## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

*My Dear Friends:*

On this Memorial Day weekend, as we approach our nation's 250th birthday, it is our duty as Christians and as Americans to remember those who gave their lives to preserve our freedoms. While this weekend is normally marked by barbecues and pool or boat days, we should pause at some point, as we will at Mass, to honor the memories of the men and women who gave their lives for our country.

There is a letter that Abraham Lincoln wrote during the Civil War to the mother of five union soldiers who were all believed to have died on the field of battle. Historians still debate whether all of them indeed died for only two can be confirmed to have been killed in action, but it does not take away from the sheer magnitude of this letter and how we should view our honored dead:

Executive Mansion,  
Washington, Nov. 21, 1864.

Dear Madam,

I have been shown in the files of the War Department a statement of the Adjutant General of Massachusetts that you are the mother of five sons who have died gloriously on the field of battle.

I feel how weak and fruitless must be any word of mine which should attempt to beguile you from the grief of a loss so overwhelming. But I cannot refrain from tendering you the consolation that may be found in the thanks of the Republic they died to save. I pray that our Heavenly Father may assuage the anguish of your bereavement, and leave you only the cherished memory of the loved and lost, and the solemn pride that must be yours to have laid so costly a sacrifice upon the altar of freedom.

Yours, very sincerely and respectfully,

*A. Lincoln*

The words of President Lincoln in the last paragraph always echo in my heart whenever I hear of the death of a member of our armed services: "laid so costly a price upon the altar of freedom." They are words I remember whenever I officiate the burial of a veteran. While they are few and far between now, early on in my priesthood one of my greatest honors was to preside at the Funeral Masses of veterans of World War II. The Greatest Generation bore unspeakable burdens when you think of what they encountered in the Pacific theater, the invasion of the beaches of Normandy on D-Day, and those poor soldiers who were overwhelmed by the images of what they found in the concentration camps they liberated. They took to their graves the memories of the worst of humanity, but they did so with a stoic silence and resisting attention from not only defending our country but saving the world from unspeakable evils.

And then you think of those who have died in the wars since then, who saw so many brothers and sisters die in their arms. Those who still carry the scars of PTSD, and many carry them to their graves. Our nation can never fully repay the debt owed to these courageous men and women who, while most do not die while engaged in combat, they still carry with them the scars of war, and are still owed a place of honor in our Memorial Day remembrance.

On a wall of our school near the main office, there is a plaque that remembers the alumni of St. Theresa that died during World War II. Many of them were just out of high school, and they are stilled honored by our children because they "laid so costly a sacrifice on the altar of freedom." This weekend, we remember all who made this sacrifice, but we particularly remember during this our centennial year, those members of our parish who went off to war and never came home. We are forever indebted to them and their families.

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord. And let perpetual light shine upon them.

## DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

*Mis Queridos Amigos:*

En este fin de semana del Día de los Caídos, al acercarnos al 250º aniversario de nuestra nación, es nuestro deber como cristianos y como estadounidenses recordar a quienes dieron su vida para preservar nuestras libertades. Aunque este fin de semana normalmente se caracteriza por barbacoas y días en piscina o barco, deberíamos hacer una pausa en algún momento, como haremos en la Misa, para honrar la memoria de los hombres y mujeres que dieron su vida por nuestro país.

Existe una carta que Abraham Lincoln escribió durante la Guerra Civil a la madre de cinco soldados de la Unión que se creía que murieron en el campo de batalla. Los historiadores aún debaten si todos murieron realmente, pues solo se puede confirmar que dos murieron en combate, pero eso no resta importancia a la magnitud de esta carta ni a cómo deberíamos ver a nuestros muertos honrados:

Mansión Ejecutiva, Washington  
21 de noviembre de 1864.

Estimada señora,--  
Me han mostrado en los archivos del Departamento de Guerra una declaración del Ayudante General de Massachusetts en la que dice que usted es madre de cinco hijos que han muerto gloriosamente en el campo de batalla.

