

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

My Dear Friends,

What an amazing Eucharistic celebration we had last week to celebrate our school's centennial. We had well over 1,200 people join us on the school grounds for Mass and a historical walk. I thank all our alumni for coming to this once in a century celebration and thank all our school parents, teachers, and staff who worked so hard to make the School Centennial Mass one of the most memorable events in the history of our school. God reward all of you for your loving service.

In 1925, the same year the school was founded, Pope Pius XI instituted a new solemnity that we celebrate today: Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of Jesuit priest, was arrested and executed under the Universe. The pope's reasons were twofold: false charges. While he was being executed he, to combat the totalitarianism and the over pietism that existed at the time. Pope Pius was seeing the state become the dominant figure in many societies, so he wanted to emphasize that Jesus Christ was the only King of our lives, and he could not be replaced by a state, a person, or an ideology. Communism and Fascism were on the rise with Naziism in its infancy, so the people were reminded of instituted this great solemnity: to remind us Christ's kingship in their daily lives and to not allow an ideology to replace Christ. Those three "-isms" have fallen into "the ash heap of history," but have been replaced with other "isms" like materialism and secularism. We live in a world where God isn't relevant, necessary, or even acknowledged. This is why today's feast is so important because we need to be reminded that Jesus is King!

Last week I wrote in this space about Christians persecuted in different parts of the world. Our Holy Father this past week mentioned Christians persecuted in Nigeria. Needless to say, it is not safe to worship Jesus Christ in some parts of the world. Yet many still go to worship Christ their King in spite of adversity even if it may cost them their lives as it has for so many martyrs during the history of the Church. Martyrs like Blessed Miguel Agustin Pro, whose feast we celebrate on November 23, who died during the Cristero War in Mexico in the 1920's right around the time this solemnity of Christ the King began to be celebrated. The Church was under great persecution in Mexico and Father Miguel, a as well as many who died during those times, proclaimed, "Viva Cristo Rey! (Long live, Christ the King!)" Those words should not only be on our lips, but engraved in our hearts every single day. Christ must reign in our hearts so that we might make his kingdom known to all even in the face of adversity. It is getting harder to be a Christian, but this is why Pope Pius XI that no matter what adversity we may face, Jesus Christ is King!

# DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mís Querídos Amígos,

maravillosa celebración eucarística :Oué tuvimos la semana pasada para conmemorar el centenario de nuestra escuela! Más de 1,200 personas nos acompañaron en el recinto escolar para la misa y un recorrido histórico. Agradezco a todos nuestros exalumnos por asistir a esta celebración única en un siglo y a todos los padres, maestros y personal de la escuela que trabajaron arduamente para que la Misa del Centenario fuera uno de los eventos más memorables en la historia de nuestra escuela parroquial. Que Dios los bendiga a todos por su amoroso servicio.

En 1925, el mismo año en que se fundó la escuela, el Papa Pío XI instituyó una nueva solemnidad que celebramos hoy: Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, Rey del Universo. Las razones del Papa fueron dos: combatir el totalitarismo y el excesivo pietismo que existían en aquel entonces. El Papa Pío veía cómo el Estado se convertía en la figura dominante en muchas sociedades, por lo que quiso enfatizar que Jesucristo era el único Rey de nuestras vidas y que no podía ser reemplazado por un Estado, una persona o una ideología. El comunismo y el fascismo estaban en auge, y el nazismo en sus inicios, por lo que se les recordaba a las personas la realeza de Cristo en su vida diaria y la importancia de no permitir que una ideología lo reemplazara. Esos tres «ismos» han quedado relegados al olvido, pero han sido reemplazados por otros «ismos» como el materialismo y el secularismo. Vivimos en un mundo donde Dios no es relevante, necesario ni siquiera reconocido. Por eso la fiesta de hoy es tan importante, porque necesitamos recordar que Jesús es Rey.

La semana pasada escribí en este espacio sobre los cristianos perseguidos en diferentes partes del mundo. Nuestro Santo Padre mencionó la semana pasada a los cristianos perseguidos en Nigeria. Huelga decir que no es seguro adorar a Jesucristo en algunas partes del mundo. Sin embargo, muchos siguen acudiendo a adorar a Cristo, su Rey, a pesar de la adversidad, incluso si ello les cuesta la vida, como ha sucedido con tantos mártires a lo largo de la historia de la Iglesia. Mártires como el Beato Miguel Agustín Pro, cuya fiesta celebramos el 23 de noviembre, quien murió durante la Guerra Cristera en México en la década de 1920, justo cuando se empezó a celebrar esta solemnidad de Cristo Rey. La Iglesia sufría una gran persecución en México y el Padre Miguel, sacerdote jesuita, fue arrestado y ejecutado bajo falsas acusaciones. Mientras era ejecutado, él, al igual que muchos otros que murieron en aquella época, proclamó: «¡Viva Cristo Rey!». Estas palabras no solo deben estar en nuestros labios, sino grabadas en nuestros corazones cada día. Cristo debe reinar en nuestros corazones para que podamos dar a conocer su reino a todos, incluso ante la adversidad. Cada vez es más difícil ser cristiano, pero por eso el Papa Pío XI solemnidad: instituyó esta gran recordarnos que, sin importar la adversidad que enfrentemos, ¡Jesucristo es Rey!




# PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO BOSTON FOR THE GRAND UNVEILING OF FISK OPUS 166!


