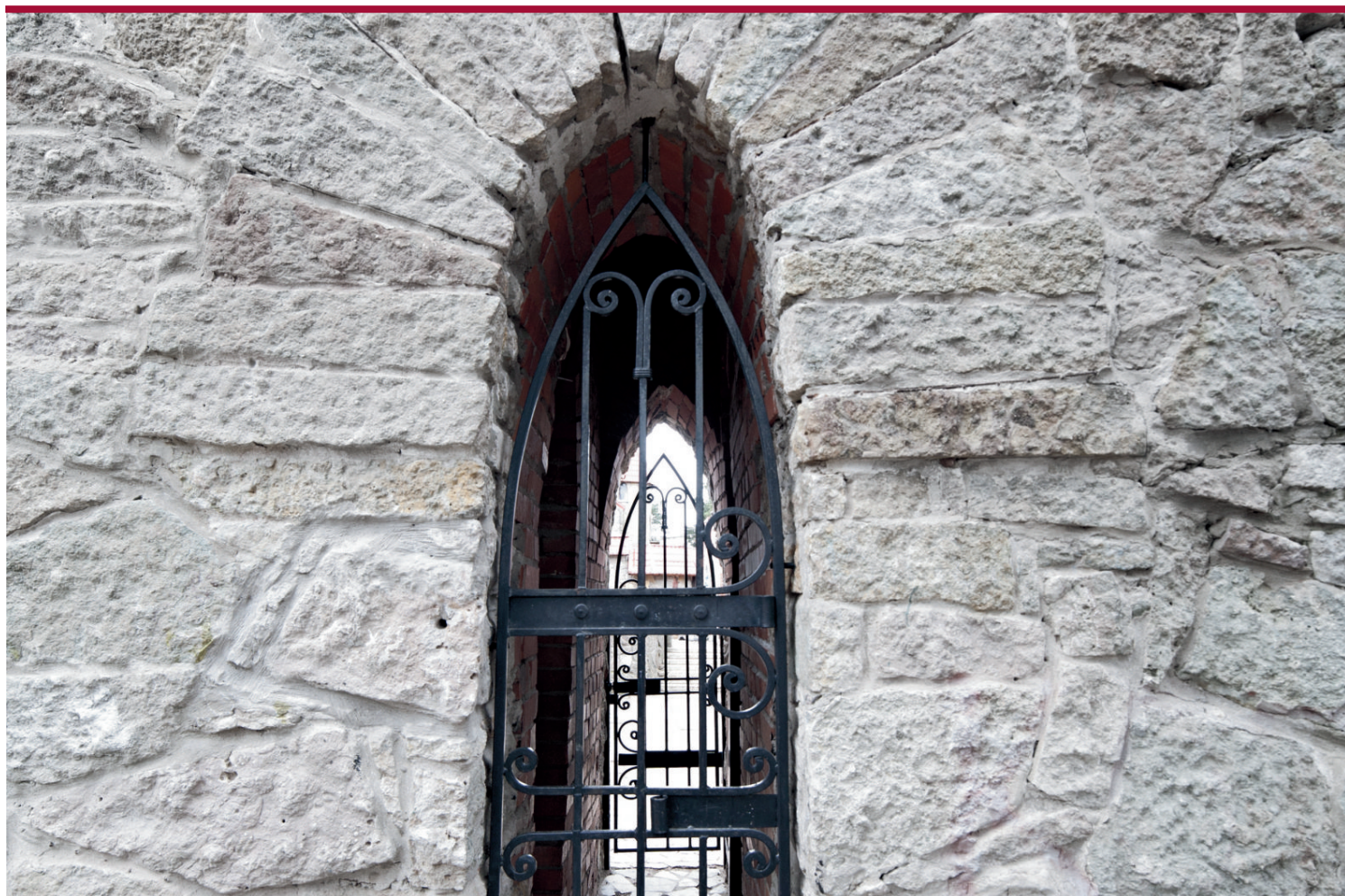

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

School started almost two weeks ago, and we have had a wonderful beginning to our 100th year at St. Theresa. I know many of our young parishioners had wonderful first weeks at their respective schools. Now that classes have begun, parents are no doubt registering their children in all types of interesting activities like sports or dance or learning a foreign language or a musical instrument. All of these are important for a well-rounded child, but there's one thing that is essential that I left off that list: have you registered your child for Religious Education?

