# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

This weekend the children of our parish begin receiving their First Holy Communion. It is a blessed time in the life of our parish, and I ask you pray for these little ones as they approach the altar for the first time.

Do you remember the experience of your First Communion? If you look up to the left narthex of our church, you can see stained glass of "The First Communion of the Little Flower." St. Therese recalled quite vividly that special day in her autobiography which I share with you so that you can meditate on the importance of this day:

At last the most wonderful day of my life arrived, and I can remember every tiny detail of those heavenly hours: my joyous waking up at dawn, the tender, reverent kisses of the mistresses and older girls, the room where we dressed — filled with the white "snowflakes" in which one after another we were clothed — and above all, our entry into chapel and the singing of the morning hymn: "O Altar of God, Where the Angels are Hovering."

I would not tell you everything, even if I could, for there are certain things which lose their fragrance in the open air, certain thoughts so intimate that they cannot be translated into earthly language without losing at once their deep and heavenly meaning. How lovely it was, that first kiss of Jesus in my heart — it was truly a kiss of love. I knew that I was loved and said, "I love You, and I give myself to You forever."

Jesus asked for nothing, He claimed no sacrifice. Long before that, He and little Thérèse had seen and understood one another well, but on that day it was more than a meeting - it was a complete fusion. We were no longer two, for Thérèse had disappeared like a drop of water lost in the mighty ocean. Jesus alone remained — the Master and the King. Had she not asked Him to take away her liberty, the liberty she feared? She felt so weak and frail that she wanted to unite herself forever to His Divine Strength. And her joy became so vast, so deep, that now it overflowed. Soon she was weeping, to the astonishment of her companions, who said to one another later on: "Why did she cry? Was there something on her conscience? Perhaps it was because her mother was not there, or the Carmelite sister she loves so much."

It was beyond them that all the joy of Heaven had entered one small, exiled heart, and that it was too frail and weak to bear it without tears. As if the absence of my mother could make me unhappy on the day of my First Communion! As all Heaven entered my soul when I received Jesus, my mother came to me as well. Nor could I cry because you were not there, we were closer than ever before. It was joy alone, deep ineffable joy that filled my heart.

That afternoon I was chosen to read the "Act of Consecration to Our Lady." I suppose they chose me because I had lost my earthly mother so young. Anyway, I put my whole heart into it and begged Our Lady to guard me always. I felt sure she was looking at me with that lovely smile which had cured me and delivered me, and I knew all I owed her; for it was she herself, that morning of the 8th of May, who placed Jesus in my soul, "the flower of the field and the lily of the valley."

When evening came that lovely day, Father led his little queen by the hand to Carmel, and there I saw you made the bride of Christ. I saw your veil, all white like mine, and your crown of roses. There was no bitterness in all my joy, for I hoped to join you and wait for Heaven at your side.

I was very moved by the family feast prepared at Les Buissonets and delighted with the little watch which Father gave me. Yet my happiness was very tranquil, with an inward peace no earthly thing could touch. Night came at last to end my lovely evening, for darkness falls even on the brightest day. Only the first day of Communion in Eternity will never end. (Excerpt from "Story of A Soul" by St. Therese of Lisieux)

The children of our parish get to partake in the foretaste of eternity starting this weekend. May we approach the altar for Holy Communion with the innocence and faith of St. Therese and of our children who look beyond everything and only see the "Master and the King."

# DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

Este fin de semana, los niños de nuestra parroquia empiezan a recibir su Primera Comunion. Es una epoca bella en la vida de nuestra parroquia y les ruego que rezen por estas criaturas pequeñas que se acercan al altar por primera vez.

Acaso se acuerdan de su Primera Comunion? Se alzan los ojos a la izquierda de nuestra iglesia esta el hermoso vitral de "La Comunion de la Pequeña Flor." Santa Teresita en su autobiografía recuerda con lujo de detalle el dia de su Primera Comunion y le ofrezco a su meditación estas lineas de nuestra patrona para que mediten sobre la importancia de este día:

Finamente llegó el más hermoso de los días. ¡Qué inefables recuerdos han dejado en mi alma hasta los más pequeños detalles de esta jornada de cielo...! El gozoso despertar de la aurora, los besos respetuosos y tiernos de las profesoras y de las compañeras mayores... La gran sala repleta de copos de nieve, con los que nos iban vistiendo a las niñas una tras otra. Y sobre todo, la entrada en la capilla y el precioso canto matinal «¡Oh altar sagrado, que rodean los ángeles!»

Pero no quiero entrar en detalles. Hay cosas que si se exponen al aire pierden su perfume, y hay sentimientos del alma que no pueden traducirse al lenguaje de la tierra sin que pierdan su sentido íntimo y celestial. Son como aquella «piedra blanca que se dará al vencedor, en la que hay escrito un nombre nuevo que sólo conoce el que la recibe».

¡Qué dulce fue el primer beso de Jesús a mi alma...! Fue un beso de amor. Me sentía amada, y decía a mi vez: «Te amo y me entrego a ti para siempre».

