FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

Ten years ago this month, I led my first pilgrimage to Italy. Now while I had to Italy particularly Rome before, this time I was taking my parents who had never been and showing the greatness of the Eternal City to my friends and parishioners. Now anyone who has ever been on a pilgrimage with me knows that I tend to disappear every now and then to do what the Lord did and just be on my own and seek time of solitude and prayer. So apart from the tour, I entered countless churches, cathedrals, and basilicas. All of them were works of art, yet beyond the artistic treasures they contained, every time I walked into one of them, there was treasure that I looked for above all others: the tabernacle. For no matter how big or small the church, the greatest treasure it contained was reserved in that small box for in it was Jesus Christ himself. Take St. Peter's Basilica as an example. If you have been inside St. Peter's with its glorious architecture and marble floors, and Bernini's altar, and the high decorated ceilings, you get lost in the immensity of that structure. Or you just get plain lost. There are so many people, most of them tourists, who are part of guided tours that are having the basilica explained to them. They are taking pictures, posing for selfies with the statue of St. Peter, and as beautiful and wondrous and magnificent as this sublime edifice is...it is not a house of prayer. That is, unless you go to a small chapel to your right tucked away near the tomb of St. John Paul II where tourists are not allowed to enter. Two guards stand outside the chapel door to make sure you are going in to pray, and when you enter you find the Blessed Sacrament exposed in what is probably the most beautiful Blessed Sacrament chapel in the world. There are two nuns keeping vigil up front. There are maybe a dozen or so people inside, mostly priests and religious. No photos, no tours, no talking. Only silence in the presence of the Almighty, for he is really and truly present there. That presence, His presence, is what

we celebrate today on Corpus Christi. Jesus fed us, nourished us, and stayed with us.

The only Mass that I did not celebrate alone during that pilgrimage was on the Feast of St. Anthony of Padua. It is a big feast for Italians and I was invited to concelebrate with some Franciscan friars who insisted that I read the gospel in English but I declined fearing the "are you kidding me?" looks that I would get from the Italian faithful on such great a feast if they heard a foreign tongue. When the words of consecration came, I was struck by the Italian translation of what I say every day: "Prendete e mangiatene tutti (take this all of you and eat of it.)." The Italian word for "eat" is so much stronger and has so much more meaning within the Italian culture, "mangia," for it not only means to eat, but it means to eat until one is full and satisfied. I meditated on those Italian words for days when I would escape on my own. This is what Jesus desires when we approach his altar: to eat and be satisfied.

The Solemnity of Corpus Christi reminds us of two fundamental truths about our Catholic faith: that our Lord wants to feed us and that he wants to stay with us. All we need we find at this altar. We walk around this earth aimlessly looking for life, fulfillment, peace, and joy when all we have to do to get all of these is to walk into a church on Sunday. Embrace the gift that Christ gave us which was the gift of his very self in this Eucharist and hold it above all other treasures. Let us look for His Presence. Let us be fed by His hand until we are satisfied. Let us, like Jesus, become a gift for others, and let us take that gift of His presence out into the world.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

Este mes se cumplen diez años de mi primera peregrinación a Italia. Ahora bien, aunque antes había estado en Italia, particularmente en Roma, esta vez llevaba a mis padres que nunca habían estado y mostraba la grandeza de la Ciudad Eterna a mis amigos y feligreses. Ahora, cualquiera que haya estado en una peregrinación conmigo sabe que tiendo a desaparecer de vez en cuando para hacer lo que el Señor hizo y simplemente estar solo y buscar tiempo de soledad y oración. Así que, aparte del recorrido, entré en innumerables iglesias, catedrales y basílicas. Todas ellas eran obras de arte, pero más allá de los tesoros artísticos que contenían, cada vez que entraba en una de ellas, había un tesoro que buscaba por encima de todas las demás: el tabernáculo. Porque no importaba cuán grande o pequeña fuera la iglesia, el tesoro más grande que contenía estaba reservado en esa pequeña caja, porque en ella estaba Jesucristo mismo. La Basílica de San Pedro como ejemplo. Si has estado dentro de San Pedro, con su gloriosa arquitectura y sus suelos de mármol, y el altar de Bernini, y los altos techos decorados, te pierdes en la inmensidad de esa estructura. O simplemente te pierdes. Hay muchas personas, la mayoría de ellos turistas, que forman parte de visitas guiadas a las que se les está explicando la basílica. Están tomando fotos, posando para selfies con la estatua de San Pedro, y tan hermoso, maravilloso y magnífico como es este sublime edificio... No es una casa de oración. Es decir, a menos que vayas a una pequeña capilla a tu derecha, escondida cerca de la tumba de San Juan Pablo II, donde no se permite la entrada a los turistas. Dos guardias se paran afuera de la puerta de la capilla para asegurarse de que vas a rezar, y cuando entras encuentras el Santísimo Sacramento expuesto en lo que probablemente sea la capilla del Santísimo Sacramento más hermosa del mundo. Hay dos monjas vigilando al frente. Hay tal vez una docena de personas adentro, en su mayoría sacerdotes y religiosos. Nada de fotos, nada de visitas, nada de hablar. Solo silencio en la presencia del Todopoderoso, porque Él está real y verdaderamente presente allí. Esa presencia,

Su presencia, es lo que celebramos hoy en Corpus Christi. Jesús nos alimentó, nos nutrió y se quedó con nosotros.

La única misa que no celebré sola durante esa peregrinación fue en la fiesta de San Antonio de Padua. Es una gran fiesta para los italianos, y me invitaron a concelebrar con algunos frailes franciscanos que insistieron en que leyera el evangelio en inglés, pero me negué por temor a las miradas de "¿estás bromeando?" que recibiría de los fieles italianos en una fiesta tan grande si escucharan a un extranjero. Cuando llegaron las palabras de la consagración, me llamó la atención la traducción italiana de lo que digo todos los días: "Préndete e mangiatene tutti (tomen todos esto y coman de él)". La palabra italiana para "comer" es mucho más fuerte y tiene mucho más significado dentro de la cultura italiana, "mangia", porque no solo significa comer, sino que significa comer hasta que uno esté lleno y satisfecho. Medité en esas palabras italianas durante días en los que escapaba por mi cuenta. Esto es lo que Jesús desea cuando nos acercamos a su altar: para comer y estar satisfecho.

La solemnidad del Corpus Christi nos recuerda dos verdades fundamentales sobre nuestra fe católica: que el Señor quiere alimentarnos y que quiere quedarse con nosotros. Todo lo que necesitamos lo encontramos en el altar. Caminamos por esta tierra sin rumbo buscando vida, satisfacción, paz y gozo cuando todo lo que tenemos que hacer para conseguir todo eso es entrar en una iglesia el domingo. Abraza el don que Cristo nos dio, que fue el don de sí mismo en esta Eucaristía, y tenlo por encima de todos los demás tesoros. Busquemos Su Presencia. Dejémonos alimentar por Su mano hasta que estemos satisfechos. Que nosotros, como Jesús, nos convertimos en un regalo para los demás, y llevemos ese regalo de Su presencia al mundo.