At this time of year, I always repeat the mantra that the late, saintly Bishop Roman used to repeat every year as school began: "Every child should be registered in catechesis!" The children of this parish who attend our parochial school already receive catechesis daily. Now I invite the parents of the children who do not attend our school to register your children in our Religious Education program today! It's very easy to do. Just visit www.cotlfireligioused.org and you can enroll your child right now.

If your child is in 1st grade, they can already begin their two-year preparation for First Holy Communion, and if your child is in 7th grade, they can begin their two-year journey towards Confirmation. But they don't have to be preparing for a sacrament. I know I sound like a broken record, but I attended our great Religious Education program here when I was in the 6th grade in a non-sacramental year. I remember learning so much about the Old Testament during that year. Sure, as a kid I didn't want to sit in a classroom after regular school ended, but for my parents it was non-negotiable: just like attending Mass on Sundays, we had to go receive catechesis at our parish during the week.

So, I encourage every parent to enroll your sons and daughters today. And to the grandparents, I know many of your adult children may not be practicing the faith in the way that you taught them, and you worry about your grandchildren's religious upbringing. This is the time to gently remind your kids to register your grandkids in Religious Ed. We have so many heroic grandparents who drop off and pick up their grandkids every week. We can't thank them enough and we pray for them this day.

And to the rest of the community, next month we also begin our classes for the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults (OCIA). Deacon Fleitas and his wife Nancy do such an amazing job of preparing adults who have never been baptized, who may be missing one of the sacraments, or may need their marriage convalidated. If you or someone you know needs a sacrament, contact the parish office and we'll get you signed up for these classes that begin in late September.

I haven't forgotten those who don't need any of the above. Remember that our parish we are subscribe to the Formed online series with lots of great movies and talks particularly in the midst of this Year of Jubilee, and we are about to embark on parish wide partnership with the Hallow App that I know many of you subscribe to. Our religious formation as Catholics doesn't end when we take our last religion class in school or Religious Ed. It is ongoing. It is vital that we know our faith in an intimate way so that we can properly communicate and more importantly live it! It's registration time at Little Flower! Religious Education. OCIA. Formed. Parish ministries and retreats. All of them return next month! Register your kids, your grandkids, or your friends today!

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

La escuela ha comenzado, y tuvimos una primera semana maravillosa al otro lado de la calle en Santa Teresa, y sé que muchos de nuestros jóvenes feligreses tuvieron primeras semanas maravillosas también en sus respectivas escuelas. Ahora que han comenzado las clases, los padres sin duda están inscribiendo a sus hijos en todo tipo de actividades interesantes como deportes o baile o aprender un idioma extranjero o un instrumento musical. Todo esto es importante para ser un niño completo, pero hay una cosa que es esencial y que dejé fuera de esa lista: ¿ha inscrito a su hijo para la Educación Religiosa?

En esta época del año, siempre repito el mantra que el difunto y santo Obispo Román solía repetir cada año cuando comenzaba la escuela: "¡Todos los niños deben ser inscritos en la catequesis!" Los niños de esta parroquia que asisten a nuestra escuela parroquial ya reciben catequesis diariamente. ¡Ahora invito a los padres de los niños que no asisten a nuestra escuela a inscribir a sus hijos en nuestro programa de Educación Religiosa hoy! Es muy fácil de hacer. Simplemente visite www.cotlreligioused.org y puede inscribir a su hijo ahora mismo.

Si su hijo/a está en primer grado, ya puede comenzar su preparación de dos años para la Primera Comunión, y si su hijo está en séptimo grado, puede comenzar su jornada de dos años hacia la Confirmación. Pero no tienen que estar preparándose para un Sacramento. Sé que suena como un disco rayado, pero asistí a nuestro gran programa de Educación Religiosa aquí cuando estaba en el sexto grado en un año no sacramental. Recuerdo haber aprendido mucho sobre el Antiguo Testamento durante ese año. Claro, cuando era niño no quería sentarme en un aula después de que terminara la escuela regular, pero para mis padres no era negociable: al igual que asistir a misa los domingos, teníamos que ir a recibir catequesis a nuestra parroquia durante la semana.