Siento lo débil e inútil que debe ser cualquier palabra mía que intente seducirte del dolor de una pérdida tan abrumadora. Pero no puedo evitar ofrecerte el consuelo que puede encontrarse en el agradecimiento de la República que murieron por salvar. Ruego que nuestro Padre Celestial alivie la angustia de vuestro duelo, y os deje solo el recuerdo preciado de los amados y perdidos, y el solemne orgullo que debe de tener por haber puesto un sacrificio tan costoso sobre el altar de la libertad.

Atentamente, muy sinceramente y respetuosamente,

*A. Lincoln*

Las palabras del presidente Lincoln en el último párrafo siempre resuenan en mi corazón cada vez que escucho la muerte de un miembro de nuestras fuerzas armadas: "puso un precio tan costoso sobre el altar de la libertad." Son palabras que recuerdo cada vez que oficio el entierro de un veterano. Aunque ahora son pocos, al principio de mi sacerdocio uno de mis mayores honores fue presidir las misas funerales de veteranos de la Segunda Guerra Mundial. La Generación Más Grande soportó cargas indescriptibles si se piensa en lo que encontraron en el teatro del Pacífico, la invasión de las playas de Normandía el Día D y aquellos pobres soldados que quedaron abrumados por las imágenes de lo que encontraron en los campos de concentración que liberaron. Se llevaron a la tumba los recuerdos de lo peor de la humanidad, pero lo hicieron con un silencio estoico y resistiendo la atención no solo de defender nuestro país, sino de salvar al mundo de males indescriptibles.

Y luego piensas en quienes han muerto en las guerras desde entonces, que vieron morir a tantos hermanos y hermanas en sus brazos. Aquellos que aún llevan las cicatrices del TEPT, y muchos las llevan hasta la tumba. Nuestra nación nunca podrá pagar completamente la deuda que se debe a estos valientes hombres y mujeres que, aunque la mayoría no muere en combate, aún llevan consigo las cicatrices de la guerra y aún merecen un lugar de honor en nuestro recuerdo del Día de los Caídos.

En una pared de nuestro colegio, cerca de la oficina principal, hay una placa que recuerda a los antiguos alumnos de Santa Teresa que murieron durante la Segunda Guerra Mundial. Muchos de ellos acababan de terminar el instituto, y aún así son honrados por nuestros hijos porque "sacrificaron un sacrificio tan costoso en el altar de la libertad." Este fin de semana recordamos a todos los que hicieron este sacrificio, pero especialmente recordamos durante este año centenario a aquellos miembros de nuestra parroquia que se fueron a la guerra y nunca regresaron a casa. Estaremos eternamente en deuda con ellos y sus familias.

Concédeles descanso eterno, oh Señor. Y que la luz perpetua brille sobre ellos.

## CAMPAIGN PROJECT UPDATES

- Final Inspections have begun in the church and we are now nearing 100% completion of the church renovation scope of work!
- The Pipe Organ continues to be voiced and tuned daily, with new pipes, ranks, and voices begin added regularly. The organ will be used occasionally during Sunday liturgies moving forward to give the team from Fisk an opportunity to listen to the organ in the room filled with people, assisting them with the fine-tuning of the instrument.
- Over the upcoming summer break, Comber Hall will be receiving a long-overdue repainting of its exterior, completing the next of the Centennial Campaign projects that were promised.
- The contractor selection process is now also getting underway for the St. Theresa School Multi-Purpose Center with the hope of getting site work started during the summer break!

## PIPE ORGANS ARE FOREVER... AND NOW YOUR LEGACY CAN BE, TOO!

Each one our Pipe Organ's 3,035 pipes were meticulously hand-crafted at the CB Fisk workshop in Gloucester, MA. From the melting of the metals and the creation of large tin sheets to the precise measuring, cutting, rolling, soldering, and detailed finishing, each pipe itself is a masterful work of art.

The pipes from Opus 166 are specially available to be dedicated in memory of a loved one, to commemorate major milestones like baptisms, first communions, confirmations, graduations, birthdays, weddings, or anniversaries, or simply to add your family's name to the long legacy of our parish in this milestone year.

Pipe Memorializations will be recorded in a specially printed booklet which will be provided to each donor at no additional cost early next year. A copy of the booklet will also remain inside the organ in perpetuity, ensuring the lasting legacy of both the instrument itself and of all those who helped to make it possible.

