FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

"[The Lord Jesus Christ] will change our lowly body to conform with his glorified body by the power that enables him also to bring all things into subjection to himself." (Phil 3:21)

The end of yesterday's gospel from the first Saturday of Lent flows beautiful into today's gospel of the Transfiguration because our Lord tells us: "Be perfect, just like your heavenly Father is perfect (Matthew 5:48)." Jesus transfigured must be the perfection that we as Christians aspire to. Yet we hear the word perfect and think it is something beyond our grasp. Think carefully about our defeatist view of perfection: Why would our Lord tell us to be perfect if he did not think we were capable of reaching it? As is the case with most of us, our Lord thinks more highly of us than we do. He sees the potential that each of us has, and he sees beyond our lowliness and sees something glorious. We are offered the account of the Transfiguration to remind us that this Lenten journey is going to end in the beauty of Christ glorified after the resurrection. In the meantime, we strive to perfect our lives and to grow closer to Christ. But boy is it hard to be perfect.

Going all the way back to when I was a child, I already knew that I was a frustrated perfectionist. One day in fourth or fifth grade, I remember going to the school library and one particular book caught my eye: "How To Be a Perfect Person In Just Three Days." I immediately checked it out. It was a very clever book, and I don't want to spoil how the author reaches his conclusion, but as I look back on this childhood experience, it only emphasizes the need that we all have in our hearts to be perfect, just our heavenly Father is perfect. So how do we achieve this? Well, the end of the gospel tells us quite clearly and directly from the voice of the

Father: listen to Jesus. We have a long way to go, but if we listen to the Lord, if we center our lives on the Lord, and if we continue practicing our faith in a devout and disciplined way, then perfection and holiness are very much within our grasp.

In regard to "practicing" our faith, Father Paul Scalia during the homily at the Funeral Mass of his father, Supreme Court Justice Antonin Scalia, preached the following: "[My father] was a practicing Catholic, 'practicing' in the sense that he hadn't perfected it yet. Or rather, Christ was not yet perfected in him." We haven't perfected our faith because Christ has not yet been perfected in us, so we continue "practicing" and we continue looking up at the glorified and transfigured Christ with the same wonder and awe that the three disciples did. And we also know that we are slowly brought to perfection through our celebration of these Sacred Mysteries, for it is here in the Mass that we experience a bit of Mount Tabor every Sunday. As Dr. Scott Hahn puts it so eloquently, "Mass is heaven on earth." We may look up at the altar and only see a priest elevating a host, but what is really happening is all the angels and heavenly hosts surrounding the presence of Christ who dares to come down and touch us and feed us in the Eucharist. Yes, we have a long way to go to attain perfection, but there's no harm in practicing as we continue our journey until Christ is brought to perfection in us. Until then, heed the voice of the Father this Lent: look to our Lord, his Chosen One, and listen to him!

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

"[El Señor Jesucristo] cambiará nuestro humilde cuerpo para que se conforme a su cuerpo glorificado por el poder que también le permite sujetar todas las cosas a sí mismo". (Filipenses 3:21)

El final del evangelio de ayer, del primer sábado de Cuaresma, fluye hermoso en el evangelio de hoy de la Transfiguración, porque nuestro Señor nos dice: "Sed perfectos, como vuestro Padre celestial es perfecto" (Mt 5,48). Jesús transfigurado debe ser la perfección a la que aspiramos como cristianos. Sin embargo, escuchamos la palabra perfecto y pensamos que es algo que está más allá de nuestro alcance. Piense cuidadosamente acerca de nuestra visión derrotista de la perfección: ¿Por qué nuestro Señor nos diría que seamos perfectos si no piensa que seamos capaces de alcanzarla? Como es el caso de la mayoría de nosotros, Nuestro Señor piensa más de nosotros que nosotros. Él ve el potencial que cada uno de nosotros tiene, y ve más allá de nuestra humildad y ve algo glorioso. Se nos ofrece el relato de la Transfiguración para recordarnos que este camino cuaresmal va a terminar en la belleza de Cristo glorificado después de la resurrección. Mientras tanto, nos esforzamos por perfeccionar nuestras vidas y por acercarnos más a Cristo. Pero es difícil ser perfecto.

