



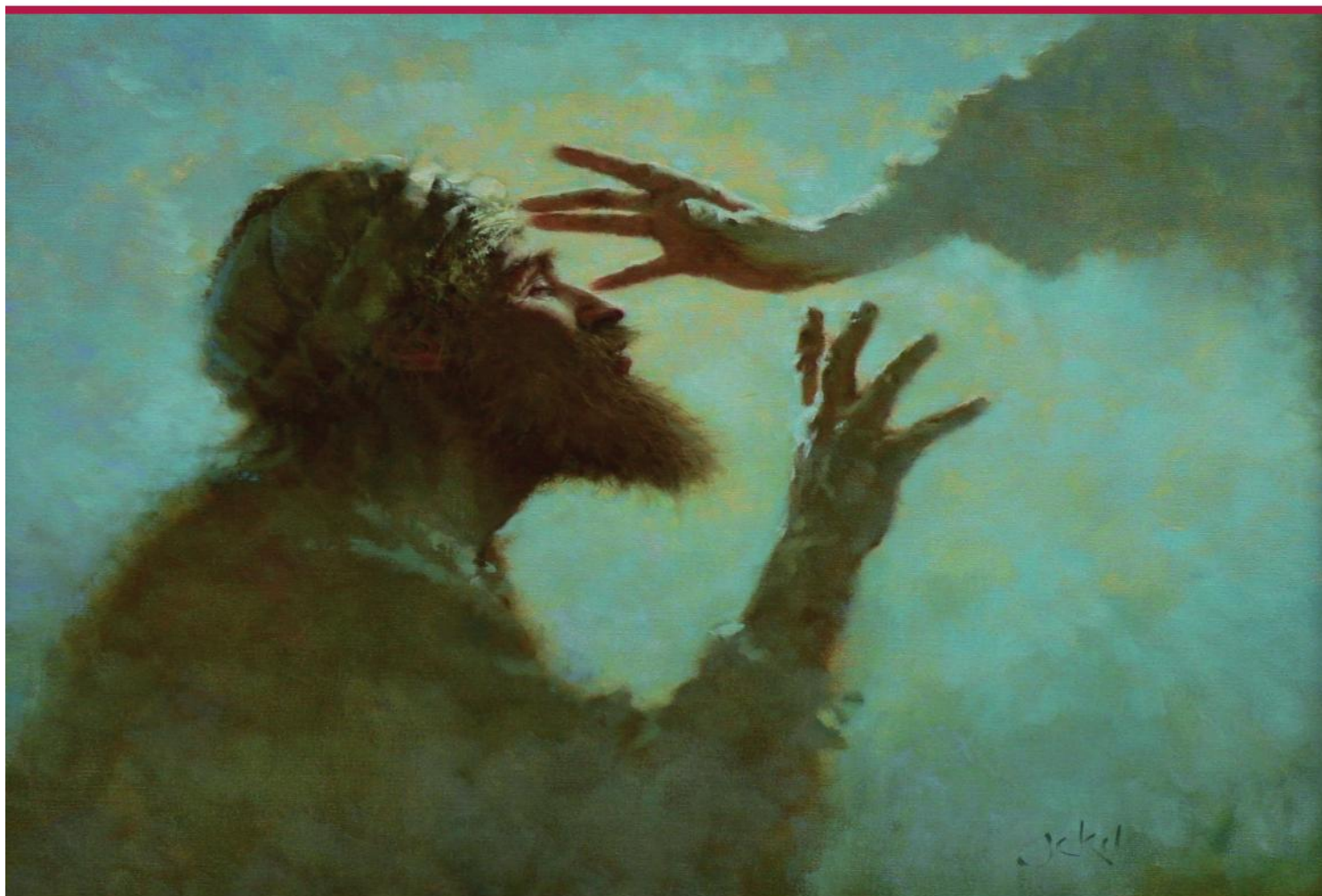

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### *My Dear Friends:*

As we get closer to Election Day, I am calling on this parish community to prayer especially when it comes to the defeat of Amendment 4 which if passed would enshrine abortion rights in our state constitution. Many of you did not hear my homily on Respect Life Sunday that I preached at the 10:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. Mass earlier this month. If I could offer some excerpts of my pastoral call to lift up our voices as a Catholic people:

