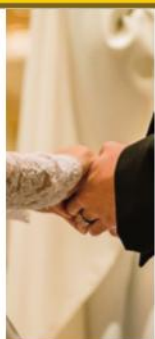

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

On this Divine Mercy Sunday, we gather still celebrating the resurrection of our Lord, but with heavy hearts over the death of our Holy Father, Pope Francis this past Easter Monday.

Much has been written and said about the Pontiff in the last week, and of all the things I can write about this extraordinary servant, allow me to share with you a personal experience of witnessing the Pope of Mercy in action.

I had the good fortune of seeing Pope Francis on three different occasions in St. Peter's Square among the people. The last time I saw him was on a trip to Rome after visiting the Holy Land with parishioners in 2017. As usual, we arrived early to the square for the Wednesday audience and got aisle seats so we could see the pope in the popemobile up close. If you've ever been to Rome for a papal event, there is always a long wait, but you get to know the good people around you who are also pilgrims coming to see the Successor of Peter. On this particular morning, I met a family from Arizona sitting next to us. They had a little girl with special needs around 3 years old sitting on their lap. The little girl's name was Ave. She was joyful, dancing to music, and even quick to offer blessings to anyone including this priest.

Now Ave was no stranger to Rome. She had been in St. Peter's Square a few years earlier, and this is where Pope Francis' love for children and for the sick comes in. When she first visited the Vatican, Ave was a baby with two holes in her heart. The pope had a custom of kissing the babies along his route in the popemobile before a general audience, and Ave's mother had her baby along the aisle. As soon as the Pope saw her, he got out of the popemobile and like a gentle and good father, embraced and kissed her. When Ave returned home to Arizona, one of the holes in her

heart had closed and the other hole was beginning to close and eventually did.

Three years later, the family was back in Vatican City to give thanks. Once again, Ave and her family were sitting on the aisle and sitting next to us. They shared their story with me, and soon thereafter the Pope came out and the guards lifted Ave out of her mother's arms so that the Holy Father could kiss her. Not a dry eye around us. We listened to the catechesis, received his blessing, and I bid farewell to this extraordinary little girl who will now forever be joined spiritually to Pope Francis.

I could've written about the many things Francis said that have moved me or on his impact on the Church, but it was this experience, this simple gesture of mercy and love that perfectly synthesizes his papacy: it was a pontificate of mercy.

I ask you to pray for the repose of the soul of Pope Francis. We will continue to offer Masses for him throughout this week.

Eternal rest grant unto your servant, Francis, O Lord. And let perpetual light shine upon him.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

En este Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, nos reunimos todavía celebrando la resurrección de nuestro Señor, pero con el corazón apesadumbrado por la muerte de nuestro Santo Padre, el Papa Francisco el pasado lunes de Pascua.

Mucho se ha escrito y dicho sobre el Pontífice en la última semana, y de todas las cosas que puedo escribir sobre este extraordinario servidor, permítanme compartir con ustedes una experiencia personal de presenciar al Papa de la Misericordia en acción.

Tuve la suerte de ver al Papa Francisco en tres ocasiones diferentes en la Plaza de San Pedro entre la gente. La última vez que lo vi fue en un viaje a Roma después de visitar Tierra Santa con feligreses en 2017. Como de costumbre, llegamos temprano a la plaza para la audiencia del miércoles y conseguimos asientos en el pasillo para poder ver de cerca al Papa en el papamóvil. Si alguna vez has estado en Roma para un evento papal, siempre hay una larga espera, pero llegas a conocer a las buenas personas que te rodean y que también son peregrinos que vienen a ver al Sucesor de Pedro. En esta mañana en particular, conocí a una familia de Arizona sentada a nuestro lado. Tenían una niña con necesidades especiales de alrededor de 3 años sentada en su regazo. La niña se llamaba Ave. Era alegre, bailaba al ritmo de la música e incluso se apresuraba a ofrecer bendiciones a cualquiera, incluido este sacerdote.

Ahora bien, Ave no era ajena a Roma. Había estado en la Plaza de San Pedro unos años antes, y aquí es donde entra en juego el amor del Papa Francisco por los niños y por los enfermos. Cuando visitó el Vaticano por primera vez, Ave era una bebé con dos agujeros en el corazón. El papa tenía la costumbre de besar a los bebés a lo largo de su ruta en el papamóvil ante una audiencia general, y la madre de Ave tenía a su bebé en el pasillo. Tan pronto como el Papa la vio, se bajó del papamóvil y, como un padre amable y bueno, la abrazó y la besó. Cuando Ave regresó a su casa en Arizona, uno de los agujeros de su corazón se había

cerrado y el otro agujero comenzaba a cerrarse y finalmente lo hizo.

Tres años después, la familia regresó a la Ciudad del Vaticano para dar gracias. Una vez más, Ave y su familia estaban sentados en el pasillo y sentados a nuestro lado. Compartieron su historia conmigo, y poco después salió el Papa y los guardias levantaron a Ave de los brazos de su madre para que el Santo Padre pudiera besarla. Ni un ojo seco a nuestro alrededor. Hemos escuchado la catequesis, hemos recibido su bendición y me despido de esta niña extraordinaria que ahora estará unida espiritualmente para siempre al Papa Francisco.

Podría haber escrito sobre las muchas cosas que Francisco dijo y que me han conmovido o sobre su impacto en la Iglesia, pero fue esta experiencia, este simple gesto de misericordia y amor lo que sintetiza perfectamente su papado: fue un pontificado de misericordia.

Les pido que recen por el descanso del alma del Papa Francisco. Continuaremos ofreciendo misas por él a lo largo de esta semana.

Dale, Señor, el descanso eterno a tu siervo, Francisco. Y brille para él la luz perpetua.

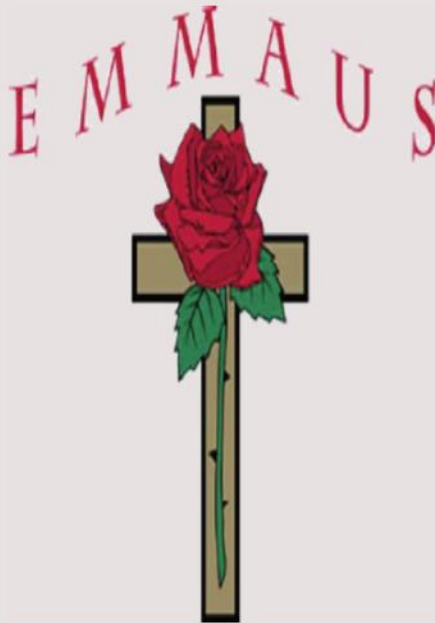



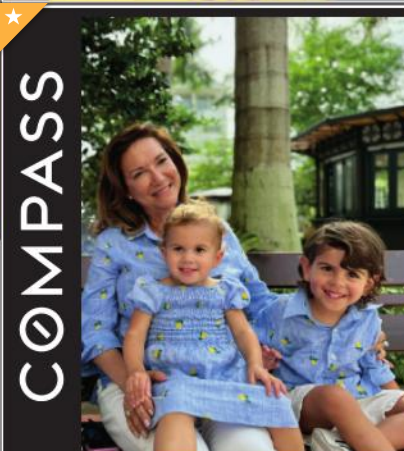
