



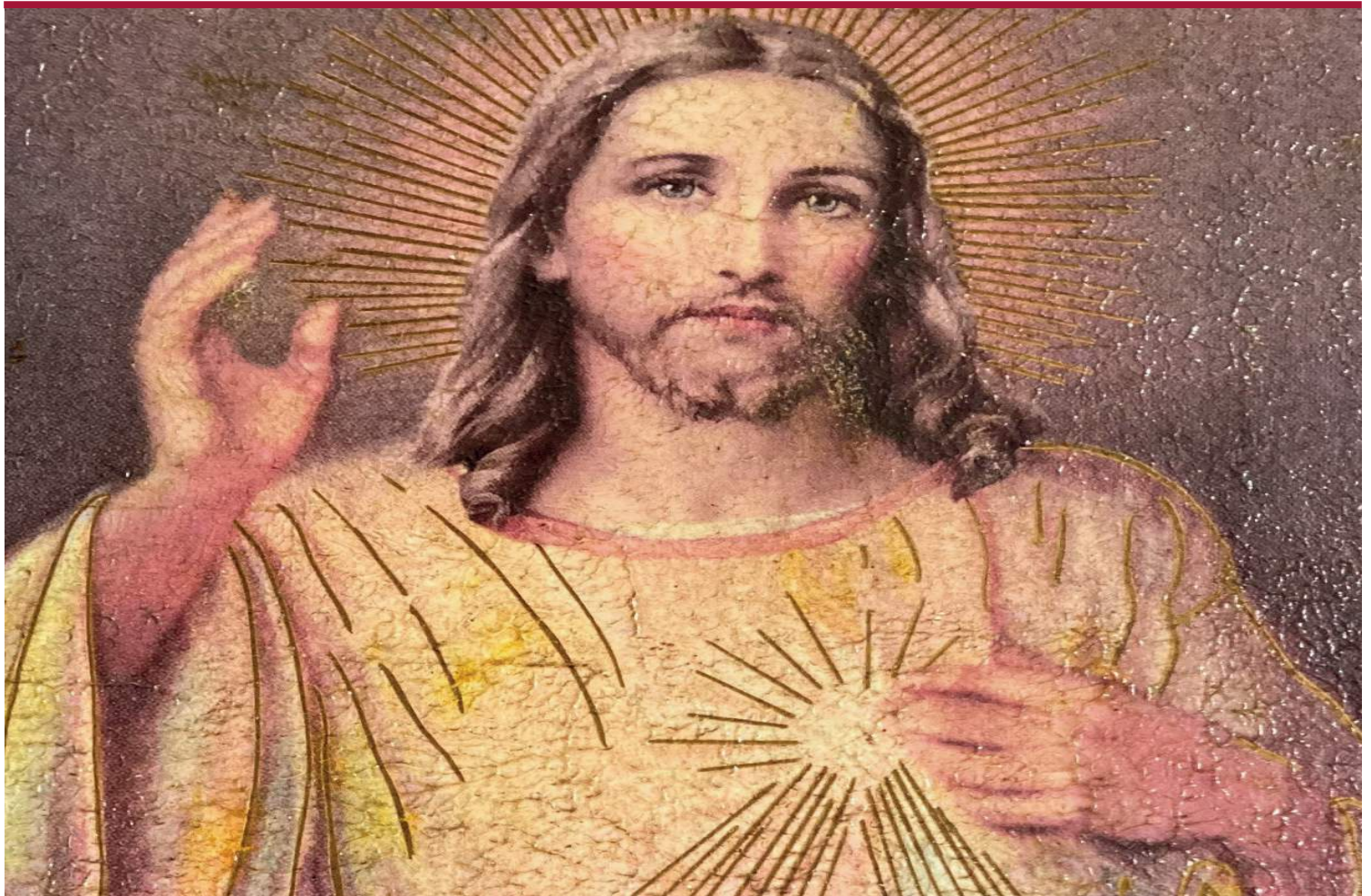

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

On this Divine Mercy Sunday, I want to share with all of you excerpts of the homily of St. John Paul II on this day in 2000 when he canonized St. Faustina.

"Give thanks to the Lord for he is good; his steadfast love endures for ever" (Ps118:1). So the Church sings on the Octave of Easter, as if receiving from Christ's lips these words of the Psalm; from the lips of the risen Christ, who bears the great message of divine mercy and entrusts its ministry to the Apostles in the Upper Room: "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I send you.... Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained" (Jn20:21-23).

