

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

I pray you had a beautiful Christmas Day, but the season continues for another two weeks. How blessed are we? The world may move on and start taking down their trees and their decorations, but as a Church, we continue to celebrate the birth of our Lord until the feast of his baptism.

Today, we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family, and I want share with you an excerpt of one of the best homilies ever given on the Holy Family, which wasn't given on this day, but was given in Nazareth by Pope St. Paul VI on his visit to the Holy Land in 1964. I invite you to reflect on these words and to pray for the sanctity of all of our families.

God bless you all, to

At Nazareth our very first thoughts must be turned toward Mary Most Holy, to offer her the tribute of Our devotion and to nourish that devotion with reflections that will make it genuine, profound and unique, in conformity with the plan of God. It is Mary who is full of grace, who is the Immaculate, the ever-virgin, the Mother of Christ and hence God's Mother and ours, she who was assumed into heaven, our most blessed Queen, the model for the Church and our hope.

Before all else We offer Our humble filial promise to venerate her with that special devotion which recognizes the wonders God has accomplished in her; with singular homage manifesting the most holy, pure affectionate, personal and confident movements of Our Heart; with such devotion as causes her encouraging example of human perfection to shine upon the world from on high.

Then we present to her Our requests for what is closest to Our heart, because We wish to honor both her goodness and the power of her love and intercession. We pray that she may preserve in our hearts a sincere devotion to her. We beg her to give us understanding, desire, and then the peace of possessing purity of body and soul, purity in thought and word, art and love; the purity that the world of today attempts to shock and violate; the purity to which Christ has linked one of His promises, one of His beatitudes, that of penetrating into the vision of God Himself.

We ask therefore the favor of joining Our Lady, mother of the home at Nazareth, and her humble but courageous husband St. Joseph, in their intimacy with Jesus Christ, her human and divine Son.

Nazareth is the school in which we begin to understand the life of Jesus. It is the school of the Gospel. Here we learn to observe, to listen, to meditate, and to penetrate the profound and mysterious meaning of that simple, humble, and lovely manifestation of the Son of God. And perhaps we learn almost imperceptibly to imitate Him. Here we learn the method by which we can come to understand Christ. Here we discover the need to observe the milieu of His sojourn among us – places, period of time, customs, language, religious practices, all of which Jesus used to reveal Himself to the world. Here everything speaks to us; everything has meaning. (Pope St. Paul VI, 1/5/64)

Espero que hayan tenído una hermosa Navídad, pero la temporada contínúa durante dos semanas más. ¡Qué afortunados somos! El mundo puede seguir adelante y empezar a quítar sus árboles y decoraciones, pero como Iglesía, seguimos celebrando el nacímiento de nuestro Señor hasta la fiesta de su bautismo.

Hoy celebramos la Fíesta de la Sagrada Família, y quiero compartír con ustedes un fragmento de una de las mejores homílias jamás pronunciadas sobre la Sagrada Família, que no fue pronunciada en este día, sino en Nazaret por el Papa San Pablo VI durante su visita a Tierra Santa en 1964. Los invito a reflexionar sobre estas palabras y a orar por la santidad de todas nuestras famílias.

Que Díos los bendiga a todos, /a

En Nazaret, Nuestro primer pensamiento se dirigirá a María Santísima: para ofrecerle el tributo de Nuestra piedad y para nutrir esta piedad con aquellos motivos que deben hacerla verdadera, profunda, única, como los designios de Dios quieren que sea: a la Llena de Gracia, a la Inmaculada, a la siempre Virgen, a la Madre de Cristo —Madre por eso mismo de Dios— y Madre nuestra, a la que por su Asunción está en el cielo, a la Reina. beatísima, modelo de la Iglesia y esperanza nuestra.

En seguida le ofrecemos el humilde y filial propósito de quererla siempre venerar y celebrar, con un culto especial que reconozca las grandes cosas que Dios ha hecho en Ella, con una devoción particular que haga actuar nuestros afectos más piadosos, más puros, más humanos, más personales y más confiados, y que levante en alto, por encima del mundo, el ejemplo y la confianza de la perfección humana:

Y en seguida, le presentaremos nuestros oraciones por todo lo que más llevamos en el corazón, porque queremos honrar su bondad y su poder de amor y de intercesión:

- la oración para que nos conserve en el alma una sincera devoción hacia Ella,
- la oración para que nos dé la comprensión, el deseo, la confianza y el vigor de la pureza del espíritu y del cuerpo, del sentimiento y de la palabra, del arte y del amor; aquella pureza que hoy el mundo no sabe ya cómo ofender y profanar; aquella pureza a la cual Jesucristo ha unido una de sus promesas, una de sus bienaventuranzas, la de la mirada penetrante en la visión de Dios;
- y la oración de ser admitidos por Ella, la Señora, la Dueña de la casa, juntamente con su fuerte y manso Esposo San José, en la intimidad de Cristo, de su humano y divino Hijo Jesús.

Nazaret es la escuela de iniciación para comprender la vida de Jesús. La escuela del Evangelio. Aquí se aprende observar, a escuchar, a meditar, a penetrar en el sentido, tan profundo y misterioso, de aquella simplísima, humildísima, bellísima manifestación del Hijo de Dios.

Casi insensiblemente, acaso, aquí también se aprende a imitar. Aquí se aprende el método con que podremos comprender quién es Jesucristo. Aquí se comprende la necesidad de observar el cuadro de su permanencia entre nosotros: los lugares, el templo, las costumbres, el lenguaje, la religiosidad de que Jesús se sirvió para revelarse al mundo. Todo habla. Todo tiene un sentido. (Papa San Pablo VI, 1/5/64)




