

My Dear Friends,

Yesterday we celebrated the feast of St. Teresa of Calcutta (Mother Teresa). In last week's homily I shared with you some of the list that she kept to acquire the virtue of humility. Here is the list in its entirety:

- 1. Speak as little as possible about yourself.
- 2. Keep busy with your own affairs and not those of others.
- 3. Avoid curiosity (this refers to wanting to know things that should not concern you.)
- 4. Do not interfere in the affairs of others.
- 5. Accept small irritations with good humor.
- 6. Do not dwell on the faults of others.
- 7. Accept censures even if unmerited.
- 8. Give in to the will of others.
- 9. Accept insults and injuries.
- 10. Accept contempt, being forgotten and disregarded.
- 11. Be courteous and delicate even when provoked by someone.
- 12. Do not seek to be admired and loved.
- 13. Do not protect yourself behind your own dignity.
- 14. Give in, in discussions, even when you are right.
- 15. Choose always the more difficult task.

Mother Teresa well said that humility is the mother of all virtues, and just last week Pope Leo XIV called upon us to embrace this virtue: "Let us pray that the Church will always be a school of humility for everyone, a home where all are welcome, a place where rivalries are set aside and where Jesus still speaks to us and teaches us to imitate his own humility and freedom."

I invite you to meditate on this list. What applies to you? What can you eradicate from your life? Humility is the path to holiness!

 - 14. Cede en discusiones, incluso cuando tengas razón.
 - 15. Elige siempre la tarea más difícil.

PIPE ORGANS ARE FOREVER... And now your legacy can be, Too!

Fisk Opus 166, which will be arriving here early next year, is now being erected at the Fisk workshop in Gloucester, MA. Keep on eye on their Facebook and Instagram pages (@cbfisk) for regular updates as the three towers get built up and the pipes start to get put in place.

Our new pipe organ will contain about 3,000 pipes and each one of them has been meticulously hand-crafted, from the melting of the metals and the creation of large tin sheets to the precise measuring, cutting, rolling, soldering, and detailed finishing of each individual pipe's various parts.

As we announced over the summer, those pipes are specially available to be dedicated in memory of a loved one, to commemorate major milestones like baptisms, first communions, confirmations, graduations, birthdays, weddings, or anniversaries, or simply to add your family's name to the long legacy of our parish in this milestone year.

Pipe Memorializations will be recorded in a specially printed booklet which will be provided to each donor at no additional cost early next year. A copy of the booklet will also remain inside the organ in perpetuity, ensuring the lasting legacy of both the instrument itself and of all those who helped to make it possible.

The 2,938 interior pipes remain available for dedication for \$400 each.

43 of the 60 facade pipes, forever visible on the front of each of the organ's three major cases, remain available for \$1,000 each.






