## FROMTHE PASTOR'S DESK DELESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

#### My Dear Friends,

Happy 100th Birthday St. Theresa! Tomorrow, we celebrate the 100th birthday of our parochial school which opened its doors as St. Joseph Academy on September 15, 1925. It will be a day of celebration here on campus as the children will attend Mass to properly celebrate this milestone, and then they will spend the day having a big birthday bash during the school day. It is indeed a reason to celebrate.

Tomorrow also marks the official beginning of our yearlong Centennial Celebration as a parish that will culminate in October 2026 when Little Flower celebrates its 100th birthday. There will be many events throughout this year to mark this once-in-a-century occasion. But more than events, I call on all our parishioners to also spiritually celebrate this milestone.

How do we do this? Well, during this Holy Year of 2025, both Pope Francis and Pope Leo have called us to conversion and to be disciples of hope. This is what we are called to during a jubilee year: conversion.

And it is providential that on the eve of our yearlong celebration, we celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. As we were reminded in last week's gospel, our Lord tells us that if we do not pick up our cross to come after him, then we cannot be his disciples. This coming jubilee year for our parish is a call to all of us to deepen our relationship with Jesus Christ by embracing our cross, to spend more time before the Blessed Sacrament in our Perpetual Adoration Chapel, to come to confession more often, and to make the Mass on Sundays the center of our life as a parish. Everything we do must be oriented to and flow from the Eucharist.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us of this reality drawing a line from the Second Vatican Council: "The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch." (Catechism of the Catholic Church 1324)

It is indeed a time of jubilee. We begin tomorrow with the 100th birthday of our school and will continue to celebrate for 13 months! May the end of this parish jubilee find us renewed by the Holy Spirit, through the intercession of Our Lady of Mount Carmel and our patroness St. Therese, to begin a new century of service centered on the Eucharist here at the Church of the Little Flower.

¡Feliz centenario, a la escuela de St. Theresa! Mañana celebramos el centenario de nuestra escuela parroquial, que abrió sus puertas como la Academia San José el 15 de septiembre de 1925. Será un día de celebración aquí, ya que los niños asistirán a misa para celebrar este hito como es debido y luego disfrutarán de una gran fiesta de cumpleaños durante la día escolar. Sin duda, es un motivo de celebración.

Mañana también marca el inicio oficial de nuestra celebración del centenario como parroquia, que durará un año y culminará en octubre de 2026, cuando Little Flower celebre su centenario. Habrá muchos eventos a lo largo de este año para conmemorar esta ocasión única en un siglo. Pero más que eventos, hago un llamamiento a todos nuestros feligreses para que también celebren espiritualmente este hito.

¿Cómo lo hacemos? Bueno, durante este Año Santo de 2025, tanto el Papa Francisco como el Papa León nos han llamado a la conversión y a ser discípulos de la esperanza. A esto estamos llamados durante un año jubilar: a la conversión.

Y es providencial que, en vísperas de nuestra celebración anual, celebremos la Fiesta de la Exaltación de la Santa Cruz. Como recordamos en el evangelio de la semana pasada, nuestro Señor nos dice que, si no tomamos nuestra cruz para seguirlo, no podemos ser sus discípulos. Este próximo año jubilar para nuestra parroquia es un llamado a todos a profundizar nuestra relación con Jesucristo abrazando nuestra cruz, a pasar más tiempo ante el Santísimo Sacramento en nuestra Capilla de Adoración Perpetua, a confesarnos con más frecuencia y a hacer de la Misa dominical el centro de nuestra vida como parroquia. Todo lo que hacemos debe estar orientado a la Eucaristía y fluir de ella.

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica nos recuerda de esta realidad, siguiendo el ejemplo del Concilio Vaticano II: "La Eucaristía es fuente y culmen de la vida cristiana. Los demás sacramentos, e incluso todos los ministerios eclesiásticos y las obras de apostolado, están unidos a la Eucaristía y a ella se ordenan. Porque en la sagrada Eucaristía se contiene todo el bien espiritual de la Iglesia, es decir, Cristo mismo, nuestra Pascua" (Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, 1324).

Es, sin duda, un tiempo de jubileo. Comenzamos mañana con el centenario de nuestro colegio y continuaremos celebrándolo durante 13 meses. Que el final de este jubileo parroquial nos encuentre renovados por el Espíritu Santo, por la intercesión de Nuestra Señora del Carmen y nuestra patrona, Santa Teresita, para comenzar un nuevo siglo de servicio centrado en la Eucaristía aquí, en la Iglesia de Little Flower.



# PIPE ORGANS ARE FOREVER... AND NOW YOUR LEGACY CAN BE, TOO!

Fisk Opus 166, which will be arriving here early next year, is now being erected at the Fisk workshop in Gloucester, MA. Keep on eye on their Facebook and Instagram pages (@cbfisk) for regular updates as the three towers get built up and the pipes start to get put in place.

Our new pipe organ will contain about 3,000 pipes and each one of them has been meticulously hand-crafted, from the melting of the metals and the creation of large tin sheets to the precise measuring, cutting, rolling, soldering, and detailed finishing of each individual pipe's various parts.

As we announced over the summer, those pipes are specially available to be dedicated in memory of a loved one, to commemorate major milestones like baptisms, first communions, confirmations, graduations, birthdays, weddings, or anniversaries, or simply to add your family's name to the long legacy of our parish in this milestone year.


Pipe Memorializations will be recorded in a specially printed booklet which will be provided to each donor at no additional cost early next year. A copy of the booklet will also remain inside the organ in perpetuity, ensuring the lasting legacy of both the instrument itself and of all those who helped to make it possible.

The 2,938 interior pipes remain available for dedication for \$400 each.

43 of the 60 facade pipes, forever visible on the front of each of the organ's three major cases, remain available for \$1,000 each.




