# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### My Dear Friends,

As I write this column early in the week, our Holy Father, Pope Francis, is in the hospital in Rome with a respiratory infection. Every day at the Mass, we pray for the pope, but today we pray for his health and for a prompt recovery. During this Holy Year of jubilee, Pope Francis has called us to focus on the theological virtue of hope and to be pilgrims of hope. So many of our brothers and sisters feel lost, and maybe you feel lost too as you read this, but the gift of hope that Christ gives us, lets us see the divine possibilities of a life totally transformed by our Savior. Which is why the Holy Year is a time of conversion. Father David wrote about it in this space last week. This rejection of sin and embrace of hope is transformational and life altering especially when you look at the challenge that Christ gives us in today's gospel: "love your enemies." Pope Francis has spoken often on this command from our Lord, so I cede the rest of my column to the Vicar of Christ:

This Sunday's Gospel passage (cf. Lk 6:27-38) concerns a central point that characterizes Christian life: love for enemies. Jesus' words are clear: "I say to you that hear, Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who abuse you" (vv. 27-38). And this is not optional, it is a command. It is not for everyone, but for the disciples, whom Jesus calls "you that hear". He is well aware that loving enemies exceeds our possibilities, but this is why he became man: not to leave us as we are, but to transform us into men and women capable of a greater love, that of his Father and ours. This is the love that Jesus gives to those who 'hear him'. Thus it becomes possible! With him, thanks to his love, to his Spirit, we are able to love even those who do not love us. even those who do us harm.

In this way, Jesus wants God's love to triumph over hatred and rancor in every heart. The logic of love, which culminates in Christ's Cross, is a Christian's badge and induces us to meet everyone with the heart of brothers and sisters. But how is it possible to overcome human instinct and the worldly law of retaliation? Jesus provides the answer in the same Gospel passage: "Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful" (v. 36). Those who hear Jesus, who make an effort to follow him even at a cost, become children of God, and begin to truly resemble the Father who is in heaven. We become capable of things we never thought we could say or do, and of which we would have been rather ashamed, but which now give us joy and peace instead. We no longer need to be violent, with words and gestures: we discover that we are capable of tenderness and goodness; and we sense that all of this comes not from ourselves but from him! And thus we do not brag about it but are grateful for it.

There is nothing greater and more fruitful than love: it bestows all dignity to the person, while, on the contrary, hatred and vengeance decrease it, marring the beauty of the creature made in God's image...

May the Virgin Mary help us to let our heart be touched by this holy word of Jesus, burning like fire, that it may transform us and make us able to do good without reciprocation, doing good without reciprocation, witnessing everywhere to the victory of love. (Angelus 2/24/19)

Lord Jesus, comfort our Holy Father in his illness and restore him to health. Amen.

# DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

de semana, nuestro Santo Padre, el Papa Francisco, está en el hospital de Roma con una infección respiratoria. Todos los días en la Misa, rezamos por el Papa, pero hoy rezamos por su salud y por una pronta recuperación. Durante este Año Santo de jubileo, el Papa Francisco nos ha llamado a centrarnos en la virtud teologal de la esperanza y a ser peregrinos de esperanza. Muchos de nuestros hermanos y hermanas se sienten perdidos, y tal vez tú también te sientas perdido al leer esto, pero el regalo de la esperanza que Cristo nos da nos permite ver las posibilidades divinas de una vida totalmente transformada por nuestro Salvador. Por eso el Año Santo es un tiempo de conversión. El padre David escribió sobre ellos en este boletín la semana pasada. Este rechazo del pecado y el abrazo de la esperanza es transformador y cambia la vida, especialmente cuando se observa el desafío que Cristo nos da en el evangelio de hoy: "ama a tus enemigos". El Papa Francisco ha hablado a menudo sobre este mandato de nuestro Señor, por lo que cedo el resto de mi columna al Vicario de Cristo:

refiere a un punto central y característico de la vida cristiana: el amor por los enemigos. Las palabras de hecha a imagen de Dios... Jesús son claras: "Yo os digo a los que me escucháis: Amad a vuestros enemigos, haced bien a los que os odian, bendecid a los que os maldigan, rogad por los que os difamen" (versículos 27-28) ). Y esto no es una opción, es un mandato. No es para todos, sino para los discípulos, que Jesús llama "a los que me escucháis". Él sabe muy bien que amar a los enemigos va más allá de nuestras posibilidades, pero para esto se hizo hombre: no para dejarnos así su enfermedad y restáurale la salud. Amén. como somos, sino para transformarnos en hombres y mujeres capaces de un amor más grande, el de su Padre y el nuestro. Este es el amor que Jesús da a quienes lo "escuchan". ¡Y entonces se hace posible! Con él, gracias a su amor, a su Espíritu, también podemos amar a quienes no nos aman, incluso a quienes nos hacen daño.

