FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

Today we celebrate with joy the diaconate ordination of one of our seminarians: Deacon Jonathan Sanchez was ordained on Saturday morning, and this weekend he will be preaching at some of our Masses and celebrating his first baptisms. God willing, Deacon Jonathan will be ordained to the priesthood 13 months from now and celebrate his first Mass here in our parish. Please pray for Deacon Jonathan as he begins ordained ministry in the Church, and pray for all of his classmates. Also, I ask you to pray for the 9 young deacons who will be ordained priests next month at St. Mary's Cathedral. We are blessed with a large number of ordinations this year, but we must never cease to pray for more vocations to the priesthood.

Easter is a time for many sacraments. Our catechumens spend months preparing for Easter so that they may be welcomed into the Church through the sacraments. You may have read or seen in the news that the Catholic Church throughout the United States has welcomed a record number of new Catholics this year. Here at Little Flower it was no different. We had around 75 adults in our adult formation program back in September attending our Tuesday night classes with Deacon Fleitas. During the Easter Vigil, we baptized 19 adults and children into the faith. There are a few more who will be baptized in the coming months, and many more who will be doing their Profession of Faith, their First Communion, and/or their Confirmation during this Easter season. It is indeed a springtime of renewal here in our parish and throughout the Archdiocese of Miami. In addition, our school students will receive their First Communion this coming Saturday. We never stop doing infant baptisms, and as for our weddings, more and more young couples are seeking the Sacrament of Marriage. Just consider this statistic from last year that blew my mind: even though our church was closed for 5 months in 2025 for renovations, we still celebrated over 90 weddings last year and are on track to celebrate well over 110 weddings this calendar year, and will probably receive more that aren't even scheduled yet. Yes, we are indeed blessed as a parish with all these sacramental graces.

In other news, our contractor finished the last of the major restoration work in our church this past Friday. The railing was installed in the balcony, and on Monday the process of voicing the organ begins, which will take us through the end of the summer. The church will be closed for most of the day between Masses as these brilliant people start bringing our pipe organ to life sometimes working after hours when all is quiet. Which leads me to my next piece of news which I wanted to wait until after Easter to share with all of you: the big pipes that will be the façade of the pipe organ were being manufactured in the Netherlands in a town called Zeist, just to the south of Amsterdam, by world renowned organ maker Jacques Stinkens. They supply pipes to organ manufacturers around the world. On the morning of Saturday, March 21st a fire broke out in their office park which destroyed everything. Thankfully, no workers were injured. We didn't get confirmation that our newly fashioned pipes were incinerated until late in Holy Week. So, now we, along with our organ builder CB Fisk, have to pivot, and thankfully a solution was found rather quickly. The 70 or so large pipes that were being fashioned overseas will now be manufactured here in the USA by Taylor and Boody Organ Builders based out of Virginia. While we won't know a timetable for completion until midsummer, we thank the Good Lord for allowing us to find a quick solution to an unforeseen situation. In the parish office, the restoration of this church for its centennial has been one obstacle after another that has been met with resilience on the part of our staff and the workers who have labored hard to beautify and enhance this sacred worship space. So now we wait, and we pray, but everything continues to point to our Parish Centennial Mass with the archbishop on Saturday, October 3rd at 7:00 p.m. Nothing will deter us from celebrating this milestone for the glory of God.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

Hoy celebramos con alegría la ordenación diaconal de uno de nuestros seminaristas: el diácono Jonathan Sanchez fue ordenado el sábado por la mañana, y este fin de semana predicará en algunas de nuestras misas y celebrará sus primeros bautizos. Si Dios quiere, el diácono Jonathan será ordenado sacerdote dentro de 13 meses y celebrará su primera misa aquí en nuestra parroquia. Por favor, orad por el diácono Jonathan cuando comience su ministerio ordenado en la Iglesia y rezad por todos sus compañeros de clase. Además, os pido que recéis por los 9 jóvenes diáconos que serán ordenados sacerdotes el mes que viene en la Catedral de Santa María. Este año estamos bendecidos con un gran número de ordenaciones, pero nunca debemos dejar de orar por más vocaciones al sacerdocio.

