FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends:

The mighty wind of the Holy Spirit always brings change. On the morning of Pentecost, the lives of the disciples were changed forever when they went from the familiar confines of the Upper Room to boldly preaching the Risen Christ to the multitudes in Jerusalem. The Holy Spirit changes simple bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ. He heals the wounded, brings pardon to the sinner, warms the frozen heart, refreshes a tired soul, and comforts the afflicted. All welcomed changes.

Last week in this space, I wrote about the change we will be experiencing as a parish starting tomorrow: our move for the summer to worship and celebrate Mass and the sacraments in Comber Hall. As Father David and I announced last week, we will be “cozier” in the small space that used to be our church a century ago. All of us are used to sitting in our favorite pew, in a specific part of the church. Yet, the Spirit is prompting us to get out of our comfort zones even if for a few months so that we can do some necessary upkeep of our church.

Children needing baptism will be baptized in a temporary font. Confessions on Saturdays will be on the second floor of the hall with priests spread out for privacy. Funerals will still be celebrated for our faithful departed. And believe it or not, even a wedding is scheduled to be celebrated in July in our temporary worship space. Worship aids, songs, and the readings of the day will be printed in this bulletin.

What I ask all of you to pray for during this time of transition is patience, a fruit of the Holy Spirit. Much planning has been done to make the move next door as smooth as possible, but the first week or two will indeed be bumpy because all the planning in the world cannot prepare us for a full Sunday Mass crowd and the logistics of a new space. Pray for the virus of adaptability. The most important thing we do as a parish will still be there: the Divine Sacrifice of the Mass.

During this past week, some dedicated parishioners have started decorating our temporary worship space with great love and care. While nothing can replicate the splendor of our church and sanctuary, we pray you will find a warm, welcoming, and prayerful environment when you come in next week. For our daily Mass goers, you will slowly see our saints and devotional candles making their way over during the next few days. Little touches of the church to make us feel at home.

As for the work in the church, first thing Monday morning, the work of removing our old pews begins followed by the reinforcement of the balcony, then the restoration of the reredos and finally the painting of the interior and the installation of the new pews. It is a bold endeavor, and we now look forward to our return to a rejuvenated church this fall. The Holy Spirit indeed always brings change. May we be able to embrace it.

One final note about change. This Sunday is the last Mass for our 5:30pm young adult choir, “The Call.” For the past five years, they have lifted up our spirits with their praise and worship songs and moving post-communion meditations. But as it is with our young people, moves are made, the young get married and start families of their own, and the Spirit calls us elsewhere. They have served the Church of the Little Flower well and have blessed us with the gift of song. Thankfully, other young adults from our parish and alumni of our school have stepped up and committed to continue the legacy of The Call by forming a new young adult choir that we hope will start singing when school begins. So, one final thank you to The Call for your unwavering commitment to your ministry and your joyful spirit. May the Spirit always guide you and strengthen you and always know there is an open mic ready for any of you when you want to lead us in song.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos:

El poderoso viento del Espíritu Santo siempre trae cambio. En la mañana de Pentecostés, la vida de los discípulos cambió para siempre cuando pasaron de los confines familiares del Aposento Alto a predicar audazmente a Cristo resucitado a las multitudes en Jerusalén. El Espíritu Santo transforma el pan y el vino sencillos en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. Él sana a los heridos, trae el perdón al pecador, calienta el corazón helado, refresca un alma cansada y consuela a los afligidos. Todos los cambios son bienvenidos.

La semana pasada en este espacio, escribí sobre el cambio que experimentaremos como parroquia a partir de mañana: nuestro traslado para el verano para adorar y celebrar la Misa y los sacramentos en Comber Hall. Como el Padre David y yo anunciamos la semana pasada, estaremos "más acogedores" en el pequeño espacio que solía ser nuestra iglesia hace un siglo. Todos estamos acostumbrados a sentarnos en nuestro banco favorito, en una parte específica de la iglesia. Sin embargo, el Espíritu nos está impulsando a salir de nuestra zona de confort, aunque sea por unos meses, para que podamos hacer el mantenimiento necesario de nuestra iglesia.

Los niños que necesiten bautizarse serán bautizados en una pila temporal. Las confesiones de los sábados serán en el segundo piso de la sala con sacerdotes dispersos para mayor privacidad. Todavía se celebrarán funerales para nuestros fieles difuntos. Y lo creas o no, incluso una boda está programada para celebrarse en julio en nuestro espacio de adoración temporal. Las ayudas para la adoración, las canciones y las lecturas del día se imprimirán en este boletín.

Lo que les pido a todos ustedes que oren durante este tiempo de transición es paciencia, fruto del Espíritu Santo. Se ha hecho mucha planificación para que la mudanza de al lado sea lo más suave posible, pero la primera o segunda semana será realmente accidentada porque toda la planificación del mundo no puede prepararnos para una multitud completa de misa dominical y la logística de un nuevo espacio. Oren por el virus de la adaptabilidad. Lo más importante que hacemos como parroquia seguirá ahí: el Divino Sacrificio de la Misa.

