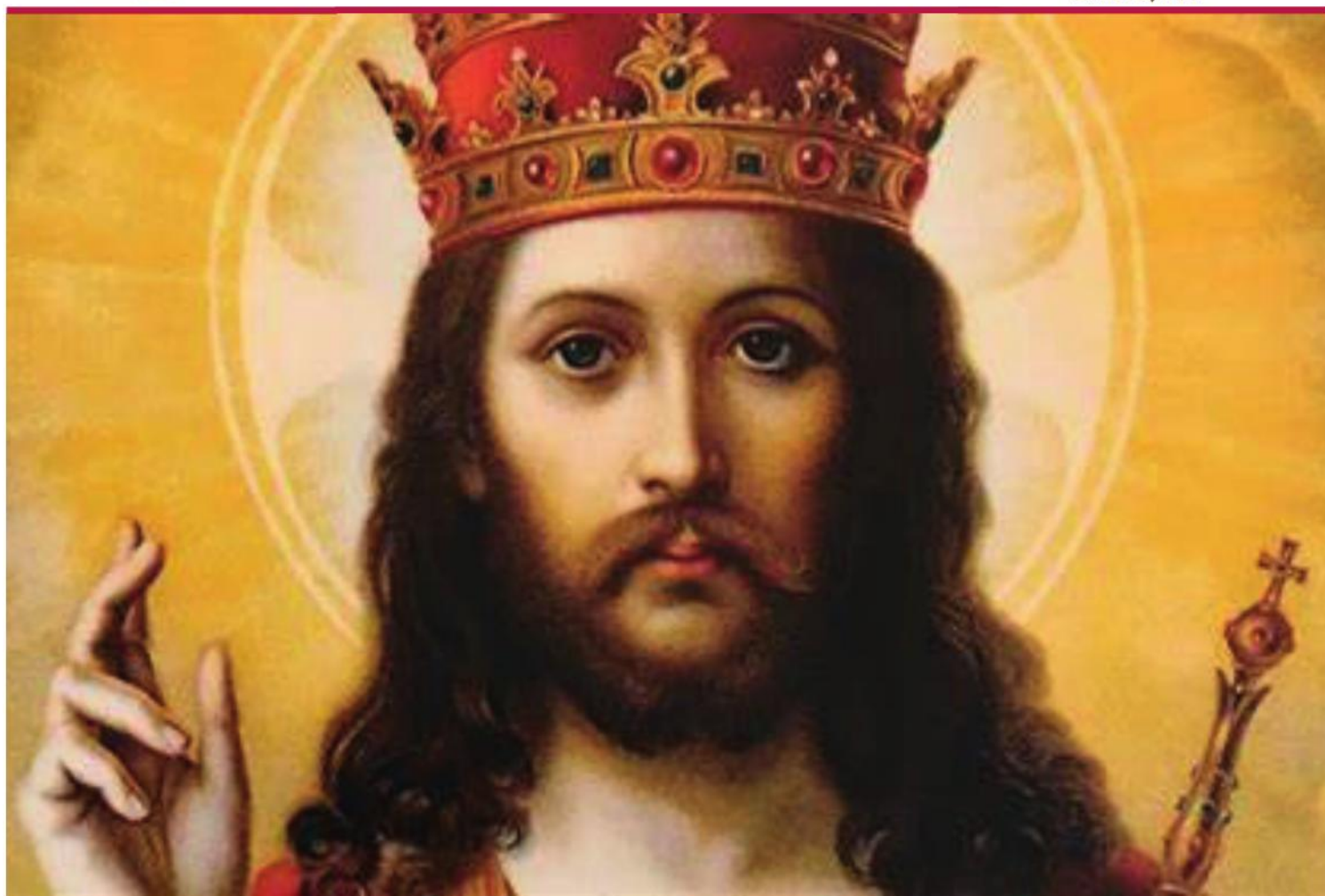

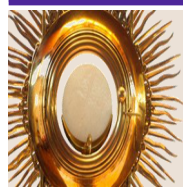

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends:

Today the Universal Church gathers to celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King. It puts a fitting and definitive punctuation on the liturgical year as we declare with one voice that Christ is indeed the King of the Universe. This solemnity is a challenge for each of us as we ask ourselves: "Is Christ truly the king of my heart and of every facet of my life?" Close to a century ago, Pope Pius XI instituted the Solemnity of Christ the King to counteract growing secularism in the world. We look around us and see that things have not changed much. Secularism continues to be the main ideology prevalent throughout the world with all of its many branches, and God no longer occupies his rightful throne in the human heart. Aside from asking our ourselves the question of the kingship of Christ in our lives, we must also use this day to pray for Christ to be enthroned again above everything on this earth. Humanity must turn to him who is "the Way, the Truth, and the Life," for when Christ ceases to be the center of our lives and the true King of our lives, then things truly start to come apart. May Christ reign always in our hearts, our family, our homes, and our Church, and may our voices join those courageous martyrs who died yelling, "Viva Cristo, Rey!"

