FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends:

I want to thank all of you who attended the all-day prayer vigil and adoration on Election Day. Once again, the faith of our parish shined through, and I am particularly proud of the efforts of all of you in the campaign against Amendment 4. Because of your prayers and work, thankfully the amendment was defeated and life installed, the soft-cover missalettes will be replaced prevailed!

When you sit down in your pew, you will notice a brand-new book in the book holder. These are our new missalettes! The old ones, while practical, would get very worn over the course of sometimes six months of use, and their wear and tear would be a bit of an eye sore for visitors and faithful walking into the church. These new hard cover missalettes are more elegant and befitting our beautiful worship space. The only drawback is that they are not dated like our usual missalettes. So this is where catechesis on the lectionary comes in...

The lectionary or the readings you hear every Sunday at Mass are divided into a three-year cycle. We are currently finishing up Year B, and on the First Sunday of Advent we begin Year C. So, essentially, we hear the same readings every three years. In Year A, we hear from the Gospel of Matthew, in Year B we read from the Gospel of Mark with some weekends dedicated to the Gospel of John, and in Year C we hear from the Gospel of Luke.

One of the nice features of this new hard-covered book is that it has a ribbon so that you can mark where the readings are that week, and your fellow parishioner that comes to Mass after you will not have to go flipping around looking for the readings. The page number of where the readings can be found for that week will always be printed in the bulletin on page 3 in the "This Week's Readings" section and announced by our cantor. The book also has a very easy to follow Order of the Mass towards the beginning of the book, and some

exquisite and uplifting prayers that you can recite before or after Mass starting on page 1216.

For the year ahead, each book rack will include one hard-cover song book, one of the seasonal soft-cover missalettes and one new, hard-cover missalette. For our Centennial/2026 liturgical year, when the new pews with the longer book racks are entirely with a second batch of hard-cover missalettes, so that the new pews will no longer house the soft-cover missalettes that may be worn and tattered.

Our music and liturgy staff did a lot of research and went to great pains to find this new hard-covered missalettes and were very picky in choosing which ones would best fit this beautiful worship space. One of the things that they wanted me to pass along to you was this simple message: please do not take these new hard-covered missalettes with you. As you can probably see, they were not cheap. If you want a dated missalette that you can take home with you, I highly recommend subscribing to Magnificat which many parishioners already do. Magnificat has some excellent reflection on the daily readings and it is a wonderful worship aid that you can take wherever you go. Magnificat also offers a children's Missal, Magnifikid, which is a great resource for children as they learn how to pray the Mass. As for this new missalette, please keep them in the pews so that all our parishioners can enjoy them and pray with them for years to come.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Mis queridos amigos,

Quiero agradecer a todos los que asistieron a la vigilia de oración y adoración de todo el día de las elecciones. Una vez más, la fe de nuestra parroquia brilló, y estoy particularmente orgulloso de los esfuerzos de todos ustedes en la campaña contra la Enmienda 4. Gracias a sus oraciones y esfuerzos, la enmienda fue derrotada y el regalo de la vida triunfó!

Cuando te sientes en tu banco, notarás un libro nuevo en el portalibros. ¡Estos son nuestros nuevos misales! Los viejos, aunque prácticos, se desgastaban mucho en el transcurso de a veces seis meses de uso, y su desgaste era un poco doloroso para los visitantes y fieles que entraban en la iglesia. Estos nuevos libros son más elegantes y acordes con nuestro hermoso espacio de culto. El único inconveniente es que no son fechas como nuestros misales habituales. Aquí es donde entra en juego la catequesis sobre el leccionario.

El leccionario o las lecturas que se escuchan cada domingo en la Misa se dividen en un ciclo de tres años. Actualmente estamos terminando el Año B, y el Primer Domingo de Adviento comenzamos el Año C. Así que, esencialmente, escuchamos las mismas lecturas cada tres años. En el año A, escuchamos el Evangelio de Mateo, en el año B leemos el Evangelio de Marcos con algunos fines de semana dedicados al Evangelio de Juan, y en el año C escuchamos el Evangelio de Lucas.