Durante la semana pasada, algunos feligreses dedicados han comenzado a decorar nuestro espacio de adoración temporal con gran amor y cuidado. Si bien nada puede replicar el esplendor de nuestra iglesia y santuario, oramos para que encuentre un ambiente cálido, acogedor y de oración cuando venga la próxima semana. Para nuestros asistentes diarios a Misa, verán lentamente a nuestros santos y velas devocionales abriéndose camino durante los próximos días. Pequeños toques de la iglesia para que nos sintamos como en casa.

En cuanto a los trabajos en la iglesia, a primera hora de la mañana del lunes, comienza el trabajo de remoción de nuestros viejos bancos, seguido del refuerzo del balcón, luego la restauración del retablo y finalmente la pintura del interior y la instalación de los nuevos bancos. Es un esfuerzo audaz, y ahora esperamos con ansias nuestro regreso a una iglesia rejuvenecida este otoño. De hecho, el Espíritu Santo siempre trae cambio. Que seamos capaces de abrazarlo.

Una nota final sobre el cambio. Este domingo es la última misa para nuestro coro de jóvenes adultos de las 5:30 p.m., "The Call". Durante los últimos cinco años, han levantado nuestros espíritus con sus canciones de alabanza y adoración y sus conmovedoras mediaciones posteriores a la comunión. Pero al igual que con nuestros jóvenes, se hacen mudanzas, los jóvenes se casan y forman sus propias familias, y el Espíritu nos llama a otra parte. Han servido bien a la Iglesia de la Pequeña Flor y nos han bendecido con el don del canto. Afortunadamente, otros jóvenes adultos de nuestra parroquia y ex alumnos de nuestra escuela han dado un paso adelante y se han comprometido a continuar el legado de, The Call, formando un nuevo coro de jóvenes adultos que esperamos comience a cantar cuando comiencen las clases. Así que, un último agradecimiento a El Llamado por su compromiso inquebrantable con su ministerio y su espíritu alegre. Que el Espíritu siempre los guíe y los fortalezca y que siempre sepan que hay un micrófono abierto listo para cualquiera de ustedes cuando quieran guiarnos en la canción.

PARDON OUR DUST! SUMMER CONSTRUCTION PLANS

Beginning Monday, June 9th all Masses and liturgical celebrations will be taking place in Comber Hall as construction begins inside the church ahead of the February arrival of our new pipe organ.

During this phase of the work, the balcony will be reinforced to support the weight of the new organ, the entire interior of the church will be repainted, including a golden accent on the interior of the dome, the altar reredos and the side altars of the Blessed Virgin Mary, St. Joseph, St. Therese and St. Anthony will all be cleaned up and restored, and our new pews will be installed.

We anticipate a return to the church in October but until then, we will celebrate Mass in the same space as our founding parishioners did a century ago!

PIPE ORGANS ARE FOREVER... AND NOW YOUR LEGACY CAN BE, TOO!

With our centennial celebrations now underway, we are pleased to announce a new, once-in-a-lifetime legacy gift opportunity.

Our new pipe organ will contain about 3,000 pipes and each one of those pipes is now available to be dedicated in memory of a loved one, to commemorate major milestones like baptisms, first communions, confirmations, graduations, birthdays, weddings, or anniversaries, or simply to add your family's name to the legacy of our parish in this milestone year.

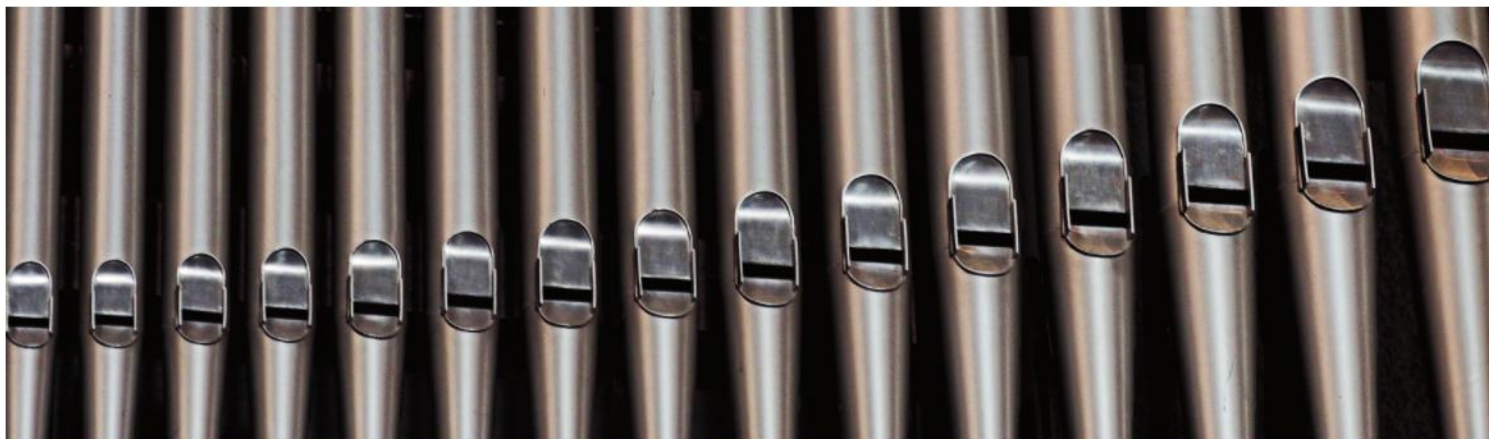
Fisk Opus 166, which will be arriving here early next year, is now over 50% constructed, with over 85% of our pipes already made. Each of the tin pipes is meticulously hand-crafted, from the melting of the metals and the creation of large tin sheets to the precise measuring, cutting, rolling, soldering, and detailed finishing of each individual pipe's various parts.

