



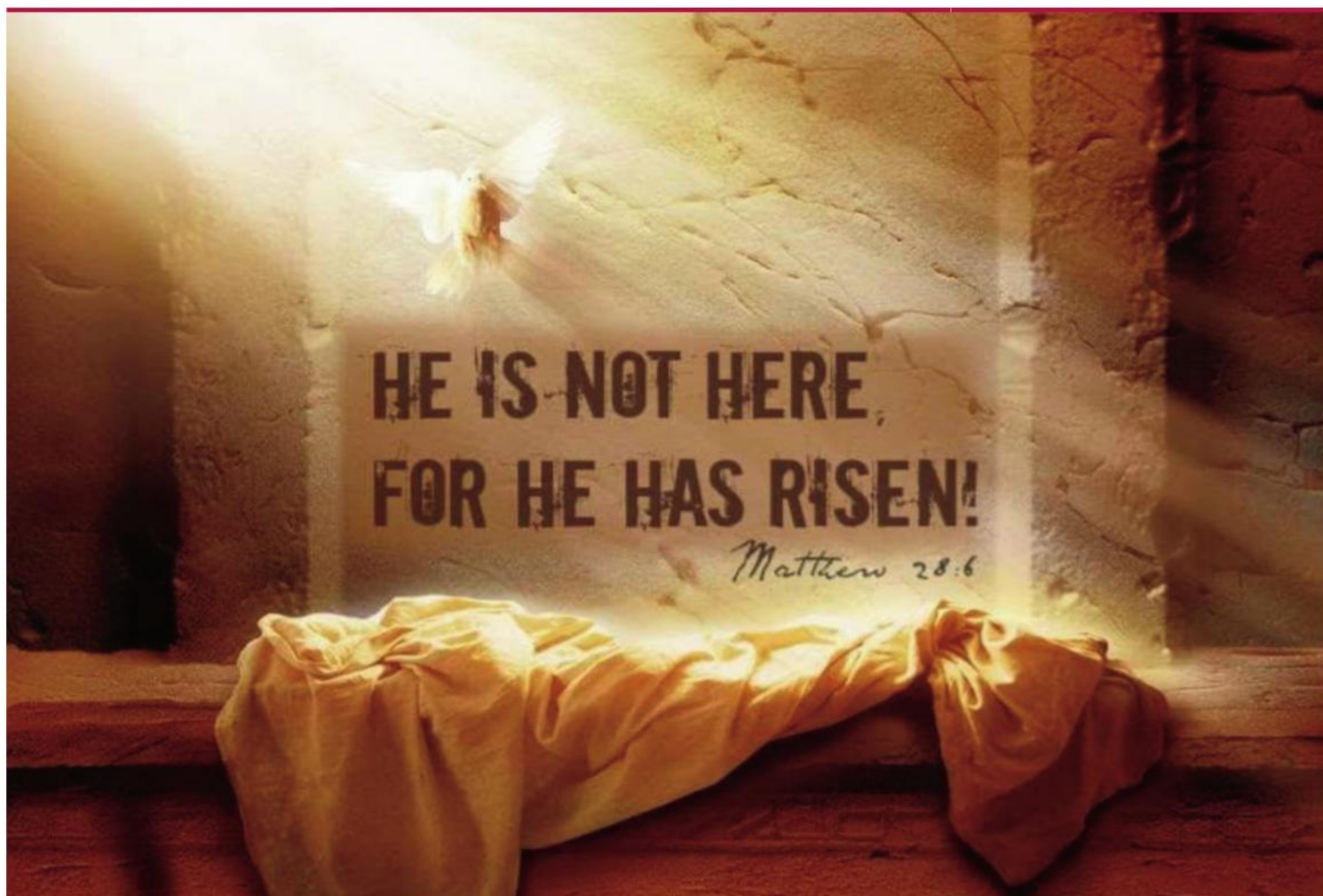

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

Happy Easter! We welcome all of our parishioners home and all of our visitors who come to this beautiful church to celebrate the most sacred day of the year. We are glad that you are here.