Una de las características agradables de este nuevo libro es que tiene una cinta para que puedas marcar dónde son las lecturas esa semana, y tu compañero feligrés que venga a Misa después de ti no tendrá que ir dando vueltas buscando las lecturas. El número de página donde se pueden encontrar las lecturas de esa semana siempre estará impreso en el boletín en la página 3 en la sección "Lecturas de esta semana" y anunciado por nuestro cantor. El libro también tiene un Orden de la Misa muy fácil de seguir hacia el comienzo del misal, y algunas oraciones maravillosas y

edificantes que puedes recitar antes o después de la Misa a partir de la página 1216.

Para el próximo año, cada estante de libros incluirá un cancionero de tapa dura, uno de los misales de tapa blanda de temporada y un nuevo misal de tapa dura. Para nuestro año litúrgico del Centenario/2026, cuando se instalen los nuevos bancos con los estantes de libros más largos, los misales de tapa blanda serán reemplazados por completo por un segundo lote de misales de tapa dura, de modo que los nuevos bancos ya no albergarán los misales de tapa blanda que pueden estar desgastados y desechados.

Nuestro personal de música y liturgia investigó mucho y se esforzó mucho para encontrar estos nuevos misales de tapa dura y fueron muy exigentes al elegir cuáles se adaptarían mejor a este hermoso espacio de adoración. Una de las cosas que querían que les transmitiera era este simple mensaje: por favor, no se lleven estos nuevos misales de tapa dura. Como probablemente puedas ver, no fueron baratos. Si quieres un misal anticuado que puedas llevarte a casa, te recomiendo encarecidamente que te suscribas a Magníficat, que muchos feligreses ya hacen. Magnificat contiene excelentes reflexiones sobre las lecturas diarias y es una maravillosa ayuda para el culto que puedes llevar a donde quiera que vayas. Magnificat también ofrece un misal para niños, Magnifikid, que es un gran recurso para que los niños aprendan a rezar la Misa. En cuanto a este nuevo misal, por favor manténgalos en las bancas para que todos nuestros feligreses puedan disfrutarlos y orar con ellos en los años venideros.

STATEMENT BY ARCHBISHOP THOMAS WENSKI ON THE DEFEAT OF AMENDMENT 4

I am profoundly relieved that Florida's pro-abortion Amendment 4 did not pass. This outcome is certainly welcomed by all those who recognize that human life begins at conception and that this is a scientific and biological fact and not merely a religious belief or ideological theory. As such the unborn child should be welcomed in life and protected by law.

However, though this outcome reaffirms our commitment to protecting the sanctity of life at all stages, it still does not outlaw abortion entirely in Florida. This outcome only rejected an extreme and ill-conceived proposition, since the decision making on abortion policy returned to the people and its elected representatives.

We remain steadfast in our efforts to promote human flourishing in society, as Florida continues to allow legislation protecting the unborn to move forward in our state legislatures and constitution.

Abortion too often is seen as the solution to an unforeseen problem, a fallback position if contraception failed or was not used. But abortion is no solution — and it is no right. It is a wrong, a grievous wrong that has prematurely ended the lives of more than 60 million souls in this country alone since 1973.

STATEMENT BY THE FLORIDA CONFERENCE OF CATHOLIC BISHOPS ON THE DEFEAT OF FLORIDA'S PRO-ABORTION AMENDMENT 4

We are profoundly relieved at the defeat of Florida's pro-abortion Amendment 4. This is a positive outcome for Florida and all efforts to promote the flourishing of our state.

Though Amendment 4 failed to reach the 60% threshold required to pass, a majority of Floridians voting in the general election supported it. While significant gains to protect women and preborn children in recent years will remain in place, abortion in Florida will continue at a very high rate under our current laws.

Much work remains to open hearts and minds to the dignity and goodness of life in the womb and at every stage. We will continue to proclaim in our churches and in the public square the value of every human life and to highlight that there is a better way forward for women, families and society than abortion. Through our many ministries, we will continue to support, encourage and assist pregnant women and young families. For those who regret their abortion or abortions, or their cooperation in one, we reiterate that the Lord is eager to forgive, and the Church is ready to facilitate healing.

We express our gratitude to all those who worked against Amendment 4, giving of their time, talent and resources. Those efforts were clearly fruitful in this election and will reverberate to the good for generations to come.