Pipe Memorializations will be recorded in a specially printed booklet which will be provided to each donor at no additional cost early next year.

A copy of the booklet will also remain inside the organ in perpetuity, ensuring the lasting legacy of both the instrument itself and of all those who helped to make it possible.

The 2,940 interior pipes are now available for dedication for \$400 each. The 60 facade pipes, forever visible on the front of each of the organ's three major cases, are available for \$1,000 each.

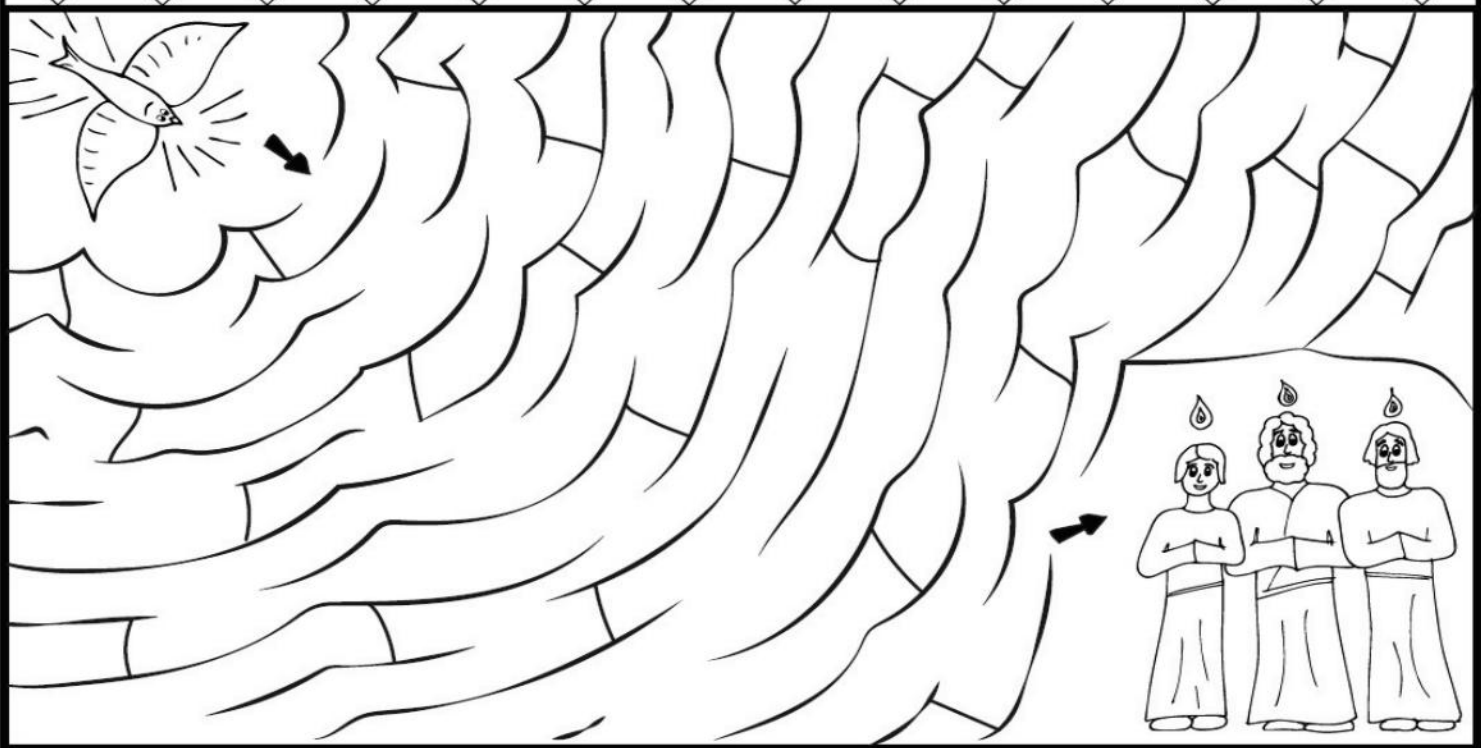


Today is Pentecost.