As you will hear in responsorial psalm today, this is truly the day the Lord has made! We rejoice in the resurrection of our Lord. This is the central dogma of our faith, and a challenge to be recreated and renewed by the Risen Christ. This day is marked, as it should be, with family gatherings and brunches or dinners, but the true challenge of Easter Sunday is to continue all the good work we did during the Lenten season. Something has changed within us during Lent, and now we must ask the Risen Lord to give us the grace to continue to grow in holiness.

At Mass today, you will renew your baptismal promises which is quite significant. We will be sprinkled by the new waters of Easter. This is a reminder that at baptism we were indeed called to holiness, and now we are reminded to take the good news of the Risen Christ to all we meet.

At Church of the Little Flower, we have been doing just that for almost 100 years. For a century we have been announcing to our corner of God's kingdom that Jesus Christ is truly risen! It is what our Emmaus brothers and sisters proclaim at every one of their retreats and gatherings. It is what our Homeless Ministry proclaims every time they feed the hungry and assist the poor. The Risen Christ is what every single one of our myriad of ministries proclaims when they go out from the beauty of our church walls to the world to bring that Risen Christ to others.

Yes, for almost 100 years, this parish community has proclaimed that Jesus Christ is Risen! Our magnificent church building itself proclaims the majesty of our God through its

beauty because inside, we experience the presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist. As a pilgrim people at the cusp of the centenary of parish, we have been chosen to ensure that this church built for the glory of God and to proclaim the Risen Christ is still standing for centuries to come.

This summer, as many of you already know, we will close the doors of our church for a few months to give the interior a much-needed paint job, restore the reredos to its original splendor, install new wooden pews, and prepare the balcony for the arrival of our new organ. It is an ambitious summer project that will have us celebrating Mass where our founders did: next door in the original church which is now Comber Hall. There is a hallmark of the parishioners of Little Flower throughout our 100-year history: we have never chosen the easy path. Our founders chose to build a glorious church with a dome seen from miles around, and because of that boldness, we now worship in the most beautiful church in the Archdiocese of Miami.

So, on this Easter Sunday, I invite you to join our Centennial Campaign so that we can continue building on the legacy of the first parishioners of Little Flower who always chose the most challenging path in order to proclaim the Risen Christ to our community. Como escucharan hoy en el salmo responsorial, ¡este es verdaderamente el día que el Señor ha hecho! Nos regocijamos en la resurrección de nuestro Señor. Este es el dogma central de nuestra fe, y un desafío que debe ser recreado y renovado por Cristo resucitado. El Cristo Resucitado es lo que cada uno de nuestros innumerables ministerios proclama cuando salen de la belleza de las paredes de nuestra iglesia al mundo para llevar a ese Cristo Resucitado a los demás.

¡Sí, durante casi 100 años, esta comunidad parroquial ha proclamado que Jesucristo ha resucitado! Nuestro magnífico edificio de la iglesia

proclama la majestad de nuestro Dios a través de su belleza porque en su interior, experimentamos la presencia de Cristo en la Sagrada Eucaristía. Como pueblo peregrino en la cúspide del centenario de la parroquia, hemos sido elegidos para asegurar que esta iglesia construida para la gloria de Dios y para proclamar a Cristo Resucitado siga en pie en los siglos venideros.

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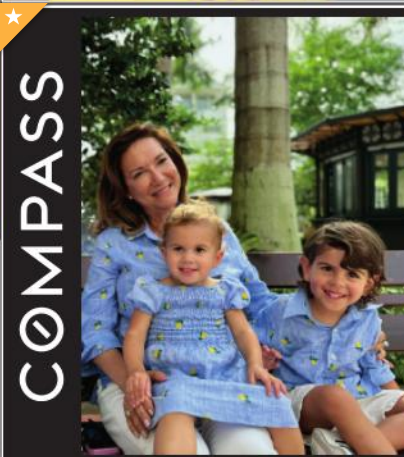
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