De este modo, Jesús quiere que en cada corazón Mientras escribo esta columna a principios el amor de Dios triunfe sobre el odio y el rencor. La lógica del amor, que culmina en la Cruz de Cristo, es la señal distintiva del cristiano y nos lleva a salir al encuentro de todos con un corazón de hermanos. Pero, ¿cómo es posible superar el instinto humano y la ley mundana de la represalia? La respuesta la da Jesús en la misma página del Evangelio: "Sed misericordiosos, como vuestro Padre es misericordioso" (vers. 36). Quien escucha a Jesús, quien se esfuerza por seguirlo aunque cueste, se convierte en hijo de Dios y comienza a parecerse realmente al Padre que está en el cielo. Nos volvemos capaces de cosas que nunca hubiéramos pensado que podríamos decir o hacer, y de las cuales nos habríamos avergonzado, pero que ahora nos dan alegría y paz. Ya no necesitamos ser violentos, con palabras y gestos; nos descubrimos capaces de ternura y bondad; y sentimos que todo esto no viene de nosotros sino de Él, y por lo tanto no nos jactamos de ello, sino que estamos agradecidos.

No hay nada más grande y más fecundo que el amor: confiere a la persona toda su dignidad, El Evangelio de este domingo (cf. Lc 6, 27-38) se mientras que, por el contrario, el odio y la venganza la disminuyen, desfigurando la belleza de la criatura

# January Update

2025 marks a huge milestone in our history as we begin our two-year centennial celebration with St. Theresa School turning 100 this Fall!

Though we're excited to soon start the celebrations, plenty of work still remains ahead.

Here are some of the latest updates on our Centennial projects:

- Our Pipe Organ is now being constructed at the Fisk Workshop in Gloucester, MA.
- Work on the interior of the church will commence in June. During the summer months, the balcony will be reinforced to support the weight of the new organ and the entire church will be repainted. The Reredos and side altars will be restored to their original beauty by dedicated artisans who will clean and touch up the many intricate details. The new pews will also be installed during this closure
- We'll soon be celebrating Mass in our original church, like our founding parishioners did, as we move to Comber Hall for all Masses during the summer construction.
- The STS Multipurpose Center has now received the approval from the city's Board of Architects, Historical Board, and Planning & Zoning. Plans now head to the City Commission for approval, which we hope to secure soon.
- Our fundraising continues to steadily progress in both pledges and gifts received. Thank you to all who have already donated! With all our project plans approaching final approval and the start of work on the horizon, the time to give is now, ensuring that we stay on track with our timeline and, ideally, break ground at the school as it opens its doors for the 100th time in August.

# LITTLE FLOWER ENLIGHTENMENT PESTIVAL CLASSICAL: MARTINES, MOZART & HAYDN BY SERAPHIC FIRE

On Friday March 7, Seraphic Fire performs the vibrant works of Marianna Martines, a star of Viennese Classical music and pupil of Franz Joseph Haydn. Receiving more acclaim than any other female composer of her time, she was famous throughout Europe, and her salon concerts were legendary. In this program featuring chorus and period orchestra, Seraphic Fire highlights the modern world premiere of Martines' O, Virgo, cui salutem, alongside bedrock works by Haydn and Mozart, including the ravishing "Laudate Dominum" from the Vesperae solennes de confessore.

Vienna's musical life depended on the collaboration and competition of its leading artists. In addition to Martines being a keyboard student of Haydn, she also benefited from Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart attending her soirées and playing duets with her. On this program, works by Haydn and Mozart complement Martines' compositions. Mozart's Missa brevis, K. 192 was composed when he was just 18 years old. Haydn's Symphony No. 63, "La Roxelane," is a musical portrait of a queen: Roxelane, wife of Suleiman the Magnificent, a sixteenth-century sultan of the Ottoman Empire.

A Pre-Concert Conversation will be presented one hour prior to the performance by a Seraphic Fire artist.


# MENS EMMAUS RETREAT #52