Mirando cuando era niño, ya sabía que era un perfeccionista frustrado. Un día, en cuarto o quinto grado, recuerdo que fui a la biblioteca de la escuela y un libro en particular me llamó la atención: "Cómo ser una persona perfecta en solo tres días. Inmediatamente lo revisé. Fue un libro muy inteligente, y no quiero estropear cómo el autor llega a su conclusión, pero cuando miro hacia atrás en esta experiencia de la infancia, solo enfatiza la necesidad que todos tenemos en nuestros corazones de ser perfectos, simplemente nuestro Padre celestial es perfecto. Entonces, ¿cómo logramos esto? Bueno, el final del Evangelio nos dice muy clara y directamente de la voz del Padre:

escucha a Jesús. Tenemos un largo camino por recorrer, pero si escuchamos al Señor, si centramos nuestra vida en el Señor, y si continuamos practicando nuestra fe de manera devota y disciplinada, entonces la perfección y la santidad están muy a nuestro alcance.

Con respecto a "practicar" nuestra fe, el Padre Paul Scalia durante la homilía en la Misa de Funeral de su padre, el Juez de la Corte Suprema Antonin Scalia, predicó lo siguiente: "[Mi padre] era un católico practicante, 'practicante' en el sentido de que aún no lo había perfeccionado. O, mejor dicho, Cristo aún no estaba perfeccionado en él." No hemos perfeccionado nuestra fe porque Cristo aún no se ha perfeccionado en nosotros, así que seguimos "practicando" y seguimos mirando al Cristo glorificado y transfigurado con la misma maravilla y asombro que los tres discípulos, y también sabemos que poco a poco somos llevados a la perfección a través de nuestra celebración de estos Sagrados Misterios, porque es aquí, en la Misa, donde experimentamos un pedacito del Monte Tabor todos los domingos. Como el Dr. Scott Hahn lo expresa tan elocuentemente: "La Misa es el cielo en la tierra." Podemos mirar hacia el altar y solo ver a un sacerdote elevando una hostia, pero lo que realmente está sucediendo es que todos los ángeles y las huestes celestiales rodean la presencia de Cristo que se atreve a bajar y tocarnos y alimentarnos en la Eucaristía. Sí, tenemos un largo camino por recorrer para alcanzar la perfección, pero no hay nada de malo en practicar mientras continuamos nuestro viaje hasta que Cristo sea llevado a la perfección en nosotros. Hasta entonces, escucha la voz del Padre en esta Cuaresma: ¡mira a nuestro Señor, su Elegido, ¡y escúchalo!

Prayer to Saint Joseph

To you, O blessed Joseph, do we come in our tribulation,
and having implored the help of your most holy Spouse,
we confidently invoke your patronage also.

Through that charity which bound you to the Immaculate Virgin Mother of God
and through the paternal love with which you embraced the Child Jesus,
we humbly beg you graciously to regard the inheritance
which Jesus Christ has purchased by his Blood,
and with your power and strength to aid us in our necessities.

O most watchful guardian of the Holy Family, defend the chosen children of Jesus Christ;
O most loving father, ward off from us every contagion of error and corrupting influence;
O our most mighty protector, be kind to us and from heaven assist us
in our struggle with the power of darkness.

As once you rescued the Child Jesus from deadly peril, so now protect
God's Holy Church from the snares of the enemy and from all adversity;
shield, too, each one of us by your constant protection,
so that, supported by your example and your aid,
we may be able to live piously, to die in holiness,
and to obtain eternal happiness in heaven.

Amen.

This prayer to Saint Joseph—spouse of the Virgin Mary, foster father of Jesus, and patron saint of the universal Church—was composed by Pope Leo XIII in his 1889 encyclical, Quamquam pluries. He asked that it be added to the end of the Rosary, especially during the month of October, which is dedicated to the Rosary. Enriched with a partial indulgence (Handbook of Indulgences, conc. 19), this prayer may be said after the customary Salve Regina and concluding prayer, and may also be used to conclude other Marian devotions.