No hubo preguntas, ni luchas, ni sacrificios. Desde hacía mucho tiempo, Jesús y la pobre Teresita se habían mirado y se habían comprendido... Aquel día no fue ya una mirada, sino una fusión. Ya no eran dos: Teresa había desaparecido como la gota de agua que se pierde en medio del océano. Sólo quedaba Jesús, él era el dueño, el rey. ¿No le había pedido Teresa que le quitara su libertad, pues su libertad le daba miedo? ¡Se sentía tan débil, tan frágil, que quería unirse para siempre a la Fuerza divina...!

Su alegría era demasiado grande y demasiado profunda para poder contenerla. Pronto la inundaron lágrimas deliciosas, con gran asombro de sus compañeras, que más tarde comentaban entre ellas: «-¿Por qué lloraba? ¿Habría algo que la atormentaba? -No, sería porque no tenía a su madre a su lado, o a su hermana la carmelita a la

que tanto quiere». No comprendían que cuando toda la alegría del cielo baja a un corazón, este corazón desterrado no puede soportarlo sin deshacerse en lágrimas...

Por la tarde, fui yo la encargada de pronunciar el acto de consagración a la Santísima Virgen. Era justo que yo, que había sido privada tan joven de la madre de la tierra, hablase en nombre de mis compañeras a mi Madre del cielo. Puse toda mi alma al hablarle y al consagrarme a ella, como una niña que se arroja en los brazos de su Madre y le pide que vele por ella. Y creo que la Santísima Virgen debió de mirar a su florecita y sonreírle. ¿No la había curado ella con su sonrisa visible...? ¿No había ella depositado en el cáliz de su florecita a su Jesús, la Flor de los campos y el Lirio de los valles...?

Al atardecer de aquel hermoso día, volví a encontrarme con mi familia de la tierra. Ya por la mañana, después de Misa, había abrazado a papá y a todos mis queridos parientes. Pero ahora fue la verdadera reunión. Papá, tomando de la mano a su reinecita, se dirigió al Carmelo... Allí vi a mi Paulina, convertida en esposa de Cristo. La vi con su velo, blanco como el mío, y con su corona de rosas... ¡Fue una alegría sin amarguras! ¡Esperaba reunirme pronto con ella, y esperar juntas el cielo!

No fui insensible a la fiesta de familia que tuvo lugar en aquel atardecer de mi primera comunión. El precioso reloj que me regaló mi rey me gustó muchísimo. Pero mi alegría era serena, y nada vino a turbar mi paz interior.

María me acostó con ella la noche que siguió a aquel hermoso día, pues a los días más radiantes les sigue la oscuridad, y sólo el día de la primera, de la única, [36ro] de la eterna comunión del cielo será un día sin ocaso... ("Historia de Un Alma" de Santa Teresita de Lisieux)

Los niños de nuestra parroquia empiezan a probar este delícia eterna este fin de semana. Que todos podamos acercarnos al altar para comulgar con la misma Inocencia y fe de Santa Teresita y de nuestros niños que miran mas alla de lo que se ve y solamente contemplan a su "Maestro y Rey."





# HOMELESS MINISTRY COLLECTION DRIVE

The COTLF Homeless Minsistry will be collecting the following items that will be delivered directly to the Missionaries of Charity shelter in Miami's inner city:

-Category 1, Food: Canned & Dry Non-Perishable Foods (ideally large canned items from Gordon Food Service that could be used to stock up the Missionaries of Charity's kitchen pantry. They feed hundreds of homeless a day through their kitchen located in the shelter). Desired donations include large cans of tomato sauces, pastas, rice bags, green beans, corn and other canned vegetables.

Also they can use iced tea powder, small sugar packets and instant coffee. We will also like to collect sliced bread, peanut butter and jelly for sandwiches as well as cases of bottled water.

-Category 2, Women's Hygiene & Toiletry Items: women's deodorant, soap bars, shampoo, shaving cream, cleansing wipes, disposable razors, body lotions, combs/hair brushes, toothpaste and toothbrushes. (Please make sure they are not travel sized items)

-Category 3, Cleaning Supplies: kitchen dish soap, degreaser, clorox/bleach, disinfectant spray and hand sanitizer.

All items can be dropped off ONLY during the following weekend masses at the Homeless Ministry Collection Area inside the church:

Saturday, April 13, 2024 (Evening Mass) • Sunday, April 14, 2024 (All Sunday Masses) Saturday, April 20, 2024 (Evening Mass) • Sunday, April 21, 2024 (All Sunday Masses)

### In-Person Saturday Service Day

Come volunteer with us on Saturday, May 4, 2024 from 8:00am-11:30am in commemoration of the First Saturday Devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. We will come together to participate in the 8:00am daily mass at Church of the Little Flower. After the mass, we will head to the Missionaries of Charity shelter to provide a helping hand with various tasks around the facility, including the feeding of hundreds of homeless men and women. We will then wrap up our service day with a group rosary at the shelter.


