FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

Holy Week is here! The most important week of the year. And so I present you with a very simple question: how do you intend to spend this week? We cannot go about the activities of the next seven days as if it were just another week. The events of Holy Week transformed human history, and it should transform our lives as well.

Today we begin with Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord. I have often bemoaned the fact that the palms that we give out distract us so much from the most important aspect of today's liturgy: the Passion of our Lord. I invite you today, and I know that this is a fool's errand that I'm about to request from you: how about we wait until we get home to make our palm crosses? Let us put the palm down so we can listen to the richness of today's Scriptures including the crucial details of the Passion of our Lord. Just a pastoral suggestion so that we can squeeze every ounce of spiritual fruit out of the Palm Sunday liturgy.

This coming Wednesday, we offer our annual Lenten Confessions evening at 7pm in our church. As of this writing, we have 7 priests confirmed to be present to hear our confessions. Your priests will be there until the last penitent has received absolution. Do not pass up this opportunity the Lord is offering you to cleanse your soul. This will be the last opportunity to go to confession before Easter as there are no confessions this coming Saturday morning.

Holy Thursday we celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper where we will have the traditional Washing of the Feet and Eucharistic Procession to the Altar of Repose. On this day, we commemorate the institution of the priesthood and the Eucharist. Two central realities of our faith that make us uniquely Catholic. The altar of repose will be open until Midnight, and for those who wish to make the pilgrimage of the Seven Monuments that evening which is so common in Latin America, here is a list of six other churches that will make it easy to finish by Midnight: St. Thomas, St. Augustine, St. Raymond,

St. Michael, St. Hugh, and the Shrine of Lady of Charity (La Ermita).

On Good Friday, we observe a day of fasting as we focus on the death of our Lord. The cross is presented to us as a sign of Christ's victory over sin and death. We will be invited during the liturgy to come forward to venerate the cross and stare on Christ's broken body. Broken for our offenses. Broken so that we may live! After the last liturgy of the day, we will have a procession around our neighborhood with the statue of the corpse of Christ. A truly somber and moving experience. I invite all our parishioners to join us for this procession. If you went to church early on Good Friday, the procession usually starts around 9:15 p.m.

Holy Saturday marks a day of silence as we stare upon the reality of the tomb and anticipate what is to come that evening at the Great Easter Vigil. I say it every year: if you have never been to an Easter Vigil, join us as we celebrate the most beautiful liturgy of the year. We live for this night! We begin in darkness and slowly build towards the celebration of Christ's resurrection! There is nothing like hearing the Gloria sung during the Easter Vigil. We also welcome new members into our parish family who have been preparing for baptism. It is the night of all nights. And if I may tempt you to come in a very practical way: if you wish to avoid the big crowds of Easter Sunday, come to the Easter Vigil.

Yes, this week is like no other. Let us treat it as such. The detailed schedule for Holy Week is printed later in this bulletin. Join us for the Holy Triduum. May we walk with Jesus on the road to Calvary and wake up on Easter morning renewed by the Risen Christ!

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

¡La Semana Santa ya está aquí! La semana más importante del año. Y por eso les presento una pregunta muy sencilla: ¿cómo piensan pasar esta semana? No podemos llevar a cabo las actividades de los próximos siete días como si fuera una semana más. Los acontecimientos de la Semana Santa transformaron la historia humana, y también deberían transformar nuestras vidas.

Hoy comenzamos con el Domingo de Ramos de la Pasión del Señor. A veces yo lamento el hecho de que las palmas que repartimos nos distraen tanto del aspecto más importante de la liturgia de hoy: la Pasión de nuestro Señor. Los invito hoy, y sé que esto posiblemente sea una tontería que estoy a punto de pedirles: ¿por qué no esperamos hasta que lleguemos a casa para hacer nuestras cruces de palma? Soltemos la palma de la mano para que podamos escuchar la riqueza de las Escrituras de hoy, incluyendo los detalles cruciales de la Pasión de nuestro Señor. Sólo una sugerencia pastoral para que podamos exprimir cada onza de fruto espiritual de la liturgia del Domingo de Ramos.

Este próximo miércoles, ofrecemos nuestra noche anual de Confesiones de Cuaresma a las 7:00 p.m. en nuestra iglesia. Al momento de escribir este artículo, tenemos 7 sacerdotes confirmados para estar presentes para escuchar nuestras confesiones. Estaremos allí hasta que el último penitente haya recibido la absolución. No dejen pasar esta oportunidad que el Señor les está ofreciendo para limpiar su alma. Esta es la última oportunidad de confesarse antes de la Pascua ya que el Sábado Santo no habrá confesiones porque estamos en el Triduo.

El Jueves Santo celebramos la Misa de la Cena del Señor donde tendremos el tradicional Lavatorio de los Pies y Procesión Eucarística hasta el Altar de Reposo. En este día, conmemoramos la institución del sacerdocio y la Eucaristía. Dos realidades centrales de nuestra fe que nos hacen singularmente católicos. El altar de reposo estará abierto hasta la medianoche, y para aquellos que deseen hacer la peregrinación de los Siete Monumentos esa noche que es tan común en América Latina, aquí hay una lista de otras seis

iglesias que harán que sea fácil terminar antes de la medianoche: St. Thomas, St. Augustine, St. Raymond, St. Michael, St. Hugh, y el Santuario de la Señora de la Caridad (La Ermita).