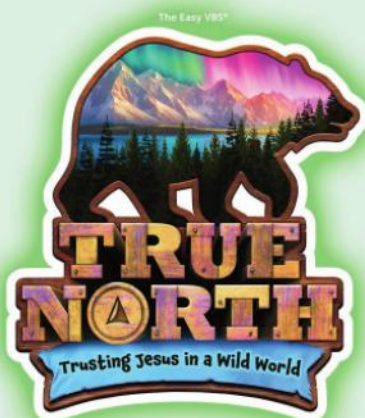
LENTEN CONFESSIONS

MEN'S EMMAUS RETREAT #52

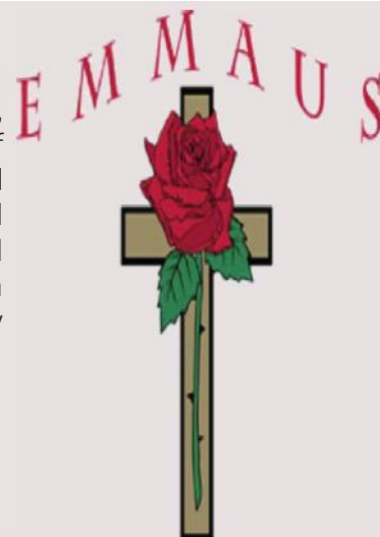

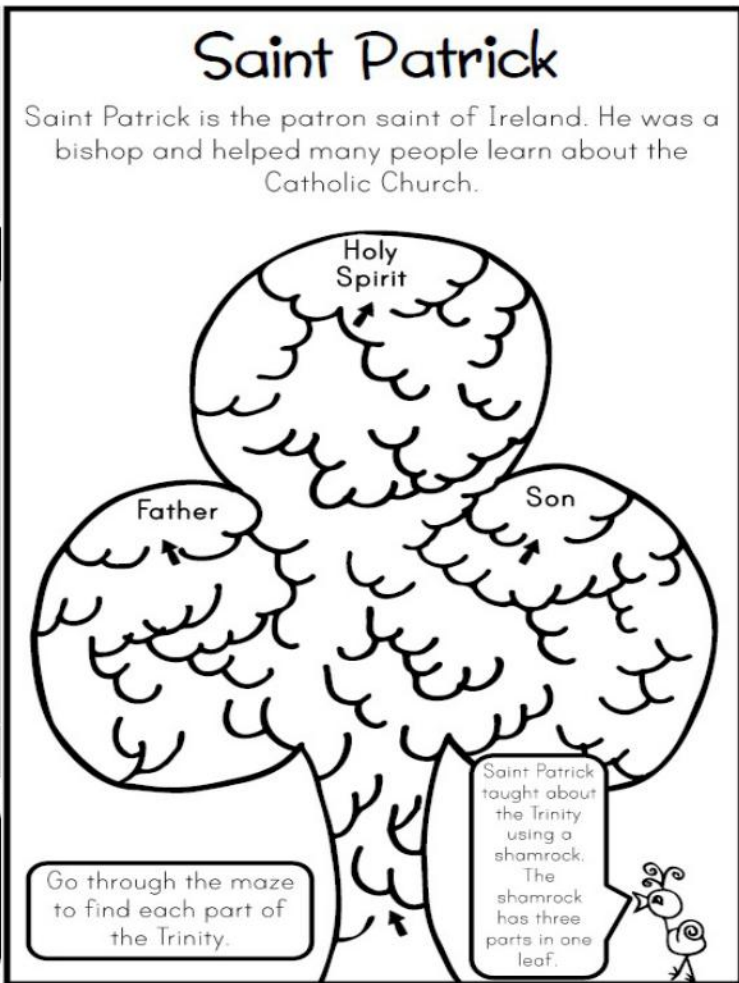

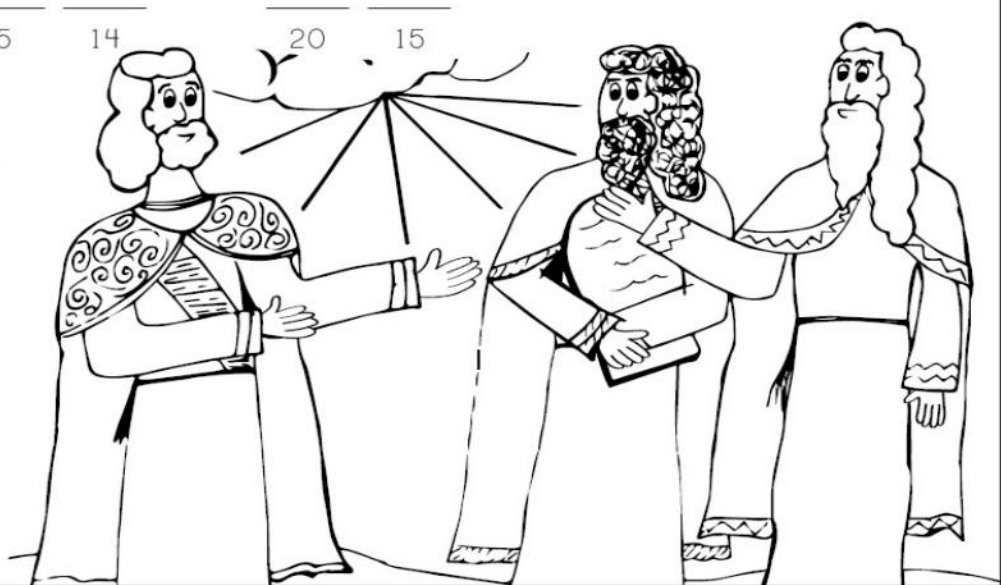