*...the greatest ill of our society, the greatest consequence of this "hook up" culture here in our country is the wiping out of an entire generation of children because of the grave sin of abortion that is sold to us as health care and something convenient. Where children are seen as a burden that can easily be discarded like a piece of tissue instead of a gift. Satan, after all is the father of lies, and the biggest lie we can tell ourselves as Catholics is that we should "live and let live" or let others believe what they believe or "we shouldn't impose our beliefs on others." That type of cowardly thinking, yes, I used the word coward, has led to the erosion of marriage and the family and not the erosion but the erasure of 65 million tiny souls.*

*Christ tells us at the end of today's gospel, "Let the children come to me." But our society does not want them. Mother Teresa once famously said about unwanted children: "Give that child to me. I want it. I will care for it. I am willing to accept any child who would be aborted and to give that child to a married couple who will love the child and be loved by the child." Notice how she also exalts the sacrament of marriage knowing how many couples struggle to conceive and are open to adopting a baby. She also understands that "marriage is the great protector of unborn human life."*

*We cannot, as a believing people stand idly by as this "culture of death" that St. John Paul II talked about continues to destroy our nation. This is why it is imperative that we rise up as Catholics and vote NO on Amendment 4 that is on our ballots next month. Archbishop Wenski wrote in a column this past May: "Catholics are nevertheless to engage themselves in the public square and do so coherently and unapologetically. To bear witness is our duty as faithful Catholics - and it is our right as faith filled citizens. Vote "no" on Amendment 4! This is not to "impose our views" but to "make our proposal" about what is necessary for human flourishing in society. By insisting that every human being matters..."*

*Let the children come to me.*

*And what is the Church proposing if we do what the bishops pray we do and "make abortion unthinkable?" Well, we start by embracing pregnant mothers who have no means to help their unborn child once that baby is born. It's by doing what we as a parish [do every year] with our annual Respect Life Brunch: raising funds to support our pregnancy centers. It's by doing what the archbishop did last month: opening a residence that will serve as a shelter and residence for needy pregnant and postpartum women and their babies.*

*Finally, I want to end this homily as I ended my bulletin column with a simple word: mercy. In my 22 years of priesthood, I have sat with many women who have had abortions. All their stories are different and heartbreaking, but they come to a priest, they come to the Church, they come to us, looking for God's mercy, and we must embrace them as God our Father would. The Church does so much that goes unnoticed to support these women. There's Project Rachel that gives them counseling and offers retreats of healing. If you are in need of healing beyond the confessional because of an abortion, you can call Project Rachel 954-981-2984 or visit [hopeafterabortion.com](http://hopeafterabortion.com).*

*My friends, we must continue to work for a culture that makes abortion unthinkable. And that begins by voting no on Amendment 4, that as your pastor, who is called to form your consciences, I urge you to do, but it goes beyond that. We must create a society that values children and welcomes them, [for] a society that is rooted in love, in Divine Love, makes every single sin unthinkable.*

The time has come. We cannot be silent on the grave sin of abortion. The world is feeding us so many lies, but as Catholics we must stand up for the truth and stand up for every vulnerable life especially the unborn. In these last days before the election, I urge you to pray that hearts may change, but I also urge you to act: tell your family and friends to vote no on Amendment 4. This bulletin has an entire page dedicated to this issue to assist you in preaching the truth to all. I beg you, for the sake of our children, get the word out and vote no on 4!

## DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

*Mis queridos amigos,*

A medida que nos acercamos al día de las elecciones, hago un llamado a esta comunidad parroquial a la oración, especialmente en lo que respecta a la derrota de la Enmienda 4 que, de aprobarse, consagraría el derecho al aborto en nuestra constitución estatal. Muchos de ustedes no escucharon mi homilía del Domingo de Respeto a la Vida que prediqué en la Misas de las 10:30 a.m. y las 5:30 p.m. a principios de este mes. Si pudiera ofrecer algunos extractos de mi llamado pastoral para que alcemos nuestras voces como pueblo católico:

*... el mayor mal de nuestra sociedad, la mayor consecuencia de esta cultura del libertinaje aquí en nuestro país es la eliminación de una generación entera de niños debido al grave pecado del aborto que se nos vende como atención médica y algo conveniente. Donde los niños son vistos como una carga que se puede descartar fácilmente en vez de un regalo. Satanás, después de todo, es el padre de las mentiras, y la mentira más grande que podemos decirnos a nosotros mismos como católicos es que debemos "vivir y dejar vivir" o dejar que otros crean lo que creen o "no debemos imponer nuestras creencias a los demás". Ese tipo de pensamiento cobarde, sí, usé la palabra cobarde, ha llevado a la erosión del matrimonio y la familia, y no a la erosión, sino a la eliminación de 65 millones de pequeñas almas.*