La Pascua es un tiempo para muchos sacramentos. Nuestros catecúmenos pasan meses preparándose para la Pascua para que puedan ser bienvenidos en la Iglesia a través de los sacramentos. Puede que hayas leído o visto en las noticias que la Iglesia Católica en todo Estados Unidos ha dado la bienvenida a un número récord de nuevos católicos este año. Aquí en Little Flower no fue diferente. En septiembre tuvimos alrededor de 75 adultos en nuestro programa de formación para adultos asistiendo a nuestras clases de los martes por la noche con Deacon Fleitas. Durante la Vigilia Pascual, bautizamos a 19 adultos y niños en la fe. Habrá algunos más que serán bautizados en los próximos meses, y muchos más que harán su Profesión de Fe, su Primera Comunión y/o su Confirmación durante esta temporada de Pascua. Es, sin duda, una primavera de renovación aquí en nuestra parroquia y en toda la Arquidiócesis de Miami. Además, nuestros alumnos recibirán su Primera Comunión este próximo sábado. Nunca dejamos de hacer bautismos de bebés, y en cuanto a nuestras bodas, cada vez más parejas jóvenes buscan el Sacramento del Matrimonio. Solo hay que considerar esta estadística del año pasado que me dejó alucinado: aunque nuestra iglesia estuvo cerrada durante 5 meses en 2025 por reformas, el año pasado celebramos más de 90 bodas y estamos en camino de celebrar más de 110 este año natural, y probablemente recibiremos más que ni siquiera están programadas todavía. Sí, somos realmente bendecidos como parroquia con todas estas gracias sacramentales.

En otras noticias, nuestro contratista terminó el último de los grandes trabajos de restauración en nuestra iglesia el pasado viernes. La barandilla se instaló en el balcón, y el lunes comienza el proceso de poner la voz del órgano, que nos llevará hasta finales de verano. La iglesia estará cerrada la mayor parte del día entre misas, ya que estas personas brillantes empiezan a dar vida a nuestro órgano de tubos, a veces trabajando fuera de horario cuando todo está tranquilo. Lo que me lleva a mi siguiente noticia, que quería esperar hasta después de Pascua para compartir con todos vosotros: los grandes tubos que serán la fachada del órgano de tubos se estaban fabricando en los Países Bajos, en una localidad llamada Zeist, justo al sur de Ámsterdam, por el mundialmente famoso organista Jacques Stinkens. Suministran tubos a fabricantes de órganos de todo el mundo. La mañana del sábado 21 de marzo se desató un incendio en su parque de oficinas que lo destruyó todo. Por suerte, ningún trabajador resultó herido. No tuvimos confirmación de que nuestras nuevas tuberías estaban incineradas hasta bien entrada la Semana Santa. Así que ahora nosotros, junto con nuestro organero CB Fisk, tenemos que pivotar, y afortunadamente se encontró una solución bastante rápida. Los aproximadamente 70 tubos grandes que se fabricaban en el extranjero ahora serán fabricados aquí en Estados Unidos por Taylor and Boody Organ Builders, con sede en Virginia. Aunque no sabremos un calendario para finalizar hasta mediados de verano, agradecemos al Buen Dios por permitirnos encontrar una solución rápida a una situación imprevista. En la oficina parroquial, la restauración de esta iglesia para su centenario ha sido un obstáculo tras otro que ha sido afrontado con resiliencia por parte de nuestro personal y de los trabajadores que han trabajado arduamente para embellecer y mejorar este sagrado espacio de culto. Así que ahora esperamos y oramos, pero todo sigue apuntando a nuestra misa del centenario parroquial con el arzobispo el sábado 3 de octubre a las 19:00. Nada nos impedirá celebrar este hito para la gloria de Dios.

CAMPAIGN PROJECT UPDATES

- The renovation work in the church is now complete! After a brief pause in the work to allow for the installation of the organ structure, teams were all back in action over the past two weeks to install the new iron handrails, paint the new columns at the main entrance, and complete the flooring in the balcony. Special thanks once again to Vilar-Hoynak and its team of sub-contractors for their superior work!

- Fisk will be back with a team of “voicers” next week to begin the tedious process of fine-tuning the organ and placing and voicing its 3,000+ pipes. The organ should be fully playable sometime over the summer!

- We remain hopeful that also coming by this summer is our official groundbreaking ceremony for the STS Multi-Purpose Center! Building plans are now working their way through the city permitting approvals and we should have a General Contractor in place soon.

PIPE ORGANS ARE FOREVER... AND NOW YOUR LEGACY CAN BE, TOO!

Each one of our Pipe Organ's 3,035 pipes were meticulously hand-crafted at the CB Fisk workshop in Gloucester, MA. From the melting of the metals and the creation of large tin sheets to the precise measuring, cutting, rolling, soldering, and detailed finishing, each pipe itself is a masterful work of art.

