## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

*Throughout this summer, we encourage all parishioners to read the Encyclical Letter, Magnífica Humanitas, of Pope Leo XIV, on safeguarding the human person in the time of Artificial Intelligence. Over the next several weeks, we will be publishing excerpts from the encyclical for further reflection. The encyclical in its entirety may be found on the Vatican website or you can purchase a physical copy of letter at your preferred religious bookstore or retailer.*

-----

1. Humanity, created by God in all its grandeur, is today facing a pivotal choice: either to construct a new Tower of Babel or to build the city in which God and humanity dwell together. Each generation inherits the task of shaping its own era, of guiding history to become a place where the dignity of every person is safeguarded, justice is promoted and fraternity is made possible. Yet every era also runs the risk of creating an inhumane and more unjust world. Whenever humanity is in danger of marring its true identity, we Christians lift our eyes to the Incarnate God, knowing that it is “only in the mystery of the Word made flesh that the mystery of humanity truly becomes clear.” [1] In Jesus Christ, this humanity in its grandeur becomes the Way, the Truth and the Life, opening the path for each of us to grow toward fullness.

2. Founded on Christ, the living stone, we experience the powerful and mysterious action of the Holy Spirit, and we believe that every authentic human effort to cooperate with him for the good will be blessed by our heavenly Father, in whom we place our hope. For this reason, we can diligently contribute to every initiative that builds a more just world, and we can call others to collaborate in promoting the integral development of every human being.

We wish to engage in dialogue with all men and women of our time, with whom we share in the events, questions and aspirations of humanity. [2] Together with them, we seek to identify new paths for the common good and for promoting a dignified life for all. Indeed, openness to dialogue is an integral part of the Church's vocation because, constituted in Christ as “a sacrament... of communion with God and of the unity of the entire human race,” [3], she recognizes history as the place where the Gospel challenges and directs human experience.

3. In this spirit, Pope Leo XIII published his Encyclical Rerum Novarum in 1891, the 135<sup>th</sup> anniversary of which we celebrate with deep gratitude this year. With that document, my beloved predecessor gave impetus to the reflection on society, the economy and politics, which is now known as the “Social Doctrine of the Church.” When some objected that the Church should not waste energy on worldly matters, but instead focus on communicating the message of eternal life, Leo XIII responded with realism and wisdom, saying that the proclamation of the Gospel cannot overlook the concrete lives of people. [4] Many decades have passed since then, and the Magisterium, pastors, theologians and faithful have continued to reflect on social issues in the light of the Gospel. Today, the Social Doctrine of the Church is a legacy of wisdom, where we find principles for thought, criteria for discernment and judgment, and concrete guidelines for action. Founded on Sacred Scripture and Tradition, and in engagement with the sciences, it helps us clearly interpret the challenges of the present and identify appropriate ways for living out a clear Christian witness, with joy and in service to the world. It is not an inert set of concepts, but a living corpus of truth that safeguards and interprets humanity's vocation to a full and just life. I therefore wish to add my own voice to this living tradition, invoking the help of the Spirit of wisdom, who has dwelt in the world since its beginning (cf. Prov 8:22-31).



## DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

*A lo largo de este verano, animamos a todos los feligreses a leer la Carta Encíclica, Magnífica Humanitas, del Papa León XIV, sobre la salvaguarda de la persona humana en la era de la Inteligencia Artificial. Durante las próximas semanas, publicaremos extractos de la encíclica para una mayor reflexión. La encíclica en su totalidad se puede encontrar en el sitio web del Vaticano o puede comprar una copia física de la carta en su librería religiosa o distribuidor preferido.*

1. La magnífica humanidad que Dios ha creado se encuentra hoy ante una elección decisiva: levantar una nueva torre de Babel o edificar la ciudad donde Dios y la humanidad habiten juntos. Cada generación recibe como herencia la tarea de dar forma a su propio tiempo: hacer madurar la historia como un lugar donde se proteja la dignidad de cada persona, se promueva la justicia y se haga posible la fraternidad. Pero en cada época se cierne el riesgo de construir un mundo inhumano y más injusto. Allí donde la humanidad corre el peligro de perder su rostro, nosotros, los cristianos, alzamos los ojos hacia el Dios que se hizo carne, sabiendo que «el misterio del hombre sólo se esclarece en el misterio del Verbo encarnado». [1] En Jesucristo, esta magnífica humanidad encuentra el camino, la verdad y la vida, abriendo a cada uno de nosotros la vía para crecer hacia la plenitud.

