FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

My Dear Friends:

Welcome to our (original) church. As you look around our new worship space this weekend, I want you to put yourself in the shoes of our founding parishioners. In 1927, the building where we will be celebrating Mass for the next few months was consecrated as a church. Imagine how the first Catholics of Coral Gables must have felt when they walked into a church they could call their own and not have to celebrate Mass in a small chapel or a theater. This was their home for the first 25 years of our parish's existence. Our first baptisms and weddings were celebrated here. We have a couple of parishioners who remember receiving their First Communions here.

A few years ago, I remember a parishioner showing me pictures of her parents' wedding here in the old church in the 1940's. Her father was a sailor and was dressed in his formal Navy blues. The façade of this building looked a bit different and for a while, along with the Biltmore hotel and our school's three-story building, it was the only prominent building in the neighborhood.

This is where we will be offering the Divine Sacrifice of the Mass over the next few months. We have moved the saints and the devotional candles back here so that it could truly feel like home, but what makes this place sacred is the Real Presence of Christ in the tabernacle and the presence of all of you!

The pews in our main church were removed quite quickly on Monday morning and repairs to our balcony are currently underway to prepare for our pipe organ next year.

You will notice that my bulletin columns will be briefer this summer since more space is needed in the bulletin for the Sunday Mass readings and songs. On this Trinity Sunday, we commend our parish to the Holy Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit to guide us and transform us this summer into the divine image of Christ, our Lord.

And one last thing: Happy Father's Day to all our fathers. May St. Joseph always protect you and your families.

Mis Queridos Amigos

Bienvenidos a nuestra iglesia (original). Al mirar alrededor de nuestro nuevo espacio de adoración este fin de semana, quiero que se ponga en los zapatos de nuestros feligreses fundadores. En 1927, el edificio donde celebraremos la misa durante los próximos meses fue consagrado como iglesia. Imagínese cómo se deben haber sentido los primeros católicos de Coral Gables cuando entraron a una iglesia que podían llamar suya y no tener que celebrar misa en una pequeña capilla o en un teatro. Este fue su hogar durante los primeros 25 años de existencia de nuestra parroquia. Nuestros primeros bautizos y bodas se celebraron aquí. Tenemos un par de feligreses que recuerdan haber recibido sus primeras comuniones aquí.

Hace unos años, recuerdo a una feligresa que me mostró fotos de la boda de sus padres aquí en la vieja iglesia en la década de 1940. Su padre era marinero y vestía sus trajes formales de azul marino. La fachada de este edificio se veía un poco diferente y durante un tiempo, junto con el hotel Biltmore y el edificio de tres pisos de nuestra escuela, fue el único edificio prominente en el vecindario.

Aquí es donde ofreceremos el Divino Sacrificio de la Misa durante los próximos meses. Hemos trasladado los santos y las velas devocionales aquí para que realmente se sienta como en casa, pero lo que hace que este lugar sea sagrado es la Presencia Real de Cristo en el tabernáculo y la presencia de todos ustedes.

Los bancos de nuestra iglesia principal se retiraron bastante rápido el lunes por la mañana y se están realizando reparaciones en nuestro balcón para prepararnos para nuestro órgano de tubos el próximo año.

Notarán que las columnas de mi boletín serán más breves este verano, ya que se necesita más espacio en el boletín para las lecturas y canciones de la Misa dominical. En este Domingo de la Trinidad, encomendamos nuestra parroquia a la Santísima Trinidad, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo para que nos guíe y nos transforme este verano a la imagen divina de Cristo, nuestro Señor.

Y una última cosa: Feliz Día del Padre a todos nuestros padres. Que San José siempre los proteja a ustedes y a sus familias.

TODAY'S READINGS / LECTURAS DEL DÍA

Reading I: Proverbs 8:22-31

Thus says the wisdom of God: "The LORD possessed me, the beginning of his ways, the forerunner of his prodigies of long ago; from of old I was poured forth, at the first, before the earth. When there were no depths I was brought forth, when there were no fountains or springs of water; before the mountains were settled into place, before the hills, I was brought forth; while as yet the earth and fields were not made, nor the first clods of the world.

"When the Lord established the heavens I was there, when he marked out the vault over the face of the deep; when he made firm the skies above, when he fixed fast the foundations of the earth; when he set for the sea its limit, so that the waters should not transgress his command; then was I beside him as his craftsman, and I was his delight day by day, playing before him all the while, playing on the surface of his earth; and I found delight in the human race."

He will not speak on his own, but he will speak what he hears, and will declare to you the things that are coming. He will glorify me, because he will take from what is mine and declare it to you. Everything that the Father has is mine; for this reason I told you that he will take from what is mine and declare it to you."

PARDON OUR DUST! SUMMER CONSTRUCTION PLANS

For the next few months, all Masses and liturgies will be taking place in our Old Church as construction begins inside the main church ahead of the February arrival of our new pipe organ.

During this phase of the work, the balcony will be reinforced to support the weight of the new organ, the entire interior of the church will be repainted, including a golden accent on the interior of the dome, the altar reredos and the side altars of the Blessed Virgin Mary, St. Joseph, St. Therese and St. Anthony will all be cleaned up and restored, and our new pews will be installed.