The pipes from Opus 166 are specially available to be dedicated in memory of a loved one, to commemorate major milestones like baptisms, first communions, confirmations, graduations, birthdays, weddings, or anniversaries, or simply to add your family's name to the long legacy of our parish in this milestone year.

Pipe Memorializations will be recorded in a specially printed booklet which will be provided to each donor at no additional cost early next year. A copy of the booklet will also remain inside the organ in perpetuity, ensuring the lasting legacy of both the instrument itself and of all those who helped to make it possible.

Interior pipes are available for dedication at \$300 each and facade pipes, forever visible on the front of each of the organ's three major cases, are available for \$1,000 each.

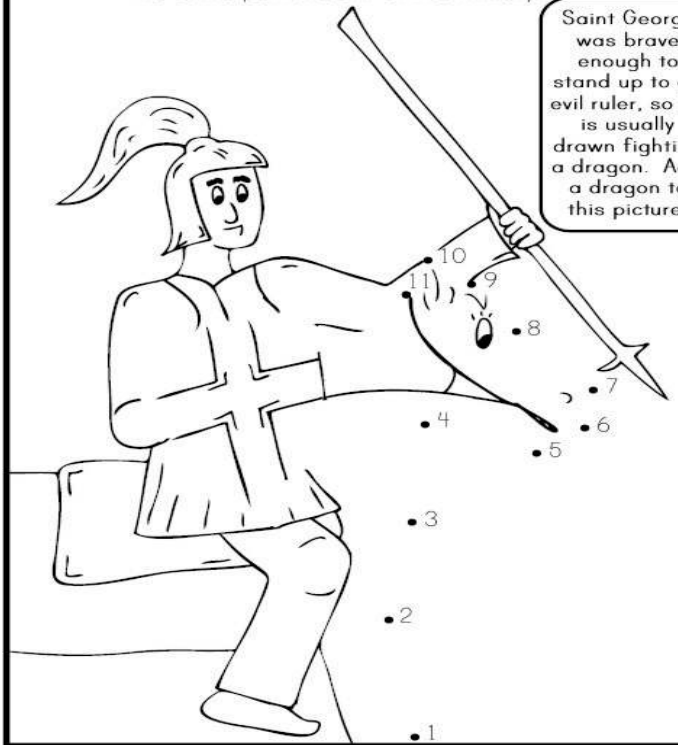

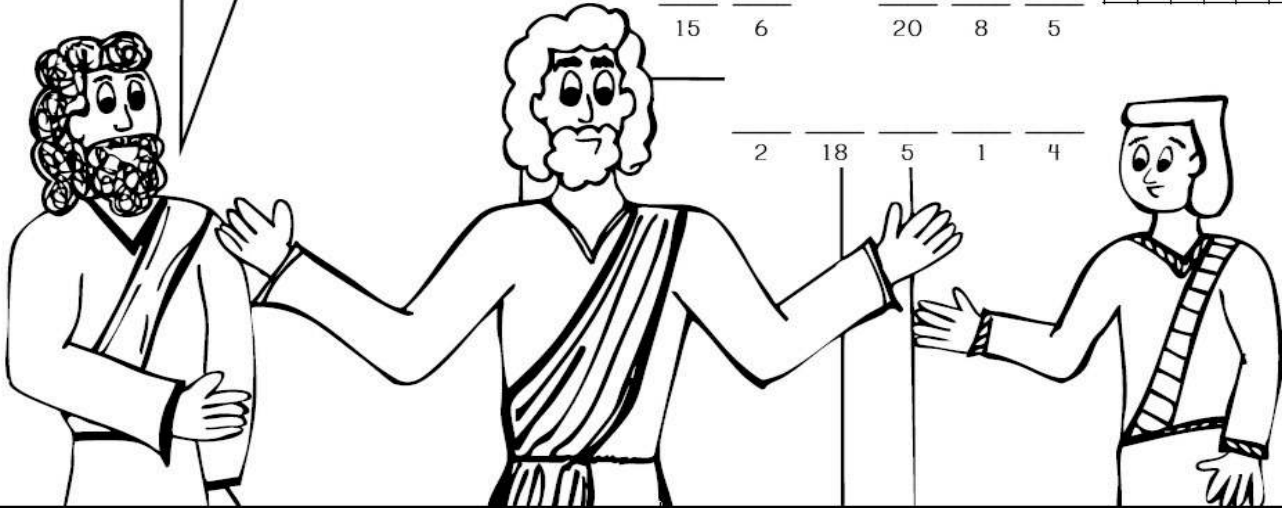
