FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My dear Brothers and Sisters,

From the bottom of my heart, I want to thank each and every one of you for your contributions to the ABCD appeal last weekend. The response was overwhelming, and as usual, the generosity of this parish knows no bounds. If you were out last weekend, I invite you to please take one of the ABCD envelopes in the pews, fill it out, and drop the filled pledge card in the collection basket. On behalf of Archbishop Wenski, thank you for reaching out to help the poorest among us in our local Church in South Florida. God reward your generosity.

As millions across the nation gather today for "Super Sunday," I will take pastoral advantage of this occasion to go a little deeper on the importance of Sunday, not because of football, but because of the importance of Mass at center of our Sundays. Now I know I'm (mostly) preaching to the choir here because you're probably reading this bulletin while sitting in the church or at home online with the intention of going to church for Mass. In 1998, St. John Paul II published an apostolic letter called "Dies Domini" (The Lord's Day) to explain to the faithful how to keep the Lord's Day holy:

The Lord's Day – as Sunday was called from Apostolic times – has always been accorded special attention in the history of the Church because of its close connection with the very core of the Christian mystery. In fact, in the weekly reckoning of time Sunday recalls the day of Christ's Resurrection. It is Easter which returns week by week, celebrating Christ's victory over sin and death, the fulfillment in him of the first creation and the dawn of "the new creation" (cf. 2 Cor 5:17). It is the day which recalls in grateful adoration the world's first day and looks forward in active hope to "the last day", when Christ will come in glory (cf. Acts 1:11; 1 Th 4:13-17) and all things will be made new (cf. Rev 21:5).

Rightly, then, the Psalmist's cry is applied to Sunday: "This is the day which the Lord has made: let us rejoice and be glad in it" (Ps 118:24). This invitation to joy, which the Easter liturgy makes its own, reflects the astonishment which came over the women who, having seen the crucifixion of Christ, found the tomb empty when they went there "very early on the first day after the Sabbath" (Mk 16:2). It is an invitation to relive in some way the experience of the two disciples of Emmaus, who felt their hearts "burn within them" as the Risen One walked with them on the road, explaining the Scriptures and revealing himself in "the breaking of the bread" (cf. Lk 24:32,35). And it echoes the joy – at first uncertain and then overwhelming – which the Apostles experienced on the evening of that same day, when they were visited by the Risen Jesus and received the gift of his peace and of his Spirit (cf. Jn 20:19, 23).

St. John Paul II wants us to rediscover Sunday and the centrality of the Sunday Mass on that day:

It seems more necessary than ever to recover the deep doctrinal foundations underlying the Church's precept, so that the abiding value of Sunday in the Christian life will be clear to all the faithful. In doing this, we follow in the footsteps of the age-old tradition of the Church, powerfully restated by the Second Vatican Council in its teaching that on Sunday "Christian believers should come together, in order to commemorate the suffering, Resurrection and glory of the Lord Jesus, by hearing God's Word and sharing the Eucharist, and to give thanks to God who has given them new birth to a living hope through the Resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead (cf. 1 Pt 1:3)". Sunday is a day which is at the very heart of the Christian life. From the beginning of my Pontificate, I have not ceased to repeat: "Do not be afraid! Open, open wide the doors to Christ!". (9) In the same way, today I would strongly urge everyone to rediscover Sunday: Do not be afraid to give your time to Christ! Yes, let us open our time to Christ, that he may cast light upon it and give it direction.

Finally, the holy pope doubles down on the importance of the Sunday Mass to the life of a parish community:

...on the pastoral level the community aspect of the Sunday celebration should be particularly stressed. As I have noted elsewhere, among the many activities of a parish, "none is as vital or as community-forming as the Sunday celebration of the Lord's Day and his Eucharist".

And he concludes that the Eucharist is the "very heart of Sunday." So, let's reorder things. I urge all our families to plan your weekends around the celebration of Sunday Mass. There is nothing, I repeat with every fiber of my being, there is NOTHING that is more important to do as a family than to participate in the celebration of Sunday Mass. Everything flows from it, and everything flows back to it. I pray we may rediscover the primordial importance of Sunday in the life of every Christian family because the Eucharist nurtures every family insofar as we participate in it and weakens the family when we put sports, birthdays, trips or anything else above the third commandment of truly making the Lord's day HOLY.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

Desde el fondo de mi corazón, quiero agradecer a cada uno de vosotros por vuestras contribuciones a la campaña de la ABCD el pasado fin de semana. La respuesta fue abrumadora y, como siempre, la generosidad de esta parroquia no tiene límites. Si estuviste fuera el fin de semana pasado, te invito a que por favor tomes uno de los sobres de ABCD que hay en los bancos, lo rellenes y dejes la tarjeta de compromiso llena en la cesta de la recogida. En nombre del arzobispo Wenski, gracias por ayudar a los más pobres entre nosotros en nuestra Iglesia local en el sur de Florida. Dios recompense tu generosidad.