Before speaking these words, Jesus shows his hands and his side. He points, that is, to the wounds of the Passion, especially the wound in his heart, the source from which flows the great wave of mercy poured out on humanity. From that heart Sr Faustina Kowalska, the blessed whom from now on we will call a saint, will see two rays of light shining from that heart and illuminating the world: "The two rays", Jesus himself explained to her one day, "represent blood and water" (Diary, Libreria Editrice Vaticana, p. 132).

Blood and water! We immediately think of the testimony given by the Evangelist John, who, when a soldier on Calvary pierced Christ's side with his spear, sees blood and water flowing from it (cf. Jn19:34). Moreover, if the blood recalls the sacrifice of the Cross and the gift of the Eucharist, the water, in Johannine symbolism, represents not only Baptism but also the gift of the Holy Spirit (cf. Jn3:5; 4:14; 7:37-39).

Divine Mercy reaches human beings through the heart of Christ crucified: *My daughter, say that I am love and mercy personified*, Jesus will ask Sr Faustina (Diary, p. 374). Christ pours out this mercy on humanity through the sending of the Spirit who, in the Trinity, is the Person-Love. And is not mercy love's "second name" (cf. *Dives in misericordia*, n. 7), understood in its deepest and most tender aspect, in its ability to take upon itself the burden of any need and, especially, in its immense capacity for forgiveness?

...Sr Faustina Kowalska wrote in her Diary: "I feel tremendous pain when I see the sufferings of my neighbours. All my neighbours' sufferings reverberate in my own heart; I carry their anguish in my heart in such a way that it even physically destroys me. I would like all their sorrows to fall upon me, in order to relieve my neighbour" (Diary, p. 365). This is the degree of compassion to which love leads, when it takes the love of God as its measure!

It is this love which must inspire humanity today, if it is to face the crisis of the meaning of life, the challenges of the most diverse needs and, especially, the duty to defend the dignity of every human person. Thus the message of divine mercy is also implicitly a message about the value of every human being. Each person is precious in God's eyes; Christ gave his life for each one; to everyone the Father gives his Spirit and offers intimacy.

This consoling message is addressed above all to those who, afflicted by a particularly harsh trial or crushed by the weight of the sins they committed, have lost all confidence in life and are tempted to give in to despair. To them the gentle face of Christ is offered; those rays from his heart touch them and shine upon them, warm them, show them the way and fill them with hope. How many souls have been consoled by the prayer "Jesus, I trust in you", which Providence intimated through Sr Faustina! This simple act of abandonment to Jesus dispels the thickest clouds and lets a ray of light penetrate every life. *Jezu, ufam tobie...*

Let us too, the pilgrim Church, join our voice to the voice of Mary most holy, "Mother of Mercy", to the voice of this new saint who sings of mercy with all God's friends in the heavenly Jerusalem.

And you, Faustina, a gift of God to our time, a gift from the land of Poland to the whole Church, obtain for us an awareness of the depth of divine mercy; help us to have a living experience of it and to bear witness to it among our brothers and sisters. May your message of light and hope spread throughout the world, spurring sinners to conversion, calming rivalries and hatred and opening individuals and nations to the practice of brotherhood. Today, fixing our gaze with you on the face of the risen Christ, let us make our own your prayer of trusting abandonment and say with firm hope: Christ Jesus, I trust in you! *Jezu, ufam tobie!*

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

En este Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, quisiera compartir partes de la homilía de San Juan Pablo II en este día en el año 2000 cuando canonizó a Santa Faustina:

Confitemini Domino quoniam bonus, quoniam in saeculum misericordia eius, "Dad gracias al Señor porque es bueno, porque es eterna su misericordia" (Sal118, 1). Así canta la Iglesia en la octava de Pascua, casi recogiendo de labios de Cristo estas palabras del Salmo; de labios de Cristo resucitado, que en el Cenáculo da el gran anuncio de la misericordia divina y confía su ministerio a los Apóstoles: "Paz a vosotros. Como el Padre me ha enviado, así también os envío yo. (...) Recibid el Espíritu Santo; a quienes les perdonéis los pecados les quedan perdonados; a quienes se los retengáis les quedan retenidos" (Jn20, 21-23).