Por lo tanto, animo a todos los padres a inscribir a sus hijos e hijas hoy. Y a los abuelos, sé que muchos de sus hijos adultos pueden no estar practicando la fe de la manera en que ustedes les enseñaron, y se preocupan por la educación religiosa de sus nietos. Este es el momento de recordarle sutilmente a sus hijos que inscriban a sus nietos en Educación Religiosa. Tenemos tantos abuelos heroicos que dejan y recogen a los nietos cada semana. No podemos agradecerles lo suficiente y oramos por ellos en este día.

Y para el resto de la comunidad, el próximo mes también comenzamos nuestras clases de catecumenado para el Orden de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos (OICA). El Diácono Fleitas y su esposa Nancy hacen un trabajo increíble al preparar adultos que nunca han sido bautizados, que les pueden faltar uno de los sacramentos, o pueden necesitar convalidar su matrimonio. Si usted o alguien que conoce necesita un sacramento, comuníquese con la oficina parroquial y lo inscribiremos en las clases que comienzan a fines de septiembre.

No he olvidado a aquellos que no necesitan nada de lo anterior. Nuestra formación religiosa como católicos no termina cuando tomamos nuestra última clase de religión en la escuela o en educación religiosa. Es continuo. ¡Es vital que conozcamos nuestra fe de una manera íntima para que podamos comunicarnos adecuadamente y, lo que es más importante, vivirla! ¡Es hora de inscribirse en Santa Teresita! Educación Religiosa. OICA. Ministerios y retiros parroquiales. ¡Todos ellos regresan el próximo mes! Inscriban a sus hijos, sus nietos o sus amigos hoy.

TODAY'S READINGS / LECTURAS DEL DÍA

Reading I: Isaiah 66:18-21

Thus says the LORD: I know their works and their thoughts, and I come to gather nations of every language; they shall come and see my glory. I will set a sign among them; from them I will send fugitives to the nations: to Tarshish, Put and Lud, Mosoch, Tubal and Javan, to the distant coastlands that have never heard of my fame, or seen my glory; and they shall proclaim my glory among the nations. They shall bring all your brothers and sisters from all the nations as an offering to the LORD, on horses and in chariots, in carts, upon mules and dromedaries, to Jerusalem, my holy mountain, says the LORD, just as the Israelites bring their offering to the house of the LORD in clean vessels. Some of these I will take as priests and Levites, says the LORD.

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 117:1,2

R:/ Go out to all the world and tell the Good News.

Praise the LORD, all you nations;
glorify him, all you peoples!

For steadfast is his kindness toward us,
and the fidelity of the LORD endures forever.

Reading II: Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13

Brothers and sisters, You have forgotten the exhortation addressed to you as children: *My son, do not disdain the discipline of the Lord or lose heart when reproved by him; for whom the Lord loves, he disciplines; he scourges every son he acknowledges.* Endure your trials as "discipline"; God treats you as sons. For what "son" is there whom his father does not discipline? At the time, all discipline seems a cause not for joy but for pain, yet later it brings the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who are trained by it. So strengthen your drooping hands and your weak knees. Make straight paths for your feet, that what is lame may not be disjointed but healed.

Gospel: Luke 13:22-30

Jesus passed through towns and villages, teaching as he went and making his way to Jerusalem. Someone asked him, "Lord, will only a few people be saved?" He answered them, "Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I tell you, will attempt to enter but will not be strong enough. After the master of the house has arisen and locked the door, then will you stand outside knocking and saying, 'Lord, open the door for us.' He will say to you in reply, 'I do not know where you are from. And you will say, 'We ate and drank in your company and you taught in our streets.' Then he will say to you, 'I do not know where you are from. Depart from me, all you evildoers!' And there will be wailing and grinding of teeth when you see Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God and you yourselves cast out. And people will come from the east and the west and from the north and the south and will recline at table in the kingdom of God. For behold, some are last who will be first, and some are first who will be last."

Primera Lectura: Isaías 66, 18-21

Esto dice el Señor: "Yo vendré para reunir a las naciones de toda lengua. Vendrán y verán mi gloria. Pondré en medio de ellos un signo, y enviaré como mensajeros a algunos de los supervivientes hasta los países más lejanos y las islas más remotas, que no han oído hablar de mí ni han visto mi gloria, y ellos darán a conocer mi nombre a las naciones. Así como los hijos de Israel traen ofrendas al templo del Señor en vasijas limpias, así también mis mensajeros traerán, de todos los países, como ofrenda al Señor, a los hermanos de ustedes a caballo, en carro, en literas, en mulos y camellos, hasta mi monte santo de Jerusalén. De entre ellos escogeré sacerdotes y levitas".