Mientras millones de personas en todo el país se reúnen hoy para el "Superdomingo", aprovecharé pastoralmente esta ocasión para profundizar un poco más en la importancia del domingo, no por el fútbol, sino por la importancia de la Misa en el centro de nuestros domingos. Ahora sé que (en su mayoría) estoy predicando para los convertidos porque probablemente estás leyendo este boletín sentado en la iglesia o en casa online con la intención de ir a misa. En 1998, San Juan Pablo II publicó una carta apostólica llamada "Dies Domini" (El Día del Señor) para explicar a los fieles cómo mantener el Día del Señor santo:

El Día del Señor –como se llamaba el domingo desde tiempos apostólicos– siempre ha recibido especial atención en la historia de la Iglesia debido a su estrecha conexión con el núcleo mismo del misterio cristiano. De hecho, en el ajuste semanal del tiempo, el domingo recuerda el día de la Resurrección de Cristo. Es la Pascua la que regresa semana tras semana, celebrando la victoria de Cristo sobre el pecado y la muerte, el cumplimiento en él de la primera creación y el amanecer de la nueva creación" (cf. 2 Corintios 5:17). Es el día que recuerda con adoración agradecida el primer día del mundo y mira con esperanza activa hacia "el último día", cuando Cristo vendrá en gloria (cf. Hechos 1:11; 1 T 4:13-17) y todas las cosas serán nuevas (cf. Apocalipsis 21:5).

Es una invitación a revivir de alguna manera la experiencia de los dos discípulos de Emaús, que sintieron que sus corazones "ardían en su interior" mientras el Resucitado caminaba con ellos por el camino, explicando las Escrituras y revelándose en "el romper el pan" (cf. Lc 24:32,35). Y refleja la alegría – al principio incierta y luego abrumadora – que los apóstoles experimentaron la misma noche de ese mismo día, cuando fueron visitados por el Jesús resucitado y recibieron el don de su paz y de su Espíritu (cf. Jn 20:19-23).

San Juan Pablo II quiere que redescubramos el domingo y la centralidad de la misa dominical en ese día:

Parece más necesario que nunca recuperar los profundos fundamentos doctrinales que sustentan el precepto de la Iglesia, para que el valor duradero del domingo en la vida cristiana sea claro para todos los fieles. Al hacer esto, seguimos los pasos de la antigua tradición de la Iglesia, poderosamente reformulada por el Concilio Vaticano II en su enseñanza de que el domingo "los creyentes cristianos deben reunirse para conmemorar el sufrimiento, la Resurrección y la gloria del Señor Jesús, escuchando la Palabra de Dios y compartiendo la Eucaristía, y para dar gracias a Dios que les ha dado un nuevo nacimiento a una esperanza viva a través de la Resurrección de Jesús Cristo de entre los muertos (cf. 1 Pt 1:3)... El domingo es un día que está en el corazón mismo de la vida cristiana. Desde el inicio de mi pontificado, no he dejado de repetir: "¡No tengáis miedo! ¡Abrid, abrid de par en par las puertas a Cristo!" De la misma manera, hoy animaría encarecidamente a todos a redescubrir el domingo: ¡No tengáis miedo de dedicar vuestro tiempo a Cristo! Sí, abramos nuestro tiempo a Cristo, para que lo ilumine y le dé dirección.

Por último, el santo papa refuerza la importancia de la misa dominical para la vida de una comunidad parroquial:

...a nivel pastoral, debe enfatizarse especialmente el aspecto comunitario de la celebración dominical. Como he señalado en otros lugares, entre las muchas actividades de una parroquia, ninguna es tan vital o tan formadora de comunidad como la celebración dominical del Día del Señor y su Eucaristía."

Y concluye que la Eucaristía es el "corazón mismo del domingo." Así que, vamos a reordenar las cosas. Insto a todas nuestras familias a que planifiquen vuestros fines de semana en torno a la celebración de la misa dominical. No hay nada, repito con cada fibra de mi ser, NO hay NADA más importante que hacer en familia que participar en la celebración de la Misa dominical. Todo fluye de ello, y todo vuelve a ello. Rezo para que redescubramos la importancia primordial del domingo en la vida de toda familia cristiana, porque la Eucaristía nutre a cada familia en la medida en que participamos en ella y debilita a la familia cuando ponemos deportes, cumpleaños, viajes o cualquier otra cosa por encima del tercer mandamiento de hacer verdaderamente santo el día del Señor.