Antes de pronunciar estas palabras, Jesús muestra sus manos y su costado, es decir, señala las heridas de la Pasión, sobre todo la herida de su corazón, fuente de la que brota la gran ola de misericordia que se derrama sobre la humanidad. De ese corazón, *sor Faustina Kowalska*, la beata que a partir de ahora llamaremos santa, verá salir dos haces de luz que iluminan el mundo: "Estos dos haces —le explicó un día Jesús mismo— representan la sangre y el agua" (*Diario*, Librería Editrice Vaticana, p. 132).

2. *Sangre y agua*/Nuestro pensamiento va al testimonio del evangelista san Juan, quien, cuando un soldado traspasó con su lanza el costado de Cristo en el Calvario, vio salir "sangre y agua" (Jn19, 34). Y si la sangre evoca el sacrificio de la cruz y el don eucarístico, el agua, en la simbología joánica, no sólo recuerda el bautismo, sino también el don del Espíritu Santo (cf. Jn3, 5; 4, 14; 7, 37-39).

La misericordia divina llega a los hombres a través del corazón de Cristo crucificado: "Hija mía, di que soy el Amor y la Misericordia en persona", pedirá Jesús a sor Faustina (*Diario*, p. 374). Cristo derrama esta misericordia sobre la humanidad mediante el envío del Espíritu que, en la Trinidad, es la Persona-Amor. Y ¿acaso no es la misericordia un "segundo nombre" del amor (cf. *Dives in misericordia*, 7), entendido en su aspecto más profundo y tierno, en su actitud de aliviar cualquier necesidad, sobre todo en su inmensa capacidad de perdón?

...Sor Faustina Kowalska dejó escrito en su *Diario*: "Experimento un dolor tremendo cuando observo los sufrimientos del prójimo. Todos los dolores del prójimo repercuten en mi corazón; llevo en mi corazón sus angustias, de modo que me destruyen también físicamente. Desearía que todos los dolores recayeran sobre mí, para aliviar al prójimo" (p. 365). ¡Hasta ese punto de comunión lleva el amor cuando se mide según el amor a Dios!

En este amor debe inspirarse la humanidad hoy para afrontar la crisis de sentido, los desafíos de las necesidades más diversas y, sobre todo, la exigencia de salvaguardar la dignidad de toda persona humana. Así, el mensaje de la misericordia divina es, implícitamente, también un *mensaje sobre el valor de todo hombre*. Toda persona es valiosa a los ojos de Dios, Cristo dio su vida por cada uno, y a todos el Padre concede su Espíritu y ofrece el acceso a su intimidad.

Este mensaje consolador se dirige sobre todo a quienes, afligidos por una prueba particularmente dura o abrumados por el peso de los pecados cometidos, han perdido la confianza en la vida y han sentido la tentación de caer en la desesperación. A ellos se presenta el rostro dulce de Cristo y hasta ellos llegan los haces de luz que parten de su corazón e iluminan, calientan, señalan el camino e infunden esperanza. ¡A cuántas almas ha consolado ya la invocación "Jesús, en ti confío", que la Providencia sugirió a través de sor Faustina! Este sencillo acto de abandono a Jesús disipa las nubes más densas e introduce un rayo de luz en la vida de cada uno.

A la voz de María santísima, la "Madre de la misericordia", a la voz de esta nueva santa, que en la Jerusalén celestial canta la misericordia junto con todos los amigos de Dios, unamos también nosotros, Iglesia peregrina, nuestra voz.

Y tú, Faustina, don de Dios a nuestro tiempo, don de la tierra de Polonia a toda la Iglesia, concédenos percibir la profundidad de la misericordia divina, ayúdanos a experimentarla en nuestra vida y a testimoniarla a nuestros hermanos. Que tu mensaje de luz y esperanza se difunda por todo el mundo, mueva a los pecadores a la conversión, elimine las rivalidades y los odios, y abra a los hombres y las naciones a la práctica de la fraternidad. Hoy, nosotros, fijando, juntamente contigo, nuestra mirada en el rostro de Cristo resucitado, hacemos nuestra tu oración de abandono confiado y decimos con firme esperanza: "Cristo, Jesús, en ti confío".

CAMPAIGN PROJECT UPDATES

- With the structure and mechanical components of the pipe organ installed and many of the pipes already placed, the new choir loft is quickly taking shape and nearing completion! Over the next several weeks, the general contractor will be back on site to install the new wrought-iron railing and to finish up some remaining areas of work on the ground level of the church.,

- Fisk will be back with a team of “voicers” later this month to begin the tedious process of fine-tuning the organ and placing and voicing its 3,000+ pipes. The organ should be fully playable sometime over the summer!