Interior pipes are available for dedication at \$300 each and facade pipes, forever visible on the front of each of the organ's three major cases, are available for \$1,000 each.

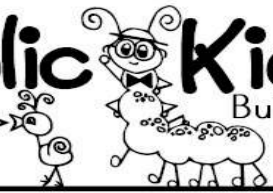

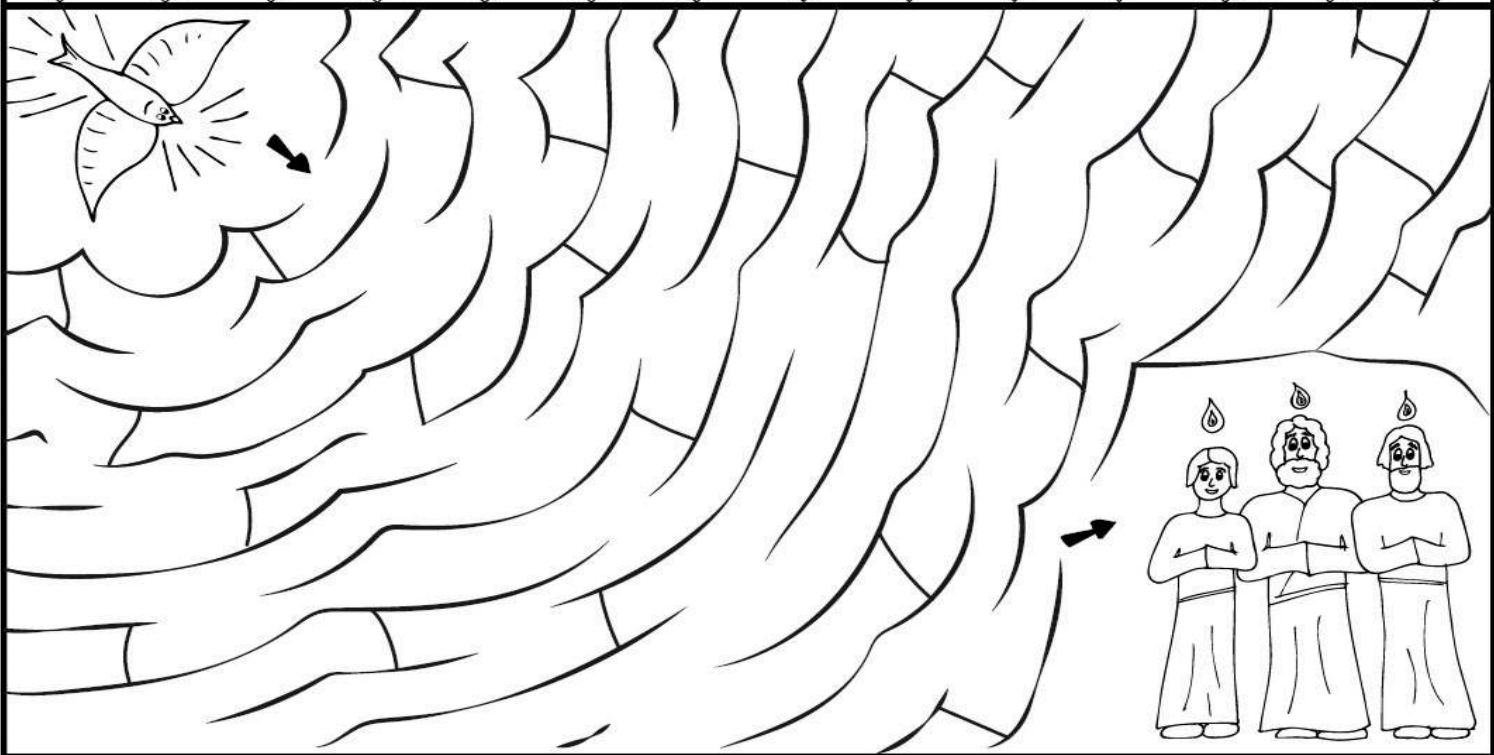