*Cristo nos dice al final del evangelio de hoy: "Dejad que los niños vengan a mí". Pero nuestra sociedad no los quiere. La Madre Teresa dijo una vez una frase famosa sobre los niños no deseados: "Dadme ese niño. Lo quiero. Lo cuidaré. Estoy dispuesta a aceptar a cualquier niño que sea abortado y a entregarlo a una pareja casada que lo ame y sea amada por él". Observe cómo también exalta el sacramento del matrimonio sabiendo cuántas parejas luchan por concebir y están abiertas a adoptar un bebé. También entiende que "el matrimonio es el gran protector de la vida humana no nacida."*

*No podemos, como pueblo creyente, quedarnos de brazos cruzados mientras esta "cultura de la muerte" de la que habló San Juan Pablo II continúa destruyendo nuestra nación. Por eso es imperativo que nos levantemos como católicos y votemos NO a la Enmienda 4 que está en nuestras papeletas electorales el mes próximo. El Arzobispo Wenski escribió en una columna el pasado mes de mayo: "Sin embargo, los católicos deben participar en la esfera pública y hacerlo de manera coherente y sin pedir disculpas. Dar testimonio es nuestro deber como católicos fieles, y es nuestro derecho como ciudadanos llenos de fe. ¡Voten "no" a la Enmienda 4! No se trata de "imponer nuestras opiniones", sino de "hacer nuestra propuesta" sobre lo que es necesario para el florecimiento humano en la sociedad. Insistiendo en que cada ser humano importa..."*

*Dejen que los niños vengan a mí.*

*¿Y qué propone la Iglesia si hacemos lo que los obispos rezan que hagamos y "hacer que el aborto sea impensable"? Bueno, empecemos por acoger a las madres embarazadas que no tienen medios para ayudar a su hijo no nacido una vez que el bebé nace. Es haciendo lo que nosotros como parroquia [hacemos todos los años] con nuestro desayuno anual de Respeto a la Vida: recaudar fondos para apoyar a nuestros centros de embarazo. Es haciendo lo que hizo el arzobispo el mes pasado: abrir una residencia que servirá como refugio y residencia para mujeres embarazadas y posparto necesitadas y sus bebés.*

*Finalmente, quiero terminar esta homilía con una simple palabra: misericordia. En mis 22 años de sacerdocio, me he sentado con muchas mujeres que han tenido abortos. Todas sus historias son diferentes y desgarradoras, pero vienen a un sacerdote, vienen a la Iglesia, vienen a nosotros, buscando la misericordia de Dios, y debemos aceptarlas como lo haría Dios nuestro Padre. La Iglesia hace tanto que pasa desapercibido para apoyar a estas mujeres. Existe el Proyecto Raquel que les brinda asesoramiento y ofrece retiros de sanación. Si necesita sanación más allá del confesionario debido a un aborto, puede llamar al Proyecto Raquel al 954-981-2984 o visitar [hopeafterabortion.com](http://hopeafterabortion.com).*

*Mis amigos, debemos seguir trabajando por una cultura que hace que el aborto sea impensable. Y eso comienza votando no a la Enmienda 4, que como su pastor, que está llamado a formar sus conciencias, los insto a hacer, pero va más allá de eso. Debemos crear una sociedad que valore a los niños y los acoja, [porque] una sociedad que esté arraigada en el amor, en el Amor Divino, hace que cada pecado sea impensable.*

*Lo hará ha llegado. No podemos permanecer en silencio ante el grave pecado del aborto. El mundo nos está alimentando con tantas mentiras, pero como católicos debemos defender la verdad y defender cada vida vulnerable, especialmente la de los no nacidos. En estos últimos días antes de las elecciones, los insto a orar para que los corazones cambien, pero también los insto a actuar: díganle a sus familiares y amigos que voten no a la Enmienda 4. Este boletín tiene una página entera dedicada a este tema para ayudarlos a predicar la verdad a todos. ¡Les ruego, por el bien de nuestros niños, que difundan la palabra y voten no a la Enmienda 4!*

# NO on 4

## AMENDMENT 4 FACT SHEET — WHY TO VOTE NO!

**Ballot Title:** Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion

**Ballot Summary:** No law shall prohibit, penalize, delay, or restrict abortion before viability or when necessary to protect the patient's health, as determined by the patient's healthcare provider. This amendment does not change the Legislature's constitutional authority to require notification to a parent or guardian before a minor has an abortion.