2. Cimentados en Cristo, la piedra viva, experimentamos la acción poderosa y misteriosa del Espíritu Santo, y creemos que todo esfuerzo humano auténtico por cooperar con Él en pro del bien será bendecido por el Padre celestial, en quien ponemos nuestra esperanza. Por este motivo, podemos contribuir con determinación a todas aquellas iniciativas que construyen un mundo más justo, y podemos invitar a otros a colaborar con nosotros en la promoción del desarrollo integral de cada ser humano.

Deseamos entrar en diálogo con todos los hombres y mujeres de nuestro tiempo, con quienes participamos juntos en los acontecimientos, las preguntas y las aspiraciones de la humanidad. [2] Queremos identificar, junto con ellos, nuevos caminos para el bien común y la promoción de una vida digna para todos. Esta actitud de diálogo es parte integrante de la vocación de la Iglesia, ya que ella, constituida «en Cristo como un sacramento, [...] de la unión íntima con Dios y de la unidad de todo el género humano», [3] reconoce en la historia el lugar donde el Evangelio interpela y acompaña la experiencia humana.

3. Con este espíritu, en 1891 León XIII publicó la Encíclica Rerum novarum, cuyo 135º aniversario celebramos este año con profunda gratitud. Con ese documento, mi querido Predecesor impulsó aquella reflexión sobre la sociedad, la economía y la política que hoy llamamos “Doctrina social de la Iglesia”. Y cuando algunos objetaban que la Iglesia no debía desperdiciar energías en cuestiones mundanas, sino preocuparse por comunicar un mensaje de vida eterna, él respondía con realismo y sabiduría que el anuncio del Evangelio no puede olvidar la vida concreta de los pueblos. [4] Han pasado muchas décadas desde entonces, y el Magisterio, los pastores, los teólogos y los fieles han seguido reflexionando sobre las cuestiones sociales a la luz del Evangelio. Hoy, la Doctrina social de la Iglesia es un patrimonio de sabiduría, en el que encontramos principios para pensar, criterios para discernir y juzgar, y orientaciones concretas para actuar. Se fundamenta en la Sagrada Escritura y en la Tradición y, en diálogo con las ciencias, nos ayuda a leer con lucidez los desafíos del presente, identificando caminos adecuados para vivir un testimonio cristiano límpido, con alegría y al servicio del mundo. No es un conjunto estático de conceptos, sino un corpus vivo de verdades, que custodia e interpreta la vocación de la humanidad a una vida plena y justa. A esta tradición viva deseo, por tanto, sumar mi voz, invocando la asistencia del Espíritu de sabiduría, que habita en el mundo desde su creación (cf. Pr 8,22-31).

COTLF offers adults an opportunity to come together in a small group to learn more about our faith through the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults, beginning once again this September.

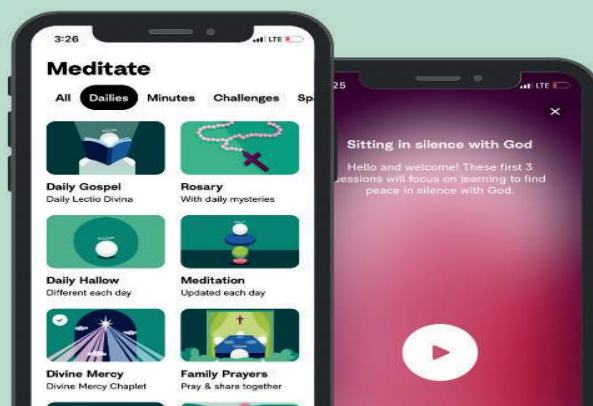


The program serves:
