FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

As we begin the month of May, the month of our Blessed Mother, I wanted to give the community an update on our Centennial Campaign. A few weeks ago, a parishioner approached me after Mass and astutely pointed out that the thermometer on our weekly campaign updates has not moved much in the last few months. God bless him because he asked how he could help. I explained to him that it had not moved much because at the beginning of the year the parish was focused on the ABCD campaign, making sure we were fulfilling our yearly obligation to the charities of our local church. I did point out that after an initial big and generous push when the campaign was launched in October, we have essentially been stalled since Christmas. I'll return to moving the thermometer later in this column, but first a few important updates of what we have accomplished "behind the scenes" since October.

The Multi-Purpose Center for the school has undergone some significant changes since the initial conceptual renderings we shared with you in our first Centennial Campaign booklet. We have hired a project manager to oversee the preparation phase and, eventually, the construction phase. In the last few months, we have also had several productive meetings with the City of Coral Gables Development Review Committee, which have been helpful in fine-tuning the look and feel of the building. As many of you know, building something in the City Beautiful is not for the faint of heart. We want to construct a beautiful building that mirrors our historic buildings on campus while also being good stewards of the gifts given by all of you. The current architectural designs that Sister Rosalie and I were presented with last week are stunning, and we cannot wait to share them with all of you when they are finalized and ready for final approval.

For the work inside the church, the contract for the beautiful new pipe organ has now been signed! The organ is now beginning construction at the CB Fisk workshop in New England and well on its way to, God-willing, be installed here in the church in early 2026. Over the next few months, we will be working with Fisk to finalize the design of the organ facade in the scale model. It is our hope to have that scale model of the organ on display in our vestibule once that phase of the project has been completed, as it will help us all to envision just how beautifully the organ will fit and look in the music balcony. And speaking of models: two months ago, many of you noticed the new pew sample that has been in the vestibule, and your response has been so positive. We hope to sign that contract for the pews soon so we can lock in the price and have them installed in the summer of 2025 because our current pews are deteriorating at a rapid rate.

Back to the thermometer. As you noticed in the paragraphs above, contracts have been signed, project managers, along with architects, engineers, and a wide range of people to help us in this bold endeavor have all now been hired. Suffice it to say: the bills are coming in quickly. Luckily up to now, we have collected sufficient funds to cover these numerous expenses. However, these expenses will continue to grow once we put a shovel in the ground for the Multi-Purpose Center, and once we start making monthly payments to the organ company, pew builders, and other contractors later this year. So, we need to start moving that thermometer!

To illustrate the point of the parishioner who approached me who did not notice much movement, we only moved from \$7,403,471 on New Year's Day to \$7,966,087 as of this weekend's update. Yes, that is an increase of over \$500,000 but remember that it is just pledges. We have only collected \$2,322,111, and one million of that came from the savings pledged from the parish and school. Yes, it is a lot of money that we've pledged and collected since October, and quite admirable in just seven months, but now we need to pick up the pace of the campaign as we are officially in "action mode." I beg you to please make a pledge to the Centennial Campaign if you have not already done so. If you made a pledge and have yet to start giving, we urgently need you to come through on your pledge and start making contributions, whether weekly, monthly, or quarterly. Several parishioners have generously increased their already substantial pledges after prayer and reflection, inspired by the vision, scope and magnitude of these projects that we want to complete for our 100th anniversary.

The theme of this campaign is "Building On Our Legacy." It is my prayer as your pastor that every parishioner contributes a grain of sand to these projects so we can leave this parish a lasting legacy for future generations. Yes, some grains are larger than others, but what is most important is not comparing your gift to that of others; it is making a sacrificial gift that is reflective of your commitment to our beloved parish community, church and school. I thank each and every person who has been so generous so far and pray that many more will contribute, starting today, so that Little Flower may continue to glorify God for centuries to come. We commend this endeavor to our Blessed Mother during her month and ask for her maternal protection as we continue to build up her Son's kingdom here on earth: to Christ be the glory forever and ever!

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

A comenzar el mes de mayo, el mes de nuestra Santísima Madre, quería darle a la comunidad una actualización sobre nuestra Campaña del Centenario. Hace unas semanas, un feligrés se acercó después de la misa y me señaló astutamente que el termómetro de nuestras actualizaciones semanales de campaña no se ha movido mucho en los últimos meses. Que Dios lo bendiga porque preguntó cómo podía ayudar. Le expliqué que no se había movido mucho porque a principios de año la parroquia estaba enfocada en la campaña de ABCD, asegurándose de que estábamos cumpliendo con nuestra obligación anual con las organizaciones benéficas de nuestra iglesia local. Señalé que después de un gran y generoso impulso inicial cuando se lanzó la campaña en octubre, esencialmente hemos estado estancados desde Navidad. Volveré a mover el termómetro más adelante en esta columna, pero primero algunas actualizaciones importantes de lo que hemos logrado "detrás de la escena" desde octubre.