This week we also celebrate our annual Parish Fair. It is a wonderful opportunity to gather together to build community, catch up with old friends, and meet new ones. 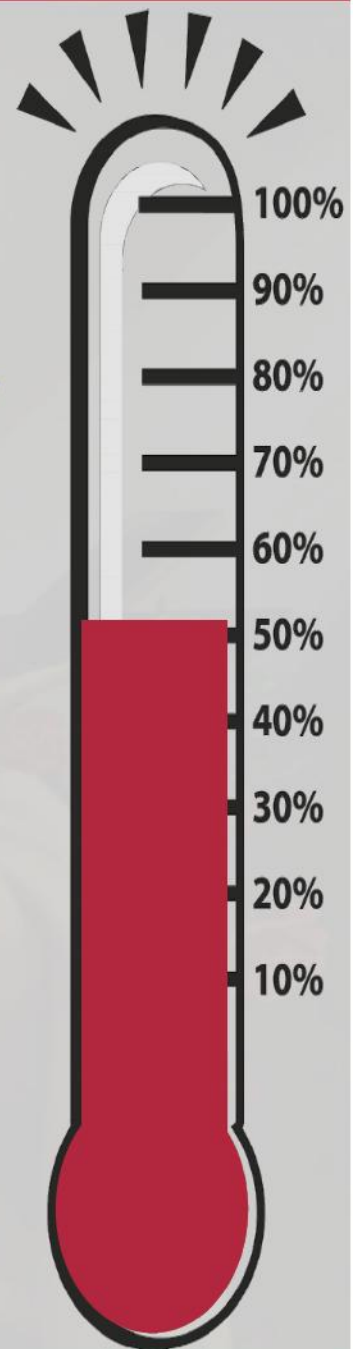

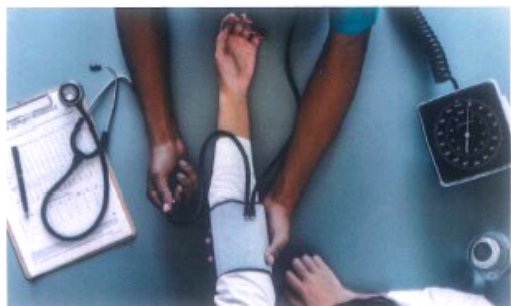
DONATE GIFTS TO THE COTLF GIVING TREE

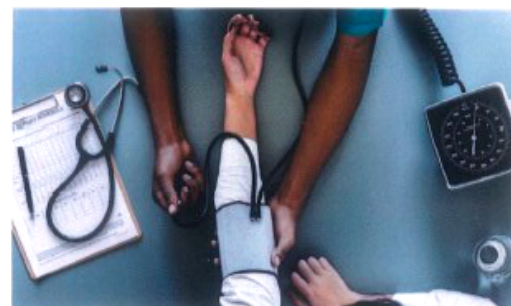

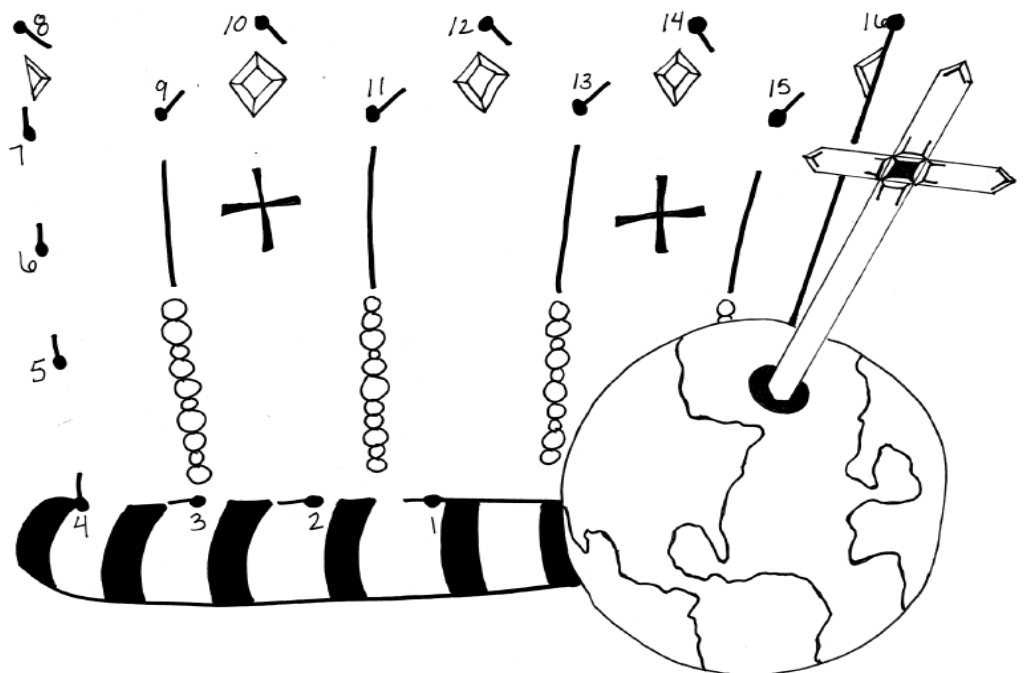
