FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends:

Happy New Year and Happy Epiphany! It is so wonderful to greet all of you in this new year which happens to be a jubilee year not only for the Universal Church, but this September we begin a year of jubilee for our parish centennial when our school turns 100 on September 15, 2025.

On Christmas Eve, Pope Francis opened the Holy Doors of St. Peter's Basilica which many of us will walk through this year. In his Papal Bull last May announcing the upcoming Holy Year, the Pope wrote: "Hope does not disappoint" (Rom 5:5). In the spirit of hope, the Apostle Paul addressed these words of encouragement to the Christian community of Rome. Hope is also the central message of the coming Jubilee in accordance with an ancient tradition, the Pope proclaims every twenty-five years. As a parish, we must prepare for the festivities of our 100th year. This is not only done with tangible events or buildings built or parties, but in the ecclesial setting, it is done with spiritual

preparation. What do we, as a parish and school, wish to achieve spiritually during our centennial celebration?

As we begin this new year, we our immediate pilgrimage as a parish towards our local jubilee. We are after all pilgrims seeking out, like the Magi in today's gospel, the road to our Lord and King. As Pope Francis wrote: "This interplay of hope and patience makes us see clearly that the Christian life is a journey calling for moments of greater intensity to encourage and sustain hope as the constant companion that guides our steps towards the goal of our encounter with the Lord Jesus."

With that goal of "encounter" in mind, I call upon all our ministries this year to invite the clergy of parish to give formation talks to your respective

And that is my prayer for this parish as we jubilee: that we may be like the ancient church as we read in Acts 4:32, "The community of believers was of one heart and mind." For this we rely on the Holy Spirit who makes us one in Christ Jesus.

May God's blessings be upon you and your family during this new year, and may God bless the Church of the Little Flower and St. Theresa Catholic School as we prepare to celebrate our centennial jubilee this coming September.

Mis queridos amigos,

¡Feliz Año Nuevo y Feliz Dia de los Reyes! Que alegría saludarlos a todos en este nuevo año que es un año jubilar no solo para la Iglesia Universal, sino que este septiembre iniciamos un año jubilar por el centenario de nuestra parroquia, cuando nuestra escuela cumpla 100 años el 15 de septiembre de 2025.

LITTLE FLOWER CONCERT SERIES

CAPILLA FLAMENCA

BY SERAPHIC FIRE

On Friday, January 17, 2025, Seraphic Fire, South Florida's GRAMMY®-nominated, professional vocal ensemble, will bring the musical legacy of the historic Capilla Flamenca to life in a stunning tribute to the most glorious choir ever assembled. Led by guest conductor Amanda Quist, 13 unaccompanied singers will perform works of great Renaissance composers. The private chapel choir of Holy Roman Emperor Charles V, the *Capilla Flamenca* was an elite group of singers and composers who dazzled the courts and cathedrals of the Holy Roman Empire with their sublime voices, singing both secular and sacred music. Charles V came from a long line of passionate music lovers, and the chapel accompanied him as he traveled his realm extensively to display his power through music. "No other institution had a repertory as rich as that of the *Capilla Flamenca*, and the music they performed represents the great riches of the sixteenth century, the 'Golden Age of Polyphony,'" writes the program's consulting scholar, Honey Meconi of Rochester University.



"Seraphic Fire is one of the only groups that I know who could really perform this," said Quist. "This is not music for any old group. This really requires a very specific skill set. For me, it's like having the most glorious car to drive and with the most glorious music. The audience is going to walk away and say, 'I am now a fan of all of this incredible Renaissance polyphony and just didn't know about it."

A Pre-Concert Conversation will be presented one hour prior to the performance by Seraphic Fire artist Luthien Brackett.