El Centro de Usos Múltiples de la escuela ha sufrido algunos cambios significativos desde las representaciones conceptuales iniciales que compartimos con ustedes en nuestro primer folleto de la Campaña del Centenario. Hemos contratado a un gerente de proyecto para supervisar la fase de preparación y, eventualmente, la fase de construcción. En los últimos meses, también hemos tenido varias reuniones productivas con el Comité de Revisión de Desarrollo de la Ciudad de Coral Gables, que han sido útiles para afinar la apariencia del edificio. Como muchos de ustedes saben, construir algo en la Ciudad Hermosa no es para los débiles de corazón. Queremos construir un hermoso edificio que refleje nuestros edificios históricos en el campus y, al mismo tiempo, ser buenos administradores de los regalos dados por todos ustedes. Los diseños arquitectónicos actuales que la Hermana Rosalie y yo recibimos la semana pasada son impresionantes, y estamos ansiosos por compartirlos con todos ustedes cuando estén finalizados y listos para su aprobación final.

Para el trabajo en el interior de la iglesia, ¡ya se ha firmado el contrato para el nuevo y hermoso órgano de tubos! El órgano está comenzando a construirse en el taller CB Fisk en Nueva Inglaterra y, si Dios quiere, está en camino de instalarse aquí en la iglesia a principios de 2026. Durante los próximos meses, trabajaremos con Fisk para finalizar el diseño de la fachada del órgano en el modelo a escala. Esperamos tener ese modelo a escala del órgano en exhibición en nuestro vestíbulo una vez que se haya completado esa fase del proyecto, ya que nos ayudará a todos a imaginar lo bien que encajará y se verá el órgano en el balcón de la música. Y hablando de modelos: hace dos meses, muchos de ustedes notaron la nueva muestra de bancos que ha estado en el vestíbulo, y su respuesta ha sido muy positiva. Esperamos firmar ese contrato para los bancos pronto para poder fijar el precio e instalarlos en el verano de 2025 porque nuestros bancos actuales se están deteriorando a un ritmo rápido.

Volvamos al termómetro. Como notó en los párrafos anteriores, se han firmado contratos, se han contratado gerentes de proyectos, junto con arquitectos, ingenieros y una amplia gama de personas para ayudarnos en este audaz esfuerzo. Baste decir que las facturas están llegando rápidamente. Afortunadamente, hasta ahora, hemos recaudado fondos suficientes para cubrir estos numerosos gastos. Sin embargo, estos gastos continuarán creciendo una vez que pongamos una pala en el suelo para el Centro de Usos Múltiples, y una vez que comencemos a hacer pagos mensuales a la compañía de órganos, constructores de bancos y otros contratistas a finales de este año. Entonces, ¡tenemos que empezar a mover ese termómetro!

Para ilustrar el punto del feligrés que se acercó a mí y que no notó mucho movimiento, solo pasamos de \$7,403,471 el día de Año Nuevo a \$7,966,087 a partir de la actualización de este fin de semana. Sí, ese es un aumento de más de \$500,000, pero recuerde que son solo promesas. Solo hemos recaudado \$2,322,111, y un millón de eso provino de los ahorros prometidos por la parroquia y la escuela. Sí, es mucho dinero que hemos prometido y recaudado desde octubre, y bastante admirable en solo siete meses, pero ahora tenemos que acelerar el ritmo de la campaña, ya que estamos oficialmente en "modo de acción". Les ruego que por favor se comprometan a la Campaña del Centenario si aún no lo han hecho. Si hiciste una promesa y aún no has comenzado a dar, necesitamos urgentemente que cumplas con tu promesa y comiences a hacer contribuciones, ya sea semanal, mensual o trimestralmente. Varios feligreses han aumentado generosamente sus ya sustanciales promesas después de la oración y la reflexión, inspirados por la visión, el alcance y la magnitud de estos proyectos que queremos completar para nuestro 100 aniversario.

El tema de esta campaña es "Construyendo Sobre Nuestro Legado". Es mi oración como su párroco que cada feligrés contribuya con un granito de arena a estos proyectos para que podamos dejar a esta parroquia un legado duradero para las generaciones futuras. Sí, algunos granos son más grandes que otros, pero lo más importante es no comparar tu regalo con el de los demás; Es hacer un regalo de sacrificio que refleja su compromiso con nuestra querida comunidad parroquial, iglesia y escuela. Agradezco a todas y cada una de las personas que han sido tan generosas hasta ahora y rezo para que muchas más contribuyan, a partir de hoy, para que Little Flower pueda continuar glorificando a Dios en los siglos venideros. Encomendamos este esfuerzo a nuestra Santísima Madre durante su mes y pedimos su protección maternal mientras continuamos construyendo el reino de su Hijo aquí en la tierra: ¡a Cristo sea la gloria por los siglos de los siglos.
