FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends:

Once again, I invite all of you to prayer this week for our nation as we approach Election Day. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for adoration in the church from 7:00am -7:00pm while the polls are open on Tuesday, November 5th. Come and spend time with Our Lord in this most pivotal point in our history.

I want to share with you the words of Pope St. John Paul II as he left our country in September 1987 just one week after visiting his here in Miami. His plea and prayer for America is one of his most moving speeches delivered on American soil. May these words give you solace in the coming days, and remember that the one constant that will never change is Jesus Christ really present in Body, Soul, and Divinity at our altar. To Him always be the glory!

From Pope John Paul II's Farewell Address in Detroit, Michigan on September 19, 1987:

As I go, I take with me vivid memories of a dynamic nation, a warm and welcoming people, a Church abundantly blessed with a rich blend of cultural traditions. I depart with admiration for the ecumenical spirit that breathes strongly throughout this land, for the genuine enthusiasm of your young people, and for the hopeful aspirations of your most recent immigrants. I take with me an unforgettable memory of a country that God has richly blessed from the beginning until now.

America the beautiful! So you sing in one of your national songs. Yes, America, you are beautiful indeed, and blessed in so many ways:

- ♦ *in your majestic mountains and fertile plains;*
- ♦ *in the goodness and sacrifice hidden in your teeming cities and expanding suburbs;*
- ♦ *in your genius for invention and for splendid progress;*
- ♦ *in the power that you use for service and in the wealth that you share with others;*
- ♦ *in what you give to your own, and in what you do for others beyond your borders;*
- ♦ *in how you serve, and in how you keep alive the flame of hope in many hearts;*
- ♦ *in your quest for excellence and in your desire to right all wrongs.*

Yes, America, all this belongs to you. But your greatest beauty and your richest blessing is found in the human person: in each man, woman and child, in every immigrant, in every native-born son and daughter.

For this reason, America, your deepest identity and truest character as a nation is revealed in the position you take towards the human person. The ultimate test of your greatness in the way you treat every human being, but especially the weakest and most defenceless ones.

The best traditions of your land presume respect for those who cannot defend themselves. If you want equal justice for all, and true freedom and lasting peace, then, America, defend life! All the great causes that are yours today will have meaning only to the extent that you guarantee the right to life and protect the human person:

- ♦ *feeding the poor and welcoming refugees;*
- ♦ *reinforcing the social fabric of this nation;*
- ♦ *promoting the true advancement of women;*
- ♦ *securing the rights of minorities;*
- ♦ *pursuing disarmament, while guaranteeing legitimate defense; all this will succeed only if respect for life and its protection by the law is granted to every human being from conception until natural death.*

Every human person - no matter how vulnerable or helpless, no matter how young or how old, no matter how healthy, handicapped or sick, no matter how useful or productive for society - is a being of inestimable worth created in the image and likeness of God. This is the dignity of America, the reason she exists, the condition for her survival-yes, the ultimate test of her greatness: to respect every human person, especially the weakest and most defenseless ones, those as yet unborn.

With these sentiments of love and hope for America, I now say goodbye in words that I spoke once before: "Today, therefore, my final prayer is this: that God will bless America, so that she may increasingly become - and truly be - and long remain one Nation, under God, indivisible. With liberty and justice for all"

May God bless you all. God bless America!

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Mis queridos amigos,

Una vez más, los invito a todos a orar esta semana por nuestra nación, mientras nos acercamos al día de las elecciones. El Santísimo Sacramento estará expuesto para adoración en la iglesia de 7:00 am a 7:00 pm mientras las urnas están abiertas el martes 5 de noviembre. Vengan y pasen tiempo con Nuestro Señor en este momento crucial de nuestra historia.

Quiero compartir con ustedes las palabras del Papa San Juan Pablo II cuando dejó nuestro país en septiembre de 1987, solo una semana después de visitarnos aquí en Miami. Su súplica y oración por los Estados Unidos es uno de sus discursos más conmovedores pronunciados en suelo estadounidense. Que estas palabras les brinden consuelo en los próximos días, y recuerden que la única constante que nunca cambiará es Jesucristo realmente presente en Cuerpo, Alma y Divinidad en nuestro altar. ¡A Él siempre sea la gloria!

Del discurso de despedida del Papa Juan Pablo II en Detroit, Michigan, el 19 de septiembre de 1987:

Al partir, me llevo vívidos recuerdos de una nación dinámica, un pueblo cálido y acogedor, una Iglesia bendecida abundantemente con una rica mezcla de tradiciones culturales. Parto con admiración por el espíritu ecuménico que respira con fuerza en toda esta tierra, por el entusiasmo genuino de sus jóvenes y por las aspiraciones esperanzadoras de sus inmigrantes más recientes. Me llevo un recuerdo inolvidable de un país que Dios ha bendecido abundantemente desde el principio hasta ahora.