El Viernes Santo, observamos un día de ayuno mientras nos enfocamos en la muerte de nuestro Señor. La cruz se nos presenta como un signo de la victoria de Cristo sobre el pecado y la muerte. Seremos invitados durante la liturgia a acercarnos para venerar la cruz y mirar fijamente el cuerpo quebrantado de Cristo. Roto por nuestras ofensas. ¡Roto para que podamos vivir! Después de la última liturgia del día, tendremos una procesión por nuestro vecindario con la estatua del cadáver de Cristo. Una experiencia verdaderamente sombría y conmovedora.

El Sábado Santo marca un día de silencio mientras miramos la realidad de la tumba y anticipamos lo que vendrá esa noche en la Gran Vigilia Pascual. Lo digo todos los años: si nunca han estado en una Vigilia Pascual, únense a nosotros mientras celebramos la liturgia más hermosa del año. ¡Vivimos para esta noche! ¡Comenzamos en la oscuridad y progresamos lentamente hacia la celebración de la resurrección de Cristo! No hay nada como escuchar el Gloria cantado durante la Vigilia Pascual. También damos la bienvenida a nuevos miembros a nuestra familia parroquial que se han estado preparando para el bautismo. Es la noche de todas las noches. Y si se me permite tentarles a venir de una manera muy práctica: si desea evitar las multitudes grandes del Domingo de Pascua, vengan a la Vigilia Pascual.

Sí, esta es una semana como ninguna otra. Vamos a tratarla como tal. El horario detallado de la Semana Santa se encuentra más adelante en este boletín. Únense a nosotros para el Santo Triduo. ¡Que caminemos con Jesús en el camino al Calvario para despertarnos en la mañana de Pascua renovados por Cristo resucitado!

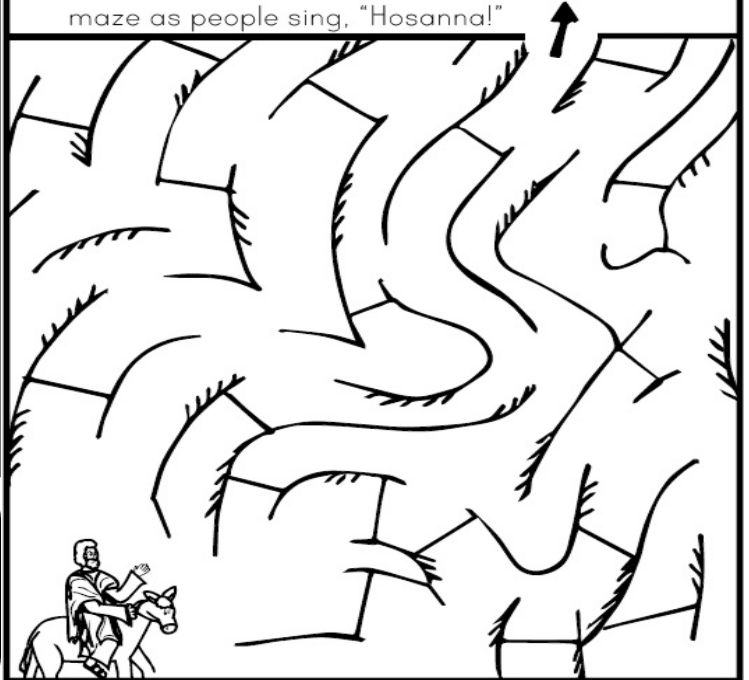
Did you get a palm branch at the beginning of Mass today? Hold your palm quietly during Mass, then take it home and keep it in a special place in your house.

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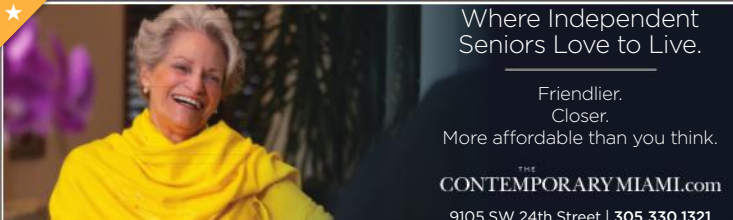
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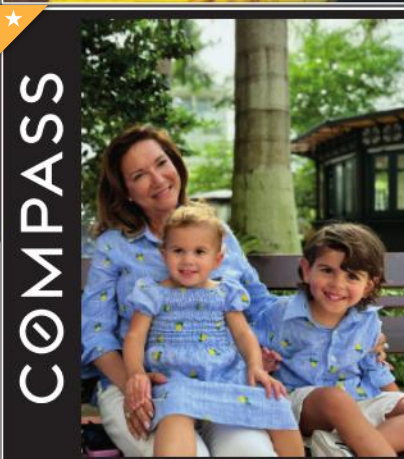


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