We anticipate a return to the church in October but until then, we will celebrate Mass in the same space as our founding parishioners did a century ago!

PIPE ORGANS ARE FOREVER... AND NOW YOUR LEGACY CAN BE, TOO!

With our centennial celebrations now underway, we are pleased to announce a new, once-in-a-lifetime legacy gift opportunity.

Our new pipe organ will contain about 3,000 pipes and each one of those pipes is now available to be dedicated in memory of a loved one, to commemorate major milestones like baptisms, first communions, confirmations, graduations, birthdays, weddings, or anniversaries, or simply to add your family's name to the legacy of our parish in this milestone year.

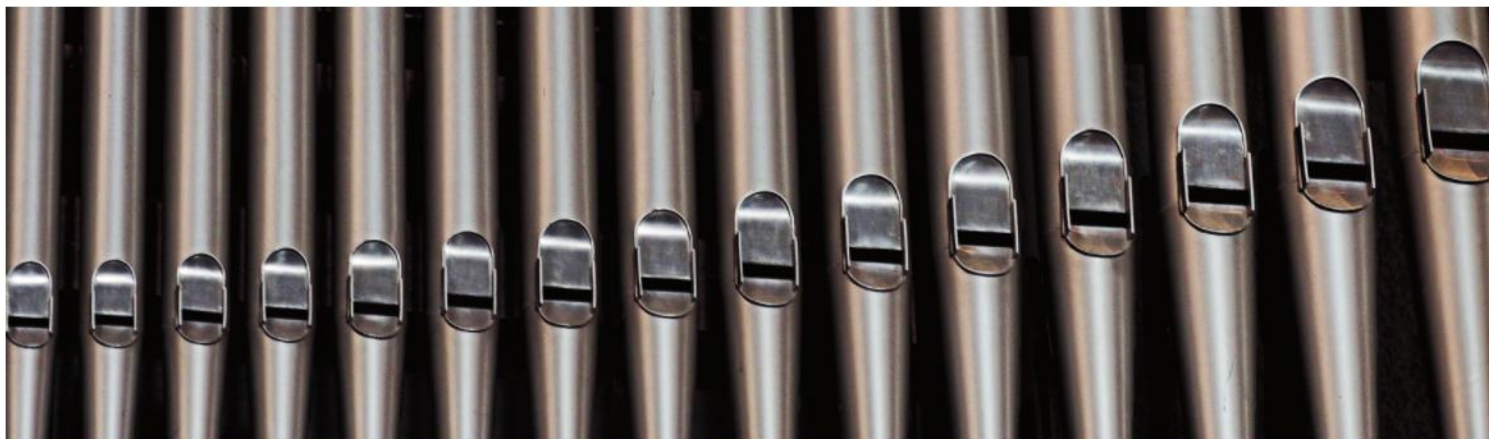
Fisk Opus 166, which will be arriving here early next year, is now over 50% constructed, with over 85% of our pipes already made. Each of the tin pipes is meticulously hand-crafted, from the melting of the metals and the creation of large tin sheets to the precise measuring, cutting, rolling, soldering, and detailed finishing of each individual pipe's various parts.

Pipe Memorializations will be recorded in a specially printed booklet which will be provided to each donor at no additional cost early next year.

A copy of the booklet will also remain inside the organ in perpetuity, ensuring the lasting legacy of both the instrument itself and of all those who helped to make it possible.

The 2,940 interior pipes are now available for dedication for \$400 each. The 60 facade pipes, forever visible on the front of each of the organ's three major cases, are available for \$1,000 each.

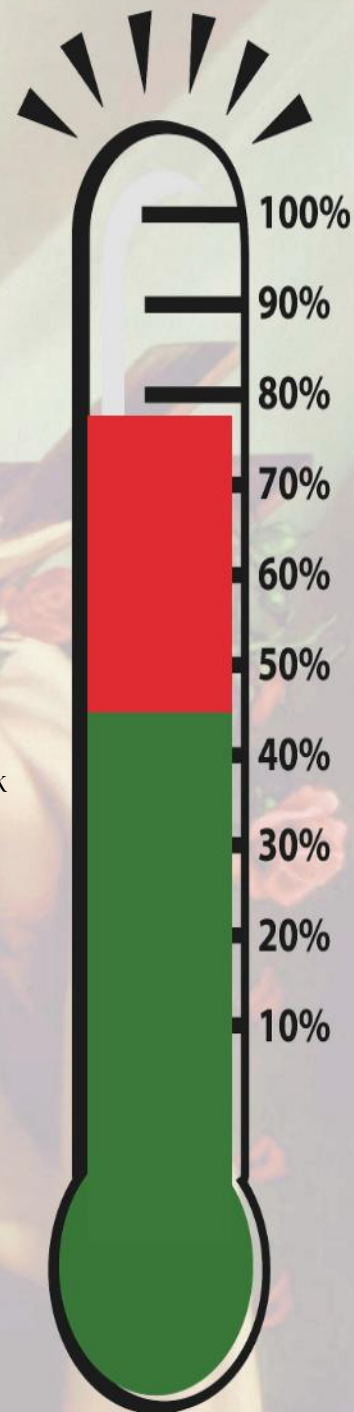