¡América la hermosa! Así cantáis en una de vuestras canciones nacionales. Sí, América, eres hermosa de verdad, y bendecida de muchas maneras:

- *en tus majestuosas montañas y fértiles llanuras;*
- *en la bondad y el sacrificio escondidos en tus ciudades rebosantes y suburbios en expansión;*
- *en tu genio para la invención y para el espléndido progreso;*
- *en el poder que utilizas para el servicio y en la riqueza que compartes con los demás;*
- *en lo que dais a los vuestros y en lo que hacéis por los demás más allá de vuestras fronteras;*
- *en cómo servís y en cómo mantenéis viva la llama de la esperanza en muchos corazones;*
- *en vuestra búsqueda de la excelencia y en vuestro deseo de corregir todos los males.*

Sí, América, todo esto te pertenece. Pero tu mayor belleza y tu bendición más rica se encuentra en la persona humana: en cada hombre, mujer y niño, en cada inmigrante, en cada hijo e hija nacidos en el país.

Por esta razón, América, tu identidad más profunda y tu carácter más auténtico como nación se revela en la posición que adoptas respecto a la persona humana. La prueba máxima de tu grandeza es la manera en que tratas a cada ser humano, pero especialmente a los más débiles e indefensos.

Las mejores tradiciones de tu tierra presuponen respeto por aquellos que no pueden defenderse por sí mismos. Si quieres justicia igual para todos, y verdadera libertad y paz duradera, entonces, América, ¡defiende la vida! Todas las grandes causas que hoy os propugnan tendrán sentido sólo en la medida en que garantizéis el derecho a la vida y protejáis a la persona humana:

- *alimentando a los pobres y acogiendo a los refugiados;*
- *reforzando el tejido social de esta nación;*
- *promoviendo el verdadero progreso de la mujer;*
- *asegurando los derechos de las minorías;*
- *persiguiendo el desarme, garantizando al mismo tiempo la legítima defensa; todo esto tendrá éxito sólo si se garantiza el respeto a la vida y su protección por la ley a todo ser humano desde la concepción hasta la muerte natural.*

Toda persona humana -no importa cuán vulnerable o indefensa sea, no importa cuán joven o cuán vieja, no importa cuán sana, discapacitada o enferma, no importa cuán útil o productiva sea para la sociedad- es un ser de inestimable valor creado a imagen y semejanza de Dios. Ésta es la dignidad de América, la razón de su existencia, la condición para su supervivencia; sí, la prueba máxima de su grandeza: respetar a toda persona humana, especialmente a las más débiles e indefensas, a las que aún no han nacido. Con estos sentimientos de amor y esperanza por América, me despido ahora con las palabras que ya pronuncié una vez: "Hoy, por tanto, mi última oración es ésta: que Dios bendiga a América, para que pueda llegar a ser cada vez más—y ser verdaderamente— y permanecer durante mucho tiempo como una sola nación, bajo Dios, indivisible. Con libertad y justicia para todos".

Que Dios los bendiga a todos. ¡Dios bendiga a América!

AMENDMENT 4 FACT SHEET — WHY TO VOTE NO!

Ballot Title: Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion

Ballot Summary: No law shall prohibit, penalize, delay, or restrict abortion before viability or when necessary to protect the patient's health, as determined by the patient's healthcare provider. This amendment does not change the Legislature's constitutional authority to require notification to a parent or guardian before a minor has an abortion.

Why Floridians Should Vote NO on Amendment 4

Amendment 4 would enshrine UNREGULATED ABORTION in our state constitution, making Florida one of the MOST PRO-ABORTION states in the nation. The amendment language is MISLEADING, and its proposed outcomes are DANGEROUS.

- ◇ **PUTS WOMEN AT RISK:** Amendment 4 would jeopardize existing laws and prohibit new ones that voters on both sides of the abortion issue support, including health and safety laws that protect women.
- ◇ **ALLOWS SECOND AND THIRD TRIMESTER ABORTIONS:** Though not defined in the amendment, "viability" is defined in Florida law as the stage of development when the life of a fetus is sustainable outside the womb (Ch. 390.011(15)), generally accepted to be 22-24 weeks of pregnancy, or about 6 months.
- ◇ **CREATES A BROAD "HEALTH" LOOPHOLE:** "Patient's health" is not defined in the amendment, allowing post-viability, extremely late-term abortions for treatable, temporary health concerns. Emotional health would justify an abortion when a child could survive outside the womb.
- ◇ **WEAKENS MEDICAL DOCTOR REQUIREMENT:** "Healthcare providers" – not just physicians – could determine if an abortion is "necessary" to protect the mother's "health." Even some employees of abortion clinics, such as nurses and counselors, could approve late-term abortions.
- ◇ **ELIMINATES PARENTAL CONSENT:** While preserving parental notification in our state constitution (Article X, Section 22), the amendment would invalidate the current law that requires parental consent for a minor to have an abortion (Ch. 390.01114(5)), making abortion the only medical decision for which parents have no say.