Salmo Responsorial: Salmo 116, 1. 2

R:/ Vayan por todo el mundo y prediquen el Evangelio.

Que alaben al Señor todas las naciones,
que lo aclamen todos los pueblos.

Porque grande es su amor hacia nosotros
y su fidelidad dura por siempre.

Segunda Lectura: Hebreos 12, 5-7. 11-13

Hermanos: Ya se han olvidado ustedes de la exhortación que Dios les dirigió, como a hijos, diciendo: *Hijo mío, no desprecies la corrección del Señor; ni te desanimes cuando te reprenda. Porque el Señor corrige a los que ama, y da azotes a sus hijos predilectos.* Soporten, pues, la corrección, porque Dios los trata como a hijos; ¿y qué padre hay que no corrija a sus hijos? Es cierto que de momento ninguna corrección nos causa alegría, sino más bien tristeza. Pero después produce, en los que la recibieron, frutos de paz y de santidad. Por eso, robustezcan sus manos cansadas y sus rodillas vacilantes; caminen por un camino plano, para que el cojo ya no se tropiece, sino más bien se alivie.

Evangelio: Lucas 13, 22-30

En aquel tiempo, Jesús iba enseñando por ciudades y pueblos, mientras se encaminaba a Jerusalén. Alguien le preguntó: "Señor, ¿es verdad que son pocos los que se salvan?" Jesús le respondió: "Esfuércense en entrar por la puerta, que es angosta, pues yo les aseguro que muchos tratarán de entrar y no podrán. Cuando el dueño de la casa se levante de la mesa y cierre la puerta, ustedes se quedarán afuera y se pondrán a tocar la puerta, diciendo: 'Señor, ábrenos!' Pero él les responderá: 'No sé quiénes son ustedes'. Entonces le dirán con insistencia: 'Hemos comido y bebido contigo y tú has enseñado en nuestras plazas'. Pero él replicará: 'Yo les aseguro que no sé quiénes son ustedes. Apártense de mí todos ustedes los que hacen el mal'. Entonces llorarán ustedes y se desesperarán, cuando vean a Abraham, a Isaac, a Jacob y a todos los profetas en el Reino de Dios, y ustedes se vean echados fuera. Vendrán muchos del oriente y del poniente, del norte y del sur, y participarán en el banquete del Reino de Dios. Pues los que ahora son los últimos, serán los primeros; y los que ahora son los primeros, serán los últimos".

La Ermita was designated by Archbishop Wenski as a jubilee pilgrimage site during this year of jubilee for the Catholic Church and the faithful can gain a plenary indulgence by making the pilgrimage, going to confession, receiving the Eucharist, and praying for the intentions of the Pope.

Mass will be celebrated at 8:00pm that evening and will be preceded by the praying of the rosary and an opportunity to go to confession.

Pray to Saint Maximilian Kolbe when you need courage.

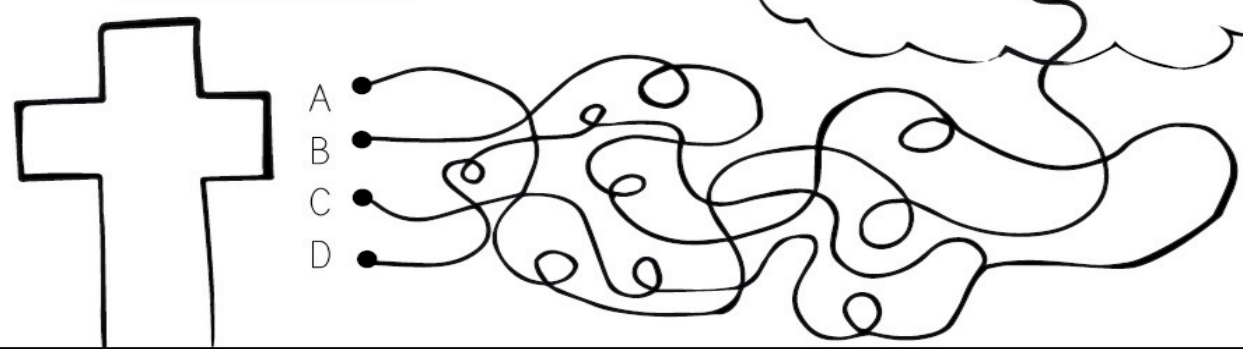
