FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends:

On Christmas Day, we will hear the great news from the angels: "For today in the city of David a savior has been born for you who is Christ and Lord." (Luke 2:11)

Years ago, I received a Christmas card with this brief poem from the Christian writer and pastor, Max Lucado. It read:

"Jesus humbled himself.

He went from commanding angels
to sleeping on straw.

From holding stars to clutching Mary's finger.
The palm that held the universe
Took the nail of the soldier.

Why?

Because that's what love does."

I remember reading it over and over again. This is what love does! When we stop to ponder what Christ actually did for us by becoming a child, it makes us look at the manger scene with more of a sense of wonder. How can our omnipotent God become so fragile, so vulnerable?

This is not how one would envision the King of Kings being born. Not under these circumstances. Not in this place. Yet there he is sleeping in the straw of a manger. Bishop Fulton Sheen once said, "The world might have expected the Son of God to be born—if He was to be born at all—in an inn. A stable would be the last place in the world where one would have looked for Him. Divinity is always where one least expects to find it."

Our God, so powerful and mighty, teaches us humility. He teaches us that to show the depths of love we must become vulnerable as well. This is the mystery of Christmas: the meek and the lowly are the ones who are favored by God, for in the silence of a stable in Bethlehem of Judea, the Son

of God was born as a meek, little infant. This child who will be our Savior, our Redeemer, and our King begins the masterful work of our redemption. This is what love does indeed. God becomes a tiny child so that we may become like Him. There is no greater gift we can receive this Christmas.

And therein lies another great mystery about Christmas: God becomes gift for us. On this day when we focus so much on gifts, God himself makes himself a gift for humanity. When I was a child, we would always have our family manger scene under the Christmas tree and my mother would take great care that it wouldn't be obscured by all the presents that would accumulate under the tree. This divine gift that is the Christ child tends to get obscured by so many things. We all have beautiful traditions at home for Christmas with food and gifts and family and friends, but all these traditions should point us back to the reason we gathered in the first place: to Jesus. So many times we let all the clutter of Christmas get in the way of why we celebrate. At a Midnight Mass, Pope Benedict XVI once said: "Let us ask the Lord to help us see through the superficial glitter of this season, and to discover behind it the child in the stable in Bethlehem, so as to find true joy and true light." The shepherds saw past the great spectacle of the angels and knelt before this child. This week we celebrate this Divine Infant who became a gift for us so that we would learn to become a gift for others.

The priests and religious sisters of our parish pray that all of you have a Blessed Christmas filled with the light, the joy, and the peace of Christ, our newborn King!

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Mis queridos amigos,

El día de Navidad, escucharemos las grandes noticias de los ángeles: "Porque hoy, en la ciudad de David, os ha nacido un salvador, que es el Cristo y el Señor". (Lucas 2:11.)

Hace años, recibí una tarjeta de Navidad con este breve poema del escritor y pastor cristiano, Max Lucado. Decía:

"Jesús se humilló a sí mismo.

Pasó de mandar a los ángeles

a dormir sobre paja.

De sostener estrellas a agarrar el dedo de María.

La palma que sostenía el universo

Tomó el clavo del soldado.

¿Por qué?

Porque eso es lo que hace el amor".

Recuerdo haberlo leído una y otra vez. ¡Esto es lo que hace el amor! Cuando nos detenemos a meditar sobre lo que Cristo realmente hizo por nosotros al convertirse en niños, nos hace mirar la escena del pesebre con un sentido de asombro. ¿Cómo puede nuestro Dios omnipotente volverse tan frágil, tan vulnerable?

Así no es como uno se imaginaría nacer al Rey de Reyes. No en estas circunstancias. No en este lugar. Sin embargo, allí está durmiendo en la paja de un pesebre. El obispo Fulton Sheen dijo una vez: "El mundo podría haber esperado que el Hijo de Dios naciera, si es que iba a nacer, en una posada. Un establo sería el último lugar en el mundo donde uno lo habría buscado. La divinidad siempre está donde uno menos espera encontrarla".

Nuestro Dios, tan poderoso, nos enseña la humildad. Él nos enseña que para mostrar las profundidades del amor también debemos volvernos vulnerables. Este es el misterio de la Navidad: los mansos y los humildes son los favorecidos por Dios, porque en el silencio de un establo en Belén de Judea, el Hijo de Dios nació

como un niño manso y pequeño. Este niño que será nuestro Salvador, nuestro Redentor y nuestro Rey comienza la obra magistral de nuestra redención. Esto es lo que hace el amor. Dios se hace un niño pequeño para que podamos llegar a ser como Él. No hay regalo más grande que podamos recibir esta Navidad.

Y ahí radica otro gran misterio sobre la Navidad: Dios se convierte en regalo para nosotros. En este día en el que nos centramos tanto en los dones, Dios mismo se hace un don para la humanidad. Cuando era niña, siempre teníamos nuestra escena familiar del pesebre debajo del árbol de Navidad y mi madre se cuidaba mucho de que no quedara oscurecida por todos los regalos que se acumulaban debajo del árbol. Este don divino que es el niño Jesús tiende a ser oscurecido por Todos tenemos muchas cosas. hermosas tradiciones en casa para Navidad con comida, regalos, familiares y amigos, pero todas estas tradiciones deberían recordarnos la razón por la que nos reunimos en primer lugar: Jesús. Muchas veces dejamos que todo el desorden de la Navidad se interponga en el camino de por qué celebramos. En una Misa de Medianoche, el Papa Benedicto XVI dijo una vez: "Pidamos al Señor que nos ayude a ver a través del brillo superficial de este tiempo, y a descubrir a él niño en el establo de Belén, para encontrar la verdadera alegría y la verdadera luz". Los pastores vieron más allá del gran espectáculo de los ángeles y se arrodillaron ante este niño. Esta semana celebramos a este Divino Niño que se convirtió en un regalo para nosotros para que aprendiéramos a ser un regalo para los demás.

¡Los sacerdotes y religiosas de nuestra parroquia rezan para que todos ustedes tengan una Navidad bendita llena de la luz, la alegría y la paz de Cristo, nuestro Rey recién nacido!



LITTLE FLOWER CONCERT SERIES

CAPILLA FLAMENCA

BY SERAPHIC FIRE

On Friday, January 17, 2025, Seraphic Fire, South Florida's GRAMMY®-nominated, professional vocal ensemble, will bring the musical legacy of the historic Capilla Flamenca to life in a stunning tribute to the most glorious choir ever assembled. Led by guest conductor Amanda Quist, 13 unaccompanied singers will perform works of great Renaissance composers. The private chapel choir of Holy Roman Emperor Charles V, the Capilla Flamenca was an elite group of singers and composers who dazzled the courts and cathedrals of the Holy Roman Empire with their sublime voices, singing both secular and sacred music. Charles V came from a long line of passionate music lovers, and the chapel accompanied him as he traveled his realm extensively to display his power through music. "No other institution had a repertory as rich as that of the Capilla Flamenca, and the music they performed represents the great riches of the sixteenth century, the 'Golden Age of Polyphony," writes the program's consulting scholar, Honey Meconi of Rochester University.

"Seraphic Fire is one of the only groups that I know who could really perform this," said Quist. "This is not music for any old group. This really requires a very specific skill set. For me, it's like having the most glorious car to drive and with the most glorious music. The audience is going to walk away and say, 'I am now a fan of all of this incredible Renaissance polyphony and just didn't know about it."