- We remain hopeful that also coming by this summer is our official groundbreaking ceremony for the STS Multi-Purpose Center! Building plans are now working their way through the city permitting approvals and we should have a General Contractor in place soon.

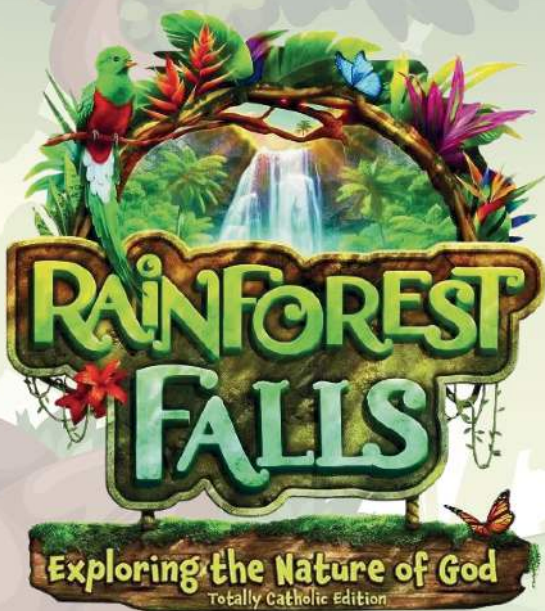

PIPE ORGANS ARE FOREVER... AND NOW YOUR LEGACY CAN BE, TOO!

Each one our Pipe Organ's 3,035 pipes were meticulously hand-crafted at the CB Fisk workshop in Gloucester, MA. From the melting of the metals and the creation of large tin sheets to the precise measuring, cutting, rolling, soldering, and detailed finishing, each pipe itself is a masterful work of art.

The pipes from Opus 166 are specially available to be dedicated in memory of a loved one, to commemorate major milestones like baptisms, first communions, confirmations, graduations, birthdays, weddings, or anniversaries, or simply to add your family's name to the long legacy of our parish in this milestone year.

Pipe Memorializations will be recorded in a specially printed booklet which will be provided to each donor at no additional cost early next year. A copy of the booklet will also remain inside the organ in perpetuity, ensuring the lasting legacy of both the instrument itself and of all those who helped to make it possible.

Interior pipes are available for dedication at \$300 each and facade pipes, forever visible on the front of each of the organ's three major cases, are available for \$1,000 each.

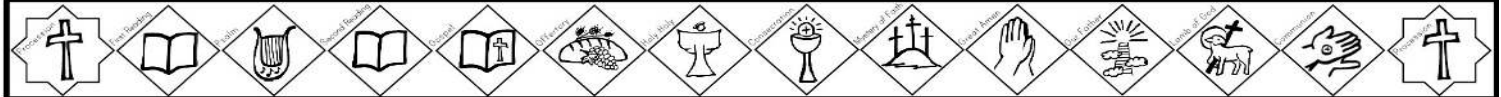
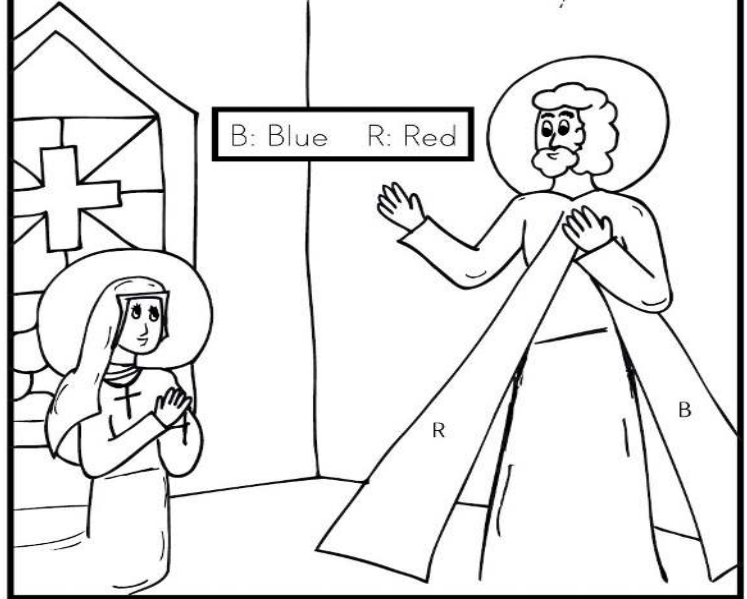