### Why Floridians Should Vote NO on Amendment 4

Amendment 4 would enshrine UNREGULATED ABORTION in our state constitution, making Florida one of the MOST PRO-ABORTION states in the nation. The amendment language is MISLEADING, and its proposed outcomes are DANGEROUS.

- ◇ **PUTS WOMEN AT RISK:** Amendment 4 would jeopardize existing laws and prohibit new ones that voters on both sides of the abortion issue support, including health and safety laws that protect women.
- ◇ **ALLOWS SECOND AND THIRD TRIMESTER ABORTIONS:** Though not defined in the amendment, "viability" is defined in Florida law as the stage of development when the life of a fetus is sustainable outside the womb (Ch. 390.011(15)), generally accepted to be 22-24 weeks of pregnancy, or about 6 months.
- ◇ **CREATES A BROAD "HEALTH" LOOPHOLE:** "Patient's health" is not defined in the amendment, allowing post-viability, extremely late-term abortions for treatable, temporary health concerns. Emotional health would justify an abortion when a child could survive outside the womb.
- ◇ **WEAKENS MEDICAL DOCTOR REQUIREMENT:** "Healthcare providers" – not just physicians – could determine if an abortion is "necessary" to protect the mother's "health." Even some employees of abortion clinics, such as nurses and counselors, could approve late-term abortions.
- ◇ **ELIMINATES PARENTAL CONSENT:** While preserving parental notification in our state constitution (Article X, Section 22), the amendment would invalidate the current law that requires parental consent for a minor to have an abortion (Ch. 390.01114(5)), making abortion the only medical decision for which parents have no say.

Masses will be celebrated at 8:00am (English) and 12 Noon (Bilingual).

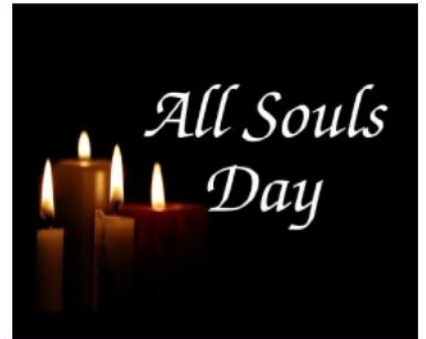
*Parishioners are invited to bring a picture of their deceased loved ones to be placed on the altar rail for the celebration of the 12 Noon All Souls' Day Mass.*

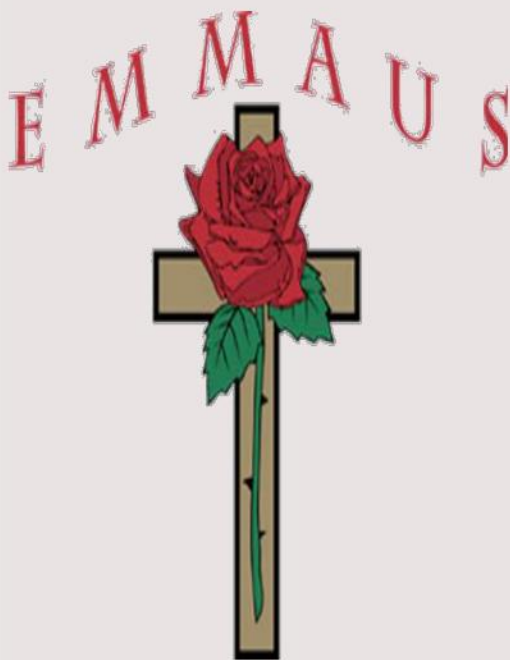
## ALL SOULS' DAY NOVENA

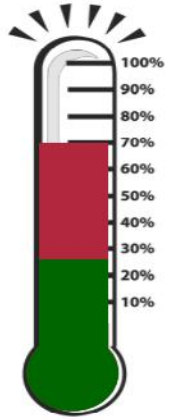
